ARIZONA receivers **Dan Buckner** (10-142, 1 TD) and **Austin Hill** (8-128), ARIZONA STATE's **Aaron Pflugrad** (8-180, 2 TDs), CALIFORNIA's **Keenan Allen** (6-104 1 TD), COLORADO's **Paul Richardson** (11-284, 2 TDs), STANFORD's **Chris Owusu** (7-106, 1 TD), USC's **Robert Woods** (8-102), UTAH's **DeVonte Christopher** (11-136, 1 TD), WASHINGTON's **Devin Aguilar** (5-131, 1 TD), and WASHINGTON STATE's **Marquess Wilson** (5-102, 1 TD).

WALNUT CREEK, Calif.--Wide receiver **Paul Richardson** of Colorado, linebacker **Cort Dennison** of Washington and defensive tackle **Everette Thompson** of Washington have been named Bank of the West Pac-12 Players of the Week in football.

Richardson, a sophomore from Gardena, Calif., caught 11 passes for 284 yards and two touchdowns (66, 78 yards) in CU's heartbreaking overtime loss to California, 36-33 in Boulder; 10 of his 11 catches earned first downs (school record for a receiver), 162 of the yards came after the catch and he had 297 all-purpose yards including one rush for 9 yards and a punt return for 4 yards. He set the Colorado record for the most receiving yards in a single game, and third most all-time in Pac-12 history, with the 284 yards (the third 200-plus game in CU history), and tied the CU single game reception mark of 11. It was also his fourth two-TD game, third most ever at CU. Richardson now has six career plays of 50 yards or longer, and his 10 career TD catches have covered 362 yards (3, 60, 62, 4, 3, 50, 15, 21, 66, 78).

Dennison, a senior from Salt Lake City, Utah, led all players with 12 total tackles in the Washington's 40-32 win over Hawaii. Ten of his 12 tackles were solo stops. Additionally, Dennison provided a key play when he stripped the ball from a Hawaii receiver on the UW 12-yard line at the end of a 34-yard reception. Washington recovered the fumble and drove for the game's second score, a touchdown. The Huskies limited Hawai'i to 55 yards rushing (2.2 ypc).

Thompson, a senior from Renton, Wash., and a starting defensive tackle, blocked two PAT attempts in the Huskies' 40-32 win over Hawaii. The second was key to the game as Hawaii had just scored a touchdown with 1:39 remaining in the game to cut the score to 38-32. That blocked PAT was picked up and returned for a two-point defensive conversion by UW cornerback Desmond Trufant to give Washington an eight-point lead. Thompson also contributed three tackles, including a sack.

Also nominated for offensive player of the week honors were quarterbacks **Zach Maynard** of California, **Darron Thomas** of Oregon, **Andrew Luck** of Stanford, **Keith Price** of Washington, and **Marshall Lobbestael** of Washington State, running backs **Derrick Coleman** of UCLA and **Marc Tyler** of USC, wide receivers **Aaron Pflugrad** of Arizona State and **DeVonte Christopher** of Utah. Also nominated on defense were linebackers **Colin Parker** of Arizona State, **D.J. Holt** of California, **Michael Clay** of Oregon, **Chase Thomas** of Stanford, **Sean Westgate** of UCLA, **Dion Bailey** of USC and **Matt Martinez** of Utah. Also nominated for special teams play were punters **Josh Hubner** of Arizona State and **Bryan Anger** of California, place kickers **Will Oliver** of Colorado, **Jordan Williamson** of Stanford and **Kip Smith** of UCLA, running back/punt returner **LaMichael James** of Oregon, and tackle **Matt Kalil** of USC.

Buffalo Notes: Colorado had 474 yards passing vs. Cal, tying for the second most passing yards in CU history (also vs. San Jose State, 1999), and behind only 533 against NE Louisiana in 1995. . . Senior QB **Tyler Hansen** set a record for the most passing yards in a single game with 474, the 10th 400-yard game in school history, and tied the mark for the most total offense with 500 yards. Hansen's 49 attempts is also a record for the most in a single game without throwing an interception; the old mark was 44, set by Cody Hawkins at Oklahoma last year. . . Went from allowing seven sacks at Hawai'i to zero vs. California; the downside of that is it marked the first time the Buffs have ever lost a game when not committing a turnover or allowing a sack; CU is 14-1 since 1972 in such situations. . . PK **Will Oliver** became just the second freshman to kick a 50-yard or longer field goal in school history, with his 52-yard boot in the second quarter vs. California the longest ever by a frosh.

Duck Notes: In the 69-20 win over Nevada, junior QB Darron Thomas connected on 13-of-19 passes for 295 yards, tying a school record with 6 TDs (also held by Joey Harrington {2} and Danny O'Neil). He set an Oregon record for most TD passes in one half (5 in the first half). His pass efficiency rating of 303.05 vs. Nevada was the highest in the Pac-12 and fourth-highest in college football since 2005 (Minimum 15 attempts vs. FBS opponents). The last QB with a higher mark was Notre Dame's Jimmy Clauson (303.66) – also against Nevada – Sept. 9, 2009. . . Junior RB **LaMichael James** returned a punt for a 58-yard TD - his first special teams TD of his career.

Bruin Notes: After having 0 carries in the first half, senior TB **Derrick Coleman** tallied 135 total rushing yards on 14 carries, averaging 9.6 yards per run in the final two quarters of the Bruins' victory over San Jose State. In the fourth quarter, he rushed for 77 yards on 11 carries, capped off by a 24-yard touchdown run to push UCLA's lead to 27-17. Coleman also had the longest rush of the day for the Bruins (42 yards). He also had two tackles on special teams. . . Junior TB **Johnathan Franklin** added 81 yards on 16 carries to bolster the Bruin rushing attack. As a team, UCLA rushed for 272 yards on 42 carries (6.5 yards per carry)

Husky Notes: This is the third game in a year between the Huskies and Cornhuskers. Nebraska defeated the Huskies in Seattle on Sept. 18, but Washington turned the tables in the Holiday Bowl with a 19-7

victory on Dec. 30. . . Senior WR **Jermaine Kearse** caught a pair of TD passes in the win over Hawai'i, bringing his career total to 24 TD receptions. That ranks second all-time in the Husky record book, trailing Mario Bailey who posted 30 TD catches from 1988-91. . . The Huskies rank seventh nationally in rushing defense, allowing just 43.0 yards per game. They'll be challenged this week at Nebraska as the Cornhuskers average 224 yards on the ground (24th nationally).

Sophomore WR **Keenan Allen** has posted back-to-back games with 100 receiving yards. His 216 receiving yards on 14 catches is nearly half of his freshman total of 490 receiving yards on 46 catches. . . After averaging 35.5 on six punts in the season-opener, senior P **Bryan Anger** responded with an average of 51.0 yards on four boots at Colorado. . . After posting a game-high tying nine tackles, senior LB **D.J. Holt**, co-leads Cal with 17 tackles on the season. . . California will play the first of five games this season at AT&T Park when it takes on Presbyterian Saturday.

Cougar Notes: Senior QB **Marshall Lobbestael** had a career day Saturday against UNLV as he was 24-of-32 for 361 yards and 5 TDs, playing a little more than a half. Four of those touchdowns came in the first half, tying a WSU record for TD passes in a half and his 5 TDs tied for second-most in school history. Lobbestael played just two series after halftime as the Cougars started the season at 2-0 for the first time since the 2005 campaign. In the first half alone, Lobbestael completed 18 of 21 passes for 274 yards and four touchdowns. For the year, he has completed 38 of 51 passes with no interceptions, a passing efficiency rating of 217.15, which is third nationally. The Cougar offense averages 61.5 points per game this season, tops in the nation.

Sun Devil Notes: Senior WR **Aaron Pflugrad** registered a career night in ASU's 37-30 overtime victory over 19th-ranked Missouri. Pflugrad collected a career-high 180 receiving yards and two TDs on eight catches. Put into perspective, Pflugrad had a combined 606 total yards of receiving and five touchdowns in his career entering the game. Pflugrad's 60-yard TD reception was the longest play for the Sun Devils since 2007 (Dimitri Nance 57-yard rushing touchdown vs. Washington on Oct. 13). . . With the 37-30 overtime win over then #19/21 Missouri, Arizona State earned their first victory over a ranked opponent since a 31-20 win over #18 California on October 27, 2007. . . In the win over Missouri, junior WR **Jamal Miles** caught two touchdown passes, including the game-winner in overtime, and threw a touchdown pass.

Trojan Notes: Senior TB **Marc Tyler**, the team's 2010 rushing leader, returned from team suspension and led the Trojans with 113 yards rushing in the win over Utah. It was his fourth career 100-yard outing. . . Sophomore WR **Robert Woods** posted his second consecutive 100-yard receiving game with 102 yards on eight catches. His 25 receptions (12.5 per game) are tied for second nationally. . . Junior QB **Matt Barkley** threw for 264 yards vs. Utah. He's thrown for at least 200 yards in 16 career games. . . For the second straight game, junior OT **Matt Kalil** blocked a field goal attempt. His swat of Utah's potential game tying field goal as time was expiring preserved USC's win.

Ute Notes: Junior WR **DeVonte Christopher** caught 11 passes for 136 yards at USC. It was his fourth career 100-yard receiving game. . . Senior LB **Chaz Walker** posted a team-high 11 tackles at USC. Dating back to last season, he's posted double digit tackles in four straight games, collecting 45 tackles in that span. . . Two rivalry trophies are at stake in Saturday's game: the Deseret Duel and the Beehive Boot. Both teams have won the Deseret Duel trophy twice in its four-year history, while Utah has taken possession of the Beehive Boot 11 times and BYU 22 times in the boot's 40-year history. Utah State, which won the Beehive Boot by a media vote over Utah last year (both teams beat BYU but did not play each other), has claimed the boot seven times.

Cardinal Notes: Junior QB **Andrew Luck** was 20-of-28 for 290 yards and matched a career-high with four touchdown passes - a mark he's now hit five times - in the 44-14 win at Duke. . . The Cardinal scored 40 or more points in six of 13 games last season. They've tallied at least 40 points in each of their two games played this year. . . Has won 10 straight games dating back to last season, marking the program's longest winning streak since 1939-41, when Stanford won 13 straight games over the course of three seasons. The current streak is the fourth longest in school history. . . Last Stanford first year head coach to start his career 2-0 was Tyrone Willingham in 1995. Last to start 3-0 was Jack Christiansen in 1972. . . Rank second nationally in rushing defense, allowing just 28.50 yards per game.

Wildcat Notes: Senior QB **Nick Foles** completed 37-of-51 for 398 yards and 1 TD in the loss at Oklahoma State. For the season, he's connected on 71-of-93 for 810 yards. . . Senior WR **Juron Criner** missed the game at Oklahoma State after having an appendectomy last Monday. . . The last time Foles and Luck hooked up in Tucson, the two combined for 838 yards through the air in a 43-38 UA win - Foles was 40-of-51 for 415 yards, while Luck completed 21-of-35 for 423 yards. . . Coach Mike Stoops' Arizona clubs have beaten a ranked team each of his seven seasons in Tucson, with the highest ranked foe to go down the No. 2 Oregon Ducks, 34-24, in Tucson Nov. 15, 2007.

OREGON TABBED TO WIN PAC-12 TITLE IN PRESEASON MEDIA POLL

LOS ANGELES -- Defending Pac-12 champion OREGON is the choice to win the 2011 Pac-12 Conference football title in a preseason poll of media members who regularly cover the league. The Ducks were listed in the top spot in the North Division by 29 of the 42 voters participating in the poll, collecting 239 points. Twenty-eight of those pollsters tabbed the Ducks to come out on top in the inaugural Pac-12 Championship Game. STANFORD was picked to finish second in the North Division, collecting the other 13 first-place votes in the balloting for the division race, with 11 of those members of the media casting a vote for the Cardinal to capture the Pac-12 title.

USC was picked to win the South Division with 230 points, edging out ARIZONA STATE, which tallied 207 points. Due to NCAA sanctions, USC is on probation and ineligible to participate in the postseason. Therefore, the Trojans would not be able to represent the South Division in the Pac-12 Championship Game. Should USC capture the South Division crown, the team finishing second would be the South Division's representative in the Pac-12 Championship Game. Arizona State collected 13 first-place votes in the division race, with three of the pollsters predicting a Pac-12 Championship crown for the Sun Devils.

The media poll has correctly selected the Conference Champion in 27 of 50 previous polls, including 10 of the last 11. Following are the results of the preseason media poll (points 6-5-4-3-2-1, first-place votes in parentheses):

PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

The inaugural Pac-12 Championship Football Game will take place Friday, December 2 at 8 p.m. ET/5 p.m. PT and telecast to a national audience on FOX. The Championship game will match the winner of the North Division vs. the winner of the South Division. The game will be played on the campus of the division winner with the best overall conference record. The winner of the inaugural Pac-12 Championship will earn the league's automatic BCS berth.

TIE-BREAK PROCEDURES TO DETERMINE DIVISION CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP GAME HOST

The Division Champion will be determined by the record in all games played (both divisional and cross-divisional) within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game representatives

Two-Team Tie.

1. Head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
 - a. If no game is played between the two tied teams or that game ends in a tie, the following tie-breaking procedures would be applied:
2. Record in games played within the division
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (Based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.
6. Total number of wins in a 12-game season. The following conditions will apply to the calculation of the total number of wins:
 - a. Only one win against a team from the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision or lower division will be counted annually.
 - b. Any games that are exempted from counting against the annual maximum number of football contests per NCAA rules (current Bylaw 17.9.5.2) shall not be included.
7. Coin toss.

Multiple-Team Ties.

The following procedures will only be used to eliminate all but two teams, at which point the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

1. Head-to-head (Best record in games among the tied teams).
2. Record in games played within the division.
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.

Pac-12 Championship Game Host

The Pac-12 Championship Game Host will be determined by the record in all games played within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game host.

Tie-breaking Procedure.

1. Head-to-head, if applicable.
2. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of Pac-12 regular-season games.
3. Record against the next highest-placed common opponent in the conference (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the conference.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Coin toss.

PAC-12 BOWL ARRANGEMENTS - 2011-12

The second year of a four-year bowl cycle kicks in this season and the Pac-12 welcomes a new addition to the lineup. The Gildan New Mexico Bowl in Albuquerque will feature the Pac-12's seventh selection against an opponent from the Mountain West Conference. The Pac-12 Conference has agreements with seven bowl partners. The lineup is led by the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, which is the destination for the Pac-12 champion, unless said champion is ranked No. 1 or No. 2 in the final Bowl Championship Series rankings. If that were the case, the Pac-12 champion would play in the BCS National Championship Game hosted by the Allstate Sugar Bowl. Regardless of the disposition of the Pac-12 champion, a second Pac-12 team may be selected for an at-large berth in the Bowl Championship Series in any given year and other Pac-12 bowl partner arrangements provide for that occurrence. In addition to the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, Pac-12 bowl partners include, in order of selection, the Valero Alamo Bowl in San Antonio, Bridgeport Education Holiday Bowl in San Diego, Hyundai Sun Bowl in El Paso, the MAACO Bowl Las Vegas, the Kraft Fight Hunger Bowl in San Francisco, and the Gildan New Mexico Bowl in Albuquerque.
