Gillam set a CU freshman record (true or redshirt) with 18 tackles in Colorado's 57-16 loss to Oregon. In 86 plays, he had 14 unassisted stops, which included two tackles for loss, one a quarterback sack, along with a tackle for zero to give him three at or behind the line of scrimmage. He also had four third down stops, giving him 11 on the year (four games). He is CU's leading tackler with 51 on the year (32 solo).

# 2013 NFFCC NEWS & NOTES

## ADAMS STATE UNIVERSITY (3-2, 1-2 RMAC)

**Team Notes:** Adams State travelled to Chadron State this past weekend for the Eagles Homecoming Game. Due to a severe snowstorm, the game was moved to Sunday. The Grizzlies lost that match up, 31-0. They will face Black Hills State this Saturday at home for Homecoming.

## COLORADO MESA UNIVERSITY (3-2, 2-1 RMAC)

**Team Notes:** Colorado Mesa won their second straight league game after posting a 22-17 home win over New Mexico Highlands. The Mavericks will play Western New Mexico on Saturday.

## COLORADO SCHOOL OF MINES (3-2, 2-1 RMAC)

### Ian McFadden (Junior, Defensive Back, 5-11, 190, Mesa, Ariz./Red Mountain HS)

McFadden led the Oredigger defensive unit in the squad's 25-22 loss at Western New Mexico on Saturday with nine tackles. Eight of his stops were solo tackles and the junior added 2.0 tackles for loss for a total of seven yards. He added a safety late in the fourth quarter and added a pass break up as well.

**Team Notes:** Colorado Mines lost to Western New Mexico by a 25-22 final on Saturday afternoon at Ben Altamirano Field in Silver City, N.M. The loss dropped Mines' record on the season to 3-2, including a 2-1 mark in the RMAC. Joe Schneider led the offense with 125 yards through the air on 12-of-31 passing and a touchdown. Matt Brown finished 10-of-26 for 93 yards. Tevin Champagne led the rushing attack with 61 carries on 12 attempts, while Schneider added 49 yards on six carries and a touchdown. Brown added 48 yards on 11 carries while Dan Palmer rushed for 35 yards on 11 carries as well. Ty Young led Mines' receiving corps with 67 yards on five receptions, while Alex Waner and Court Pietra posted 29 and 23 yards, respectively, on four catches apiece. Avery Llewellyn finished 2-for-2 on field goals and added 280 yards on six punts (46.7 yards per punt) with a long of 62 yards. Jimmy Ellis added 129 all-purpose yards, with 126 coming on a total of seven returns (four punts, three kickoffs). Jake Utley led the defense with 10 stops on the afternoon, while McFadden added nine and two tackles for loss with a safety. Tyler Denson, the reigning RMAC Defensive Player of the Week, added eight stops while Kole Kadavy and Ryan Griffith each added seven with Kadavy also recording a sack for a loss of seven yards. Mines will return to the friendly confines of Campbell Field on Saturday when the squad hosts Fort Lewis at noon.

## COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY (2-3, 0-0 MWC)

**Team Notes:** CSU did not play last week. The Rams will play at home this Saturday against San Jose State.

## COLORADO STATE UNIVERSITY - PUEBLO (5-0, 3-0 RMAC)

### Kieren Duncan (Sophomore, Wide Receiver, 5-11, 156, Goodyear, Ariz./Millennium HS)

Duncan recorded 161 all purpose yards in #5 ThunderWolves' 35-3 win over Fort Lewis during CSU-Pueblo's homecoming. He recorded a 41 yard reverse to set up a score, his second rush of 40-plus yards this season. Duncan recorded his first career 100 yard receiving game by going for a career-high eight catches for 118 yards. Through five games, Duncan has 615 all-purpose yards, averaging 123 ypg.

**Team Notes:** CSU-Pueblo defeated Fort Lewis 35-3 at its homecoming game Saturday, starting 5-0 for the fourth straight season. CSU-Pueblo has now won 31 straight regular season games and 25 straight RMAC games (2 off of Chadron State's record of 27 from 2006-09). The ThunderWolves have recorded 500 or more yards of offense in each game this season. Through three RMAC games, CSU-Pueblo has scored an average of 42.3 PPG while giving up just 5.7 PPG.

## FORT LEWIS COLLEGE (2-3, 1-2 RMAC)

### Joey Alvarez (Senior, Linebacker, 6-0, 205, Everett Alvarez HS)

Alvarez led the Skyhawks defense in a 35-3 loss at No. 5 CSU-Pueblo Saturday afternoon. Eight of his 11 tackles were solo stops. Near the end of the first quarter, Alvarez forced a fumble and recovered the ball. He leads the team with 42 tackles and 28 solo tackles.
