PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - WEEK SIX

OFFENSE: Josh Nunes, QB, Stanford

DEFENSE: Kameron Jackson, DB, California

SPECIAL TEAMS: Randall Telfer, TE, USC

WALNUT CREEK, Calif.-- Quarterback **Josh Nunes** of STANFORD, defensive back **Kameron Jackson** of California and tight end **Randall Telfer** of USC have been named Pac-12 Players of the Week in football.

Nunes, a senior from Greensboro, N.C., completed 21 of 34 passes for a career-high 360 yards and accounted for five touchdowns as Stanford overcame a 14-point fourth quarter deficit to tip Arizona in overtime, 54-48. He ran for three touchdowns--the first, second and third rushing touchdowns of his career--scrambled for gains of 10 yards or more on two third-and-long situations that sustained eventual touchdown drives. Nunes, a Davey O'Brien Quarterback of the Week honorable mention selection, threw for 117 yards and picked up six passing first downs in the final frame.

Jackson, a sophomore from Long Beach, Calif., came off the bench and registered a Pac-12 single-game-high-tying three interceptions (Oregon State's senior CB Jordan Poyer also had three interceptions in a 19-6 win over Washington State) to go along with four tackles and a pass breakup in a 43-17 win over No. 25 UCLA. Jackson's first-career interception, a momentum-changer, came in the Cal endzone in the final minute of the first half and preserved 16-7 margin at the break. He added two picks in the fourth quarter to put the game out of reach.

Telfer, a sophomore from Rancho Cucamonga, Calif., blocked a potential game-tying 48-yard field goal try at the end of the first half of a 38-28 victory over Utah. His second-career block came on the heels of a 56-yard Utah drive and secured a 24-21 halftime lead for the Trojans. Telfer also made a spectacular one-handed 23-yard touchdown grab in the second quarter.

Also nominated for offensive player of the week honors were quarterbacks **Matt Scott** of ARIZONA, **Zach Maynard** of CALIFORNIA, **Marcus Mariota** of Oregon and **Matt Barkley** of USC, running back **Johnathan Franklin** of UCLA, and wide receiver **Markus Wheaton** of OREGON STATE. Also nominated on defense were defensive backs **Jordan Poyer** of OREGON STATE and **Nickell Robey** of USC, linebacker **Kiko Alonso** of OREGON, and defensive end **Cassius Marsh** of UCLA.

AROUND THE PAC-12

PAC-12 MEN'S BASKETBALL MEDIA DAY: Pac-12 Men's Basketball Media Day is Thursday, November 1, 9 a.m. - 4 p.m., and will take place in San Francisco at Pac-12 Enterprises. Media will need to complete the credential application at <http://pac12.me/bkb-credentials>. **Deadline** for the credential application is **October 18**. The application also includes hotel information (deadline for room reservations is October 11).

RECORD SETTING PERFORMANCE: Arizona senior QB **Matt Scott** set Pac-12 records for completions and attempts when he connected on 45 of 69 passes in the 54-48 OT loss at Stanford. The previous records were 43 completions (California's Rich Campbell vs. Florida, 1980) and 68 attempts (Steve Smith, Stanford vs. Notre Dame, 1989). Scott threw for 491 yards, third best single-game total in Arizona history and 12th all-time in the Pac-12. Arizona coach Rich Rodriguez's postgame comment on Scott's record attempts, "He'll be all right, they got ice for his arm."

ARIZONA STATE (4-1) at COLORADO (1-4)

Thurs., Oct. 11, 7 p.m. MT - ESPN
ASU leads, 3-0-0. Last game: ASU, 48-14 (2011)

Colorado is 2-0 in Thursday night games at Folsom Field, having notched wins over Stanford on September 6, 1990 and No. 21 West Virginia on September 18, 2008. Colorado offensive coordinator **Eric Bieniemy** played a significant role in the outcome of the former, scoring on fourth-and-goal from the one with 12 seconds remaining to give the Buffs a 21-17 win in their first-ever home Thursday night tilt.

Arizona State's defense has been tough inside its own 20-yard line this season, holding opponents to a 69.2 red zone scoring percentage to rank second in the Pac-12 and 22nd nationally. Colorado has been very efficient in the red area this season, having converted on 12 of 14 trips. With 11 of those scores resulting in touchdowns, the Buffs own a 78.57 touchdown percentage in the red zone, a figure that ranks first in the Pac-12 and second in the FBS.

ASU has three players ranked in the top 40 in the country sacks per game— junior DT **Will Sutton** (1.10), sophomore LB **Carl Bradford** (0.90) and junior DE **Junior Onyeali** (0.80). The trio combined for six sacks in their last outing, a 27-17 win over California.

UTAH (2-3) at UCLA (4-2)

Sat., Oct. 13, 12 noon PT - FOX
UCLA leads, 8-2-0. Last game: UTAH, 31-6 (2011)

UCLA senior RB **Johnathan Franklin** added another 100-yard game to his resume, his fifth in six games this year, with a 102-yard effort at California. He's now tied for third on UCLA's career 100-yard rushing list with 15 such games, trailing Bruins Freeman McNeil (17, 1977-80) and Gaston Green (20, 1984-87).

Utah starting sophomore WR **Dres Anderson's** father Flipper played wide receiver for UCLA from 1984-87. He led the Bruins in receiving yards in 1986 and 1987 and ranks 10th in school history with 2,023 yards. A second-round draft pick, he played in the NFL for 10 years.

Utah is third in the conference and 35th in the nation in total defense (350.0), and fourth and 26th, respectively in rushing defense (114.8). The Utes also have forced an FBS-leading 13 fumbles . . . Meanwhile, UCLA is third in the Pac-12 and 8th in the nation in total defense (529.0 ypg), and second and 21st, respectively in the nation in rushing offense (224.3 ypg).

OREGON STATE (4-0) at BYU (4-2)

Sat., Oct. 13, 1:30 p.m. MT - ABC
Series tied, 5-5-0. Last game: BYU, 38-28 (2011)

OSU sits at No. 10 in this week's AP poll, it's highest ranking in more than a decade. The Beavers last cracked the top ten in the media poll on August 26, 2001 when they also checked in at No. 10. . .

Oregon State's vaunted passing attack will test BYU's secondary (12th-ranked pass defense in FBS), but it will be junior QB **Cody Vaz** leading the attack in place of injured **Sean Mannion**. The Beavers have managed 339.5 yards per game through the air this season (2nd in Pac-12/8th in the FBS). OSU has registered more than 40 pass attempts in three of its four games this season. BYU, which has only surrendered two passing touchdowns this season has faced 30 pass attempts or more in just two games.

Oregon State senior WR **Markus Wheaton** had 9 receptions for 95 yards and 1 TD in the win over Washington State.

BYU head coach Bronco Mendenhall is an alumnus of Oregon State, where he played safety and linebacker from 1986-87. He began his coaching career in Corvallis as a graduate assistant in 1989-90.

STANFORD (4-1) at Notre Dame (5-0)

Sat., Oct. 13, 3:30 p.m. ET - NBC
Notre Dame leads, 17-9-0. Last game: STAN, 28-14 (2011)

In facing No. 7 Notre Dame, the Cardinal are facing their fourth straight opponent who is ranked, or has been ranked, in the Top 25 this season. Stanford has won three straight over Notre Dame, the longest string of victories for the Cardinal in the series.

Senior TE **Levine Toilolo** hauled in five receptions for 141 yards in the 54-48 OT win over Arizona. This season, he has 13 receptions for 278 yards for an impressive 21.4 yards per catch. . . Senior RB **Stepfan Taylor** rushed for 142 yards and 2 TDs against the Wildcats. It was his 16th 100-yard game, second all-time at Stanford behind only Toby Gerhart (20). . . Senior QB **Josh Nunes** competed 21-of-34 for a career-high 360 yards and 2 TDs in the victory over Arizona. He also rushed for 33 yards and added 3 TDs on the ground.

USC (4-1) at WASHINGTON (3-2)

Sat., Oct. 13, 4 p.m. PT - FOX
USC leads, 50-28-4. Last game: USC, 40-17 (2011)

For the fourth time this season, Washington will be facing an opponent ranked in the AP Top 15 when it meets No. 11 USC. The last time these two teams met in Seattle, the Huskies pulled off a 16-13 upset of No. 3 USC during the 2009 season.

Husky sophomore RB **Bishop Sankey** posted his third consecutive 100-yard rushing day with 104 yards against Oregon. . . Sophomore WR **Kasen Williams** has collected 16 receptions for 177 yards over the last two games.

USC could set the school record for consecutive games without being shut out; the last time the Trojans were blanked was, ironically, at Washington in 1997 (the Huskies also snapped USC's original record in 1983 in Seattle). The Trojans have not been shut out in its past 186 games, tying the school record for most consecutive games without being shut out first set from 1967 to 1983

Senior QB **Matt Barkley** is 4 TDs shy of the Pac-12 career touchdown pass record (99, Matt Leinart, USC 2003-05). . . Junior WR **Robert Woods** is 9 catches away from the USC career receptions mark (216, Dwayne Jarrett, 2004-06), while sophomore WR **Marqise Lee** has caught at least 8 passes in each of the past 9 games.

CALIFORNIA (2-4) at WASHINGTON STATE (2-4)

Sat., Oct. 13, 7:30 p.m. PT - P12N
CAL leads, 43-25-5. Last game: CAL, 30-7 (2011)

California has won seven straight over the Washington State. Junior WR **Keenan Allen** continues his way up Cal's receiving charts. He now has 185 career receptions. That total ranks third all-time at Cal. Up next is Dameane Douglas (195 rec., 1995-98). He also has 2,300 career receiving yards, which ranks sixth all-time at Cal (Brian Treggs and Douglas are tied for fifth with 2,335 career receiving yards). . . Senior QB **Zach Maynard** had his most productive outing as he was responsible for a career-high five touchdowns in Cal's 43-17 win over No. 25 UCLA. He tossed a career-high-tying four TD passes and ran for another score. He finished 25-of-30 overall for a season-high 295 yards with an 83.3 completion percentage and 203.27 efficiency rating, both career highs.

WSU senior DE **Travis Long** added another sack last weekend to his league-leading 7.5 sacks. He had four all of last season and his career total now stands at 18.5 sacks. . . WSU junior WR **Marquess Wilson** needs 53 yards to hit 3,000 career receiving yards, joining 15 others in Pac-12 history who have eclipsed 3,000 receiving yards. . . Junior PK **Andrew Furney** is 9-of-11 on FGs this season, and 26-of-32 (.813) for his career. His career percentage is currently tops in school history.

USC TABBED TO WIN PAC-12 TITLE IN PRESEASON MEDIA POLL

UNIVERSAL CITY, Calif. - USC is the favorite to win the 2012 Pac-12 Conference football title in a preseason poll of media members who cover the league. The Trojans were listed in the top spot in the North Division by 117 of the 123 voters participating in the poll, collecting 729 points. 102 of those pollsters tabbed the Trojans to come out on top in the Pac-12 Championship Game. Utah was picked to finish second in the South Division, collecting one first-place vote in the balloting for the division race. Arizona State claimed three of the other five first-place votes, with each of those members of the media casting a vote for the Sun Devils to capture the Pac-12 title.

Oregon was picked to win the North Division, garnering 732 points and 117 first place votes, while Stanford, which tallied five of the other six first place votes, was pegged to finish second in this year's poll. California, predicted by the voters to finish fourth in the North Division, claimed the remaining first place vote.

The media poll has correctly selected the Conference Champion in 28 of 51 previous polls, including 11 of the last 12. Following are the results of the preseason media poll (points 6-5-4-3-2-1, first-place votes in parentheses):

PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

The Pac-12 Championship Football Game will take place Friday, November 30 at 8 p.m. ET/5 p.m. PT and telecast to a national audience on FOX. The Championship game will match the winner of the North Division vs. the winner of the South Division. The game will be played on the campus of the division winner with the best overall conference record. The winner of the Pac-12 Championship will earn the league's automatic BCS berth.

TIE-BREAK PROCEDURES TO DETERMINE AND CHAMPIONSHIP GAME PARTICIPANTS & HOST

The division winner will be determined by the record in all games played (both divisional and cross-divisional) within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game representatives from each division:

Two-Team Tie.

1. Head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
 - a. If no game is played between the two tied teams or that game ends in a tie, the following tie-breaking procedures would be applied:
2. Record in games played within the division
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (Based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.
6. Total number of wins in a 12-game season. The following conditions will apply to the calculation of the total number of wins:
 - a. Only one win against a team from the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision or lower division will be counted annually.
 - b. Any games that are exempted from counting against the annual maximum number of football contests per NCAA rules (current Bylaw 17.9.5.2) shall not be included.
7. Coin toss.

Multiple-Team Ties.

The following procedures will only be used to eliminate all but two teams, at which point the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

1. Head-to-head (Best record in games among the tied teams).
2. Record in games played within the division.
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.

Pac-12 Championship Game Host

The Pac-12 Championship Game Host will be determined by the record in all games played within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game host.

Tie-breaking Procedure.

1. Head-to-head, if applicable.
2. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of Pac-12 regular-season games.
3. Record against the next highest-placed common opponent in the conference (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the conference.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Coin toss.

PAC-12 BOWL ARRANGEMENTS - 2012-13

The Pac-12 is in the third year of a four-year bowl cycle. The Pac-12 Conference has agreements with seven bowl partners. The lineup is led by the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, which is the destination for the Pac-12 champion, unless said champion is ranked No. 1 or No. 2 in the final Bowl Championship Series rankings. If that were the case, the Pac-12 champion would play in the BCS National Championship Game hosted by the Discover Orange Bowl. Regardless of the disposition of the Pac-12 champion, a second Pac-12 team may be selected for an at-large berth in the Bowl Championship Series in any given year and other Pac-12 bowl partner arrangements provide for that occurrence. In addition to the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, Pac-12 bowl partners include, in order of selection, the Valero Alamo Bowl in San Antonio, Bridgeport Education Holiday Bowl in San Diego, Hyundai Sun Bowl in El Paso, the MAACO Bowl Las Vegas, the Kraft Fight Hunger Bowl in San Francisco, and the Gildan New Mexico Bowl in Albuquerque.
