

BUFFALO BITS / Colorado vs. Missouri

QUICKLY... Colorado, now 3-1-1 after non-conference play, will open its Big Eight title defense today. The Buffaloes have never won back-to-back Big Eight titles... Colorado is coming off two straight wins over ranked teams, as CU dispatched No. 22 Texas two weeks ago and toppled No. 12 Washington last week... Colorado is 23-18-1 in Big Eight Conference openers, including a 7-10-1 mark on the road. CU is 3-3 against Mizzou to open league play, 1-1 in Columbia. CU is 3-4 in Big Eight starters under Bill McCartney.

IN THE POLLS... The Associated Press poll (media members) saw the Buffs jump from No. 20 to No. 12, while the United Press International poll had CU moving up seven notches (from No. 16 to No. 9). The difference of four places last week between the polls tied the largest difference in CU history; the jumps this week represent the second largest weekly improvements in both polls: after CU destroyed Penn State 41-13 in 1970, the Buffs moved from #18 to #8 in AP and from #16 to #7 in UPI.

COACH BILL McCARTNEY... Bill McCartney (Missouri '62) is in his ninth season at the reins of the CU football program, and has compiled a 49-46-2 record through eight-plus campaigns. (It's the first time in his tenure that CU has been three games above .500.) "Mac" is 42-21-1 over the last four-plus seasons, and is 35-12-1 since the start of the 1986 conference season.) He is 5-3 against his alma mater, having won the last five times out against the Tigers. "Mac" has been the Buff pilot for 97 games, topped only by Eddie Crowder (119), Dal Ward (110) and Fred Folsom (102). Those same three and Myron Witham are also the only ones ahead of McCartney in number of seasons coached (Folsom 15, Witham 12, Ward and Crowder 11 each) and in victories (Folsom 77, Crowder 67, Witham and Ward 63 each). In the Big Eight, Mac is 29-26-1 in conference games (25-10 since 1985), and is second only to Tom Osborne of Nebraska in longevity in the league.

BIENIEMY WATCH... Senior tailback Eric Bieniemy is in position to become the all-time CU rushing leader, as he needs just 129 yards today to surpass Charlie Davis' mark of 2,958 yards set between 1971 and 1973. "EB" has 2,830 career yards; for the year, he's averaging 129.5 yards per game. He is also in fourth place on the scoring list (188 points), and is poised to move into second with just one touchdown. Bobby Anderson is the career leader with 212 points, with Byron White second with 191 and Tom Field third with 190. Eric surpassed Davis for the most games in a career gaining 100 or more yards last week. The Washington game marked the 14th time in his career that he accomplished the feat, topping Davis' previous CU record of 13.

Eric Bieniemy is first in the Big Eight and sixth in the nation in rushing (129.5 per game), and he also leads the conference in all-purpose yardage (149.5). He is 14th nationally in that category (Mike Pritchard is fifth in the conference and 44th in the NCAA in all-purpose yards). Darian Hagan is fourth in the league in total offense (175.0). Tom Rouen is first in the league in punting (42.6), and is 13th nationally. Tim James is first in the Big Eight in interceptions (four, .8 per game), and is tied for 10th nationally. Dave McCloughan is second in the league in punt returns (16.0), which places him 18th in the country.
