WALNUT CREEK, Calif.--Running back **Johnathan Franklin** of UCLA, linebacker **D.J. Welch** of OREGON STATE and kicker **John Bonano** of ARIZONA have been named Pac-12 Players of the Week in football.

Franklin, a senior from Los Angeles, Calif., rushed for a career-best 217 yards on 26 carries (8.3 average) and hauled in three passes for 59 yards (19.6 average) and a touchdown in a 36-30 win over No. 16 Nebraska to earn his second-straight Pac-12 Player of the Week honor. He became the seventh Bruin to eclipse the 3,000-yard rushing mark and moved into seventh place on UCLA's all-time rushing list. Through two games this season, Franklin is the NCAA's leading rusher, averaging 215.5 yards per game on the ground.

Welch, a sophomore from Palm Desert, Calif., tied for the team lead with seven tackles, including two tackles for loss (8 yards) in a 10-7 win over No. 13 Wisconsin. Oregon State's defense held the Badgers to 207 yards of total offense, including just 35 yards on the ground, and kept Wisconsin running back Montee Ball out of the end zone, snapping a 21-game touchdown streak for the 2011 Heisman finalist.

Bonano, a senior from Salinas, Calif., was perfect in the kicking game and scored a career-best 15 points in a 59-38 win over No. 18 Oklahoma State. He converted field goals of 22 yards, 24 yards, and 46 yards and was 5-5 on PAT attempts. Bonano kicked off 11 times, logging 4 touchbacks and contributing Oklahoma State's average starting field position at their own 24 yard-line.

Also nominated for offensive player of the week honors were running backs **Ka'Deem Carey** of Arizona, **Isi Sofele** of California, **Christian Powell** of Colorado and **Kenjon Barner** of Oregon, wide receiver **Robert Woods** of USC, tight end **Chris Coyle** of Arizona State and quarterback **Sean Mannion** of Oregon State. Also nominated on defense were linebackers Carlos Mendoza of Arizona State, **J.P. Hurrell** of California, **Dion Bailey** of USC and **Trevor Reilly** of UTAH, defensive backs **Jared Tevis** of Arizona, **Brian Jackson** of Oregon and **Ed Reynolds** of Stanford and defensive end **Datone Jones** of UCLA. Also nominated for special teams play were kickers **Alex Garoutte** of Arizona State, **Alex Wood** of USC and **Andrew Furney** of Washington State, punter **Sean Sellwood** of Utah and punt returners **Keenan Allen** of California and **Drew Terrell** of Stanford..

AROUND THE PAC-12

THE RANKINGS: After big wins last weekend, No. 22 UCLA and No. 24 ARIZONA join No. 2 USC, No. 4 OREGON and No. 21 STANFORD in this week's Top 25. The Wildcats make their first appearance since Nov. 21, 2010, while the Bruins make their first appearance since Sept. 2, 2008. The last time five conference teams appeared in the same poll - Sept. 19, 2010 with No. 5 Oregon, No. 14 Arizona, No. 16 Stanford No. 20 USC, and No. 24 Oregon State.

RECAPING LAST WEEK: The Pac-12 had great success against teams from other BCS conferences, posting a 6-1 record with wins over three teams ranked in the AP Top 25 as OREGON STATE knocked off No. 13 Wisconsin, UCLA defeated No. 16 Nebraska, and ARIZONA dispatched No. 18 Oklahoma State. The last time the league defeated three AP ranked teams in one day? You need to go back to January 1, 1985 when No. 14 UCLA defeated No. 13 Miami in the Fiesta Bowl, No. 18 USC beat No. 6 Ohio State in the Rose Bowl, and No. 4 Washington upended No. 2 Oklahoma in the Orange Bowl.

PAC-12 COACHING DEBUTS A SUCCESS: There were 28 teams with new head coaches in the FBS this season. Of those 28, six have started the season with 2-0 records. Three of those six hail from the Pac-12 - ARIZONA's **Rich Rodriguez**, ARIZONA STATE's **Todd Graham**, and UCLA's **Jim Mora**.

ZERO TO 60: Pac-12 teams have been operating at a furious pace through the first two weeks of the season as eight teams are averaging better than 30 points per game, while six teams are racking up better than 440 yards of total offense, led by UCLA's 649.5 yards per game. Here's a look at the numbers:

- 0 - Successful 2-point conversions by the opposition against the Pac-12 in five attempts.
- 1 - UCLA senior RB **Johnathan Franklin**'s national rankings in rushing (215.5) and all-purpose (249.5) yardage.
- 2 - Four players had two interceptions each last weekend - Arizona's **Jared Tevis**, Arizona State's **Carlos Mendoza**, Stanford's **Ed Reynolds**, USC's **Dion Bailey**.
- 3 - Victories over ranked opponents Saturday.
- 4 - Pac-12 teams with three or more interceptions this season. Arizona State has forced an NCAA-leading 6 interceptions.
- 5 - Total number of penalties committed by ASU this season. It averaged 8.0 penalties per game last season.
- 6 - Touchdown passes by USC senior QB **Matt Barkley** in win over Syracuse. His third career 6 TD performance.
- 7 - Points allowed by Oregon State in win over Wisconsin. The Badgers averaged 39.25 points per game from 2009-2011.
- 8 - Average yards gained per play by UCLA, tops in the Pac-12.
- 9 - Utah's win total (9-0) when senior RB **John White** rushes for 100 yards or more in a game.
- 10 - TD passes thrown this season by USC's **Matt Barkley**, the FBS leader for touchdown passes.
- 11 - Oregon senior RB **Kenjon Barner**'s ranking among the nation's leading rushers. The Pac-12 has three running backs ranked in the top-11 in the NCAA.
- 12 - 100-yard rushing performances turned in by Pac-12 running backs this season.
- 13 - First downs Oregon State limited Wisconsin.
- 14 - Pac-12 single-game high tackles by Arizona LB **Jake Fisher** in win over No. 18 Oklahoma State.
- 15 - Average points scored per game by Pac-12 leaders Arizona's **Ka'Deem Carey**, USC's **Marqise Lee**, Oregon's **Kenjon Barner** and **D'Anthony Thomas**. That quartet is tied for third nationally.
- 16 - Combined turnover margin by the Pac-12, which leads all BCS conferences (SEC-14, Big Ten-9, Big 12-8, Big East-4, ACC-2).
- 17 - Pac-12 victories over non-conference opponents this season (Pac-12 best is 32 during the 2002 season)
- 18 - Passes defended by Arizona through two games, ranking third nationally.
- 19 - UCLA scrimmage plays of 20-yards or longer, leads the FBS.
- 20 - Victories by Pac-12 teams over AP ranked non-conference opponents since 2008.
- 21 - Tackles for loss posted by Arizona State, tied for third in FBS.
- 22 - Combined number of true freshmen (10) and redshirt freshmen (12) that have seen action at Stanford.
- 23 - First downs allowed by Utah in two games. It's 11.5 first downs per game allowed leads the Pac-12 and ranks seventh nationally.
- 24 - Points scored by Arizona sophomore RB **Ka'Deem Carey** in the win over No. 18 Oklahoma State, a Pac-12 single-game high.
- 25 - Wins by Stanford in its last 28 home games (.893)
- 26 - Consecutive games in which California junior WR **Keenan Allen** has caught a pass - every game in which he has played.
- 27 - Tackles this season by Arizona junior LB **Jake Fischer**, the Pac-12 leader.
- 28 - Carries by Colorado freshman FB **Christian Powell** in his first career start against Sacramento State, rushing for 147 yards and three touchdowns.
- 29 - Completions by Oregon State sophomore QB **Sean Mannion** in the win over Wisconsin. He tallied 276 yards through the air and now has 3,604 passing yards for his career, which ranks sixth on

the OSU career list.

- 30 - Different ASU players credited with a tackle this season.
- 31 - Fourth quarter rushing attempts by Arizona in its two wins, accounting for more than one-third of its total attempts.
- 32 - Career rushing TDs by Arizona State senior RB **Cameron Marshall**. Tied for third all-time at ASU, he needs seven to equal the school mark of 39 set by Woody Green (1971-73).
- 33 - Number of completions in 43 attempts (.767) this season for Arizona State sophomore QB **Taylor Kelly**.
- 34 - Consecutive weeks ranked in the AP Top 25 by the Stanford Cardinal, tied for fifth among active streaks in the FBS.
- 35 - Rushing yards allowed by Oregon State vs. No. 13 Wisconsin.
- 36 - Career victories by Oregon coach **Chip Kelly** in 42 games (.857 winning percentage).
- 37 - Combined receptions by WR USC's **Marqise Lee** (21) and **Robert Woods** (16) to make up 37 of Matt Barkley's 46 completions.
- 38 - California senior QB **Zach Maynard**'s career passing TD total (18 with Buffalo, 20 with California).
- 39 - Average number of points Stanford has scored in its last five meetings with USC, posting a 4-1 record in that span.
- 40 - Anniversary of 1972 USC national championship team. **Pat Haden**, the current USC Athletics Director, was a sophomore QB on that squad.
- 41 - Yards needed by UCLA senior RB **Johnathan Franklin** to move into sixth on the school's career rushing list. Currently with 3,100 yards, he trails Skip Hicks (3,140 yards from 1993-97).
- 42 - Second quarter points Arizona State and Oregon have each scored in their games this season.
- 43 - First quarter points scored by Oregon in two games.
- 44 - Arizona State's average margin of victory through two games.
- 45 - Number of games Colorado has had at least one sack in out of the last 47.
- 46 - Pac-12 teams have logged 46 takeaways against non-conference opponents this season versus 30 giveaways.
- 47 - Consecutive weeks ranked in the AP Top 25 for the Oregon Ducks, third longest active streak in the FBS.
- 48 - Interception return average by Stanford junior FS **Ed Reynolds**, who is tied for the FBS lead with three picks this season.
- 49 - Rushing yards per game allowed by Stanford in two games.
- 50 - Utah senior P **Sean Sellwood** has seven punts that have traveled 50 or more yards this season, and 44 in his career.
- 51 - Career victories for Arizona State head coach **Todd Graham**, posting a record of 51-29-0 (.638) in six-plus seasons.
- 52 - Number of freshmen listed on UCLA's roster.
- 53 - Oregon's third down conversion percentage, which leads the Pac-12 and ranks 18th nationally. (It's actually 52.78 percent, but that's close enough for this list).
- 54 - Arizona State's scoring average. The school single-season record is 46.8 ppg set in 1972.
- 55 - Number of victories posted by Utah in its all-time series with BYU (55-34-4).
- 56 - Career receptions by Washington sophomore TE **Austin Seferian-Jenkins**, which ranks ninth all-time among Husky tight ends.
- 57 - Hours it seemed to take to compile this Zero to 60 list.
- 58 - Number of completions in 87 attempts for a league-best 707 yards by Arizona senior QB **Matt Scott**.
- 59 - Points scored by Arizona in win over No. 18 Oklahoma State. Most points since 59-28 win over Washington State in 2008, and most points ever against Top-25 team
- 60 - Washington State junior PK **Andrew Furney** booted at 60-yard FG in win over Eastern Washington. The second longest in school and Pac-12 history, trailing only the 62-yard FG by former Cougar Jason Hanson.

Oregon 49, UCLA 31

USC TABBED TO WIN PAC-12 TITLE IN PRESEASON MEDIA POLL

UNIVERSAL CITY, Calif. - USC is the favorite to win the 2012 Pac-12 Conference football title in a preseason poll of media members who cover the league. The Trojans were listed in the top spot in the North Division by 117 of the 123 voters participating in the poll, collecting 729 points. 102 of those pollsters tabbed the Trojans to come out on top in the Pac-12 Championship Game. Utah was picked to finish second in the South Division, collecting one first-place vote in the balloting for the division race. Arizona State claimed three of the other five first-place votes, with each of those members of the media casting a vote for the Sun Devils to capture the Pac-12 title.

Oregon was picked to win the North Division, garnering 732 points and 117 first place votes, while Stanford, which tallied five of the other six first place votes, was pegged to finish second in this year's poll. California, predicted by the voters to finish fourth in the North Division, claimed the remaining first place vote.

The media poll has correctly selected the Conference Champion in 28 of 51 previous polls, including 11 of the last 12. Following are the results of the preseason media poll (points 6-5-4-3-2-1, first-place votes in parentheses):

PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

The Pac-12 Championship Football Game will take place Friday, November 30 at 8 p.m. ET/5 p.m. PT and telecast to a national audience on FOX. The Championship game will match the winner of the North Division vs. the winner of the South Division. The game will be played on the campus of the division winner with the best overall conference record. The winner of the Pac-12 Championship will earn the league's automatic BCS berth.

TIE-BREAK PROCEDURES TO DETERMINE AND CHAMPIONSHIP GAME PARTICIPANTS & HOST

The division winner will be determined by the record in all games played (both divisional and cross-divisional) within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game representatives from each division:

Two-Team Tie.

1. Head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
 - a. If no game is played between the two tied teams or that game ends in a tie, the following tie-breaking procedures would be applied:
2. Record in games played within the division
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (Based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.
6. Total number of wins in a 12-game season. The following conditions will apply to the calculation of the total number of wins:
 - a. Only one win against a team from the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision or lower division will be counted annually.
 - b. Any games that are exempted from counting against the annual maximum number of football contests per NCAA rules (current Bylaw 17.9.5.2) shall not be included.
7. Coin toss.

Multiple-Team Ties.

The following procedures will only be used to eliminate all but two teams, at which point the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

1. Head-to-head (Best record in games among the tied teams).
2. Record in games played within the division.
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.

Pac-12 Championship Game Host

The Pac-12 Championship Game Host will be determined by the record in all games played within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game host.

Tie-breaking Procedure.

1. Head-to-head, if applicable.
2. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of Pac-12 regular-season games.
3. Record against the next highest-placed common opponent in the conference (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the conference.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Coin toss.

PAC-12 BOWL ARRANGEMENTS - 2012-13

The Pac-12 is in the third year of a four-year bowl cycle. The Pac-12 Conference has agreements with seven bowl partners. The lineup is led by the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, which is the destination for the Pac-12 champion, unless said champion is ranked No. 1 or No. 2 in the final Bowl Championship Series rankings. If that were the case, the Pac-12 champion would play in the BCS National Championship Game hosted by the Discover Orange Bowl. Regardless of the disposition of the Pac-12 champion, a second Pac-12 team may be selected for an at-large berth in the Bowl Championship Series in any given year and other Pac-12 bowl partner arrangements provide for that occurrence. In addition to the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, Pac-12 bowl partners include, in order of selection, the Valero Alamo Bowl in San Antonio, Bridgeport Education Holiday Bowl in San Diego, Hyundai Sun Bowl in El Paso, the MAACO Bowl Las Vegas, the Kraft Fight Hunger Bowl in San Francisco, and the Gildan New Mexico Bowl in Albuquerque.
