The Pac-12 posted has posted a winning record outside league play for the 30th consecutive season . . . Since 1934, only one season witnessed the Conference capture more than 29 wins in non-league play - 2002 (32-15) when the league played an eight game conference schedule, allowing an additional 10 non-conference games to be played.

PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OFFENSE: Marcus Mariota, QB, Oregon

DEFENSE: Trent Murphy, LB, Stanford

SPECIAL TEAMS: Ty Montgomery, WR/KR, Stanford

Quarterback **Marcus Mariota** of OREGON, linebacker **Trent Murphy** of STANFORD and wide receiver/kick returner **Ty Montgomery**, also of Stanford, have been named Pac-12 Players of the Week in football.

Mariota, a sophomore from Honolulu, Hawai'i, set a school record with 42 points accounted for in Oregon's 57-16 win at Colorado on Saturday. He completed 16 of 27 passes for 355 yards and five touchdowns. Mariota also ran for an additional 43 yards and two more scores. He is eighth in the country in passing efficiency (176.30 QB rating) and ninth in total offense (339.20 ypg), helping Oregon to a No. 2 national ranking in total offense (630.40 ypg).

Murphy, a senior from Mesa, Ariz., recorded six tackles, including 2.5 tackles for loss and two sacks, in Stanford's narrow 31-28 win over Washington at home on Saturday night. He also deflected a pass that led to a Stanford interception that ended a Huskies' drive late in the fourth quarter. The forced turnover proved to be pivotal in the Cardinal's three-point victory.

Montgomery, a junior from Tahlequah, Okla., set a school-record with 204 kickoff return yards that included a 99-yard kickoff return for a touchdown to open the game against Washington. He added a 39-yard touchdown reception and ended the game with 290 all-purpose yards on nine carries (32.2 yards per touch). Montgomery currently ranks sixth in the nation in all-purpose yards (176.6 ypg).

Also nominated for offensive player of the week honors were quarterbacks **Brett Hundley** of UCLA and **Connor Halliday** of WASHINGTON STATE; and wide receivers **Jaalen Strong** of ARIZONA STATE, **Chris Harper** of CALIFORNIA, and **Dres Anderson** of UTAH. Also nominated for defensive player of the week honors were linebackers **Addison Gillam** of COLORADO, **Eric Kendricks** of UCLA and **Jared Norris** of UTAH; safety **Deone Bucannon** of Washington State; and defensive back **Damarius Randall** of Arizona State. Also nominated for special teams player of the week honors were kickers **Zane Gonzalez** of Arizona State, **Ka'imi Fairbairn** of UCLA and **Andy Phillips** of Utah.

AROUND THE PAC-12

GAME THEMES: USC interim head coach **Ed Orgeron** makes his debut as the Trojans host ARIZONA with both teams looking for their first win in Pac-12 play . . . ESPN's Game Day visits Seattle where No. 16 WASHINGTON takes on its second straight ranked foe in No. 2 OREGON and a Duck offense that averages 630.4 yards per game and 59.2 points per game . . . No. 5 STANFORD visits Salt Lake City for the third time ever as the Cardinal take on UTAH and looks to extend its 13-game winning streak, which is the second-longest in the FBS . . . ARIZONA STATE looks to keep pace in the Pac-12 South . . . A couple of young signal-callers go toe-to-toe in the Rose Bowl as CALIFORNIA freshman **Jared Goff** (364.2 passing yards per game) goes up against No. 11 UCLA and sophomore **Brett Hundley**, who has guided the Bruins to 561.8 yards per game and 48.0 points per game . . . Alert the FAA in Pullman. OREGON STATE's **Sean Mannion** and his FBS leading 403.6 passing yards visit WASHINGTON STATE where **Connor Halliday** has thrown for 332.2 yards per game. The two have combined to complete 349 of 528 pass attempts for 4,011 yards and 34 TDs.

ARMS RACE: Pac-12 quarterbacks continue to put up impressive numbers each weekend. Washington State's **Connor Halliday** (521 yards) and California's **Jared Goff** (504 yards) combined for 1,025 passing yards in WSU's 44-22 win at Cal. It was the most passing yards by two opposing players in a Conference game . . . Four Pac-12 quarterbacks ranked among the top eight in the FBS in passing yards per game - No.1 Oregon State's **Sean Mannion** (403.6 ypg), No. 3 California's Goff (364.2 ypg), No.5 Arizona State's **Taylor Kelly** (346.4 ypg) and No. 8 Washington State's Halliday (332.2 ypg) . . . Washington's **Keith Price** leads the Pac-12 and is 10th in the FBS in completion percentage (.713) . . . Oregon's **Marcus Mariota** leads the Pac-12 and is eighth in the FBS in passing efficiency (176.3) . . . Mannion (26.4 ppg) and Mariota (25.2 ppg) rank 1-2 in points responsible for per game, while UCLA's **Brett Hundley** ranks 10th (19.5 ppg).

DEFENSIVE SUPPORT: Eight Pac-12 players posted double digit tackles last week, led by Arizona State junior DB **Damarius Randall** with a Pac-12 season-high 17 tackles vs. Notre Dame . . . Colorado freshman LB **Addison Gillam** posted 15 tackles vs. Oregon to up his league-leading total to 12.2 tackles per game . . . Washington State senior CB **Deone Bucannon** tallied 12 tackles, the 14th double-digit total for his career, and averages 9.3 per game this season . . . Stanford senior LB **Shayne Skov** collected 14 tackles and leads the Cardinal with 8.4 per game . . . UCLA junior LB **Eric Kendricks** notched 13 tackles at Utah and is second in the league with 9.8 tackles per game . . . Utah sophomore LB **Jared Norris** posted 12 tackles, with 2.5 for loss, including 2.0 sacks in the loss to UCLA. Teammates **Trevor Reilly** and **Jason Whittingham** added 11 and 10 tackles respectively.

ARIZONA (3-1, 0-1) at USC (3-2, 0-2)

ARIZONA: While the Wildcats have won just four times vs. USC in Los Angeles. The last six games between these two teams have been decided by a touchdown or less . . . Arizona ranks ninth nationally in scoring defense (14.3 ppg) . . . Junior RB **Ka'Deem Carey** ranks second in the Pac-12 and is fifth nationally in rushing with 143.7 ypg . . . As a team, Arizona ranks second in the league and 10th nationally in rushing, averaging 291.5 yards per game.

USC: The Trojans take the field for the first time with interim head coach Ed Orgeron at the helm . . . USC TBs **Tre Madden** (128) and **Justin Davis** (122) both eclipsed 100 rushing yards in the Trojan's last outing at Arizona State. It was Madden's fourth 100-yard outing of the year and he currently is 13th nationally in rushing (116.6 ypg) . . . Junior WR **Marqise Lee** set the school career receiving yardage record (3,249 yds) and moved to No. 2 on USC's all-time receptions list (221 rec), but he hurt his knee at ASU.

LAST TIME: Arizona's Matt Scott piled up 469 yards of total offense and four TDs as the Wildcats fought back from a 15-point second half deficit for a 39-36 win in Tucson. USC had record setting performances from Matt Barkley, who threw for a school-record 493 yards, while Marqise Lee posted a Pac-12 record 345 receiving yards and 469 all-purpose yards.

No. 2 OREGON (5-0, 2-0) at No. 16 WASHINGTON (4-1, 1-1)

OREGON: The Ducks have won nine straight in the series with Washington, the longest such streak for either team in the 105 meetings . . . Of Oregon's 42 scoring possessions, 33 have occurred in under 2:00 . . . UO's 755 yards of total offense at CU was the second-highest total in school history . . . Sophomore QB **Marcus Mariota** has now gone 202 attempts without an interception, breaking the former UO mark set by Kellen Clemens of 178 in 2004 . . . Mariota has tossed at least one TD pass in all 18 games of his career and has thrown for and run for a score in seven straight games . . . Sophomore WR **Bralon Addison** had a career-high 158 yards on five catches at CU, including a career-best 75-yard TD . . . Oregon has scored 50 or more points in five straight games.

WASHINGTON: Huskies take on their second top 5 ranked team in as many weeks when No. 2 Oregon visits Seattle . . . Senior QB **Keith Price** completed a career-best 33 of 48 passes for 350 yards and 2 TDs in the 31-28 loss at Stanford. He moved up the UW career lists for completions (638, 2nd) and extend his school record for TD passes to 65 (tied for 17th on the Pac-12 career list) . . . Junior RB **Bishop Sankey** leads the league and is fourth in the FBS averaging 146.4 ypg. With 2,358 rushing yards in his career, Sankey needs 24 yards to move into the UW's top 10 list.

LAST TIME: Oregon quarterback Marcus Mariota threw for 198 yards and four touchdowns to lead the No. 2-ranked Ducks to a 52-21 home victory over the No. 23-ranked Huskies. Kenyon Barner added 122 yards rushing.

No. 5 STANFORD (5-0, 3-0) at UTAH (3-2, 0-2)

STANFORD: The Cardinal make their third-ever visit to Salt Lake City, posting victories in both previous visits in 1902 (35-11) and 1995 (27-20) . . . Since World War II, Stanford has started its season 5-0 three times (2013, 2011, 1951) . . . Stanford has held opponents to 12 total points in the first quarter of games this season. Stanford's defense has not allowed a first-quarter TD this season . . . In the 31-28 win over Washington, junior WR **Ty Montgomery** finished with 56 yards and one touchdown on three receptions, rushed for 30 yards on two carries, returned opening kickoff for a career-best 99-yard touchdown and compiled 290 all-purpose yards (single-game career-high). His five TD receptions averaged 29.8 yards.

UTAH: Sophomore QB **Travis Wilson** completed 22-of-44 for 288 yards against UCLA. It was the seventh time in his career that he passed for over 200 yards, and he has passed for over 200 yards in all five games this year. Wilson's 54-yard touchdown pass to **Dres Anderson** was Utah's eighth play of 50 yards or more this season. It was Anderson's fourth TD of the season. He caught six balls for 106 yards giving him four-straight 100-yard receiving games . . . Freshman PK **Andy Phillips** remained perfect on the season, converting a 37-yarder and a 44-yarder to go 9-for-9 on the year.

LAST TIME: In a September 7, 1996 meeting between No. 25 Utah at Stanford, the Utes received 114 rushing yards from Juan Johnson, while Mike Fouts threw for 222 yards and a touchdown to hold off the Cardinal 17-10. Chad Hutchinson threw for 265 yards and a touchdown to rally Stanford from a 17-0 deficit in the fourth quarter.

COLORADO (2-2, 0-2) at ARIZONA STATE (3-2, 1-0)

COLORADO: Junior CB **Greg Henderson** is the first Buff to make two interceptions in the same game since Oct. 27, 2007. He now has four on the season, the most by a player since Terrence Wheatley had five in both 2006 and 2007 . . . Junior WR **Paul Richardson** had his fourth play of 50 yards or longer this season (55-yard reception to open the game). It was his third 100-yard game of the season, giving him six for his career. He also threw and completed his first career pass, going for a touchdown (75 yards to WR D.D. Goodson). For the year, Richardson now has 31 catches for 621 yards, 20.0 per, with five TDs . . . Colorado's 10 first quarter points were the most by an opponent in a quarter against UO this year . . . Colorado had 318 yards in the first half, just 2.5 yards shy of what Oregon came in allowing per game (320.5); but the Buffs managed just 56 after halftime.

ARIZONA STATE: Sophomore WR **Jaelen Strong** had 8 receptions for 136 yards and one touchdown in a 37-34 loss to Notre Dame. It was Strong's third-straight 100-plus yard receiving game and his third in four career games with a touchdown reception. Strong now has 39 catches for 569 yards and three touchdowns on the season. He is averaging 7.8 receptions (2nd in Pac-12) 14.6 yards per catch and 113.8 yards per game (4th in Pac-12) . . . Senior RB **Marion Grice** found the end zone again with a 16-yard TD reception vs. Notre Dame. He's posted and FBS-leading 13 TDs this season, averaging 15.6 points per game . . . Junior QB **Taylor Kelly** had his fifth game this season throwing for over 300 yards and now has eight such games in his career. Kelly is one of just three FBS quarterbacks to throw for over 300 yards in each game this season, joining Sean Mannion of Oregon State and Keith Wenning of Ball State.

LAST TIME: Holding a 20-17 halftime lead, Arizona State opened the second half with a 100-yard kickoff return to ignite the Sun Devils to 31 second half points and a 51-17 victory in Boulder. ASU's Taylor Kelly completed 20-of-28 for 308 yards and five touchdowns.

CALIFORNIA (1-4, 0-2) at No. 11 UCLA (4-0, 1-0)

CALIFORNIA: Freshman QB **Jared Goff** set a Cal single-game record with 504 passing yards in the loss to Washington State (previous record of 503 was held by Pat Barnes vs. Arizona, 1996 in 4 OT) . . . Sophomore WR **Chris Harper** pulled in a career-best 14 receptions for a career-high 231 yards against Washington State. His 89-yard touchdown pass from Goff was the second longest pass play in Cal history.

UCLA: The Bruins are 4-0 for the first time since 2005 . . . Sophomore QB **Brett Hundley** threw, caught and rushed for a touchdown in last Thursday's win over Utah. He threw for 211 yards and rushed for another 85 yards, leaving himself 4 yards short of reaching the 300-yard mark in total offense for the fourth time in four games this season . . . The Bruins picked off six Utah passes. UCLA had just one interception in the first three games this season.

LAST TIME: Bears quarterback Zach Maynard completed 25-of-30 passes for 295 yards and four touchdowns, and added a fifth on the ground, as California forced six turnovers to defeat No. 25 UCLA, 43-17 in Berkeley.

OREGON STATE (4-1, 2-0) at WASHINGTON STATE (4-2, 1-1)

OREGON STATE: Over the last three games, junior QB **Sean Mannion** is averaging 408 yards through the air with 14 TD passes, while junior WR **Brandin Cooks** is averaging 173 receiving yards with 5 TDs during that same span of games . . . For two teams that like to sling it, the defenses get their fair share of interceptions. The Beavers have eight picks, while Washington State leads the league with nine interceptions.

WASHINGTON STATE: Junior QB **Connor Halliday** completed a career-high 41 passes in a WSU single-game record 67 attempts for a career-high 521 yards and three TDs in the win over Cal. He's the second Cougar all-time to throw for 500 yards in a game (Alex Brink, 531 yds vs. Oregon State, 2005) . . . Halliday also set a WSU single-game record for total offense with 516 yards, which was one more yard than Brink posted at Oregon State in 2005 . . . Halliday connected with 12 different receivers against California, which has been the norm for the season. Eight different Cougars are averaging better than 2.0 receptions per game, while seven different players are posting at least 10.0 yards per catch.

LAST TIME: A defensive battle took place in Corvallis as the Beavers stymied Washington State on the way to a 19-6 victory. Oregon State forced five turnovers, including three interceptions by Jordan Poyer. Scott Crichton added three sacks as OSU limited the Cougars to 20 rushing yards.

The game will be played on the campus of the division winner with the best overall conference record. The winner of the Pac-12 Championship will earn the league's automatic BCS berth.

TIE-BREAK PROCEDURES TO DETERMINE DIVISION CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP GAME HOST

The Division Champion will be determined by the record in all games played (both divisional and cross-divisional) within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game representatives

Two-Team Tie.

1. Head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
 - a. If no game is played between the two tied teams or that game ends in a tie, the following tie-breaking procedures would be applied:
2. Record in games played within the division
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (Based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.
6. Total number of wins in a 12-game season. The following conditions will apply to the calculation of the total number of wins:
 - a. Only one win against a team from the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision or lower division will be counted annually.
 - b. Any games that are exempted from counting against the annual maximum number of football contests per NCAA rules (current Bylaw 17.9.5.2) shall not be included.
7. Coin toss.

Multiple-Team Ties.

The following procedures will only be used to eliminate all but two teams, at which point the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

1. Head-to-head (Best record in games among the tied teams).
2. Record in games played within the division.
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.

Pac-12 Championship Game Host

The Pac-12 Championship Game Host will be determined by the record in all games played within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game host.

Tie-breaking Procedure.

1. Head-to-head, if applicable.
2. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of Pac-12 regular-season games.
3. Record against the next highest-placed common opponent in the conference (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the conference.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Coin toss.

PAC-12 BOWL ARRANGEMENTS - 2013-14

The Pac-12 is in the final year of a four-year bowl cycle. The Pac-12 Conference has agreements with seven bowl partners. The lineup is led by the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, which is the destination for the Pac-12 champion, unless said champion is ranked No. 1 or No. 2 in the final Bowl Championship Series rankings. If that were the case, the Pac-12 champion would play in the BCS National Championship Game hosted by the Discover Orange Bowl. Regardless of the disposition of the Pac-12 champion, a second Pac-12 team may be selected for an at-large berth in the Bowl Championship Series in any given year and other Pac-12 bowl partner arrangements provide for that occurrence. In addition to the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, Pac-12 bowl partners include, in order of selection, the Valero Alamo Bowl in San Antonio, Bridgeport Education Holiday Bowl in San Diego, Hyundai Sun Bowl in El Paso, the Las Vegas Bowl, the Kraft Fight Hunger Bowl in San Francisco, and the Gildan New Mexico Bowl in Albuquerque.
