AROUND THE PAC-12

- Pac-12 league play gets into full swing this Saturday with four league contests, two being divisional action featuring California at Washington in the North Division, and USC at Arizona State in the South Division.
- STANFORD has the nation's longest winning streak at 11 games, which is safe for another week as the Cardinal are idle this weekend.
- While Pac-12 quarterbacks have shared the spotlight for big performances, the league's running backs are certainly not hiding in the shadows. OREGON's **LaMichael James** rolled for 204 yards on just 12 carries (17.0 per carry) vs. Missouri State; UTAH's **John White** rushed for 174 yards on 22 carries (7.9 per carry) in the Utes' win at BYU; STANFORD's **Stepfan Taylor** collected 153 yards on 22 carries (7.0 per carry) in a Conference win at Arizona; WASHINGTON's **Chris Polk** posted his fifth consecutive 100-yard game with 130 yards on 22 carries (5.9 per carry) at Nebraska; and CALIFORNIA's **Isi Sofele** posted 110 yards on 18 carries (6.1 per carry) in the win over Presbyterian.

BANK OF THE WEST PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

MATT BARKLEY, USC - OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK
TREVOR REILLY, UTAH - DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK
BRENDAN BIGELOW, CALIFORNIA - SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

WALNUT CREEK, Calif.--Quarterback **Matt Barkley** of USC, defensive end **Trevor Reilly** of Utah and kick returner **Brendan Bigelow** of California have been named Bank of the West Pac-12 Players of the Week in football.

Barkley, a junior from Newport Beach, Calif., threw a USC record-tying and Syracuse opponent record-tying 5 touchdowns for the third time in his career to lead the Trojans to a 38-17 win over Syracuse. He shares the record with Carson Palmer, Rodney Peete, Matt Leinart and Mark Sanchez. His scoring passes went to five different receivers (5, 31, 44, 43 and 9 yards). He completed 67% of his passes (26-of-39) for 324 yards and has now moved into fifth place on USC's career total offense (6,376 yards) and pass completions (526) lists. He has now thrown at least one TD in 23 of 27 games, at least 2 TDs 14 times and at least 3 TDs 7 times. He has passed for at least 200 yards 17 times in his career (and for at least 300 yards 6 times).

Reilly, a sophomore from Valley Center, Calif., whose primary position is linebacker, subbed in at defensive end and spent most of the game in BYU's backfield in Utah's 54-10 victory. He finished with two sacks for a loss of 21 yards and three tackles for loss for 35 yards, forced three fumbles (recovering one of those), had a pass breakup and five total tackles. One of Reilly's biggest plays was with the game still in balance in the third quarter. Utah was leading 24-10, when Reilly sacked BYU quarterback Jake Heaps for a loss of 14 yards, forcing a fumble and then recovering the fumble on BYU's 6-yard. The Utes then scored, giving them a 30-10 lead. Another of Reilly's forced fumbles also led to a Utah touchdown. He sacked Heaps for a 7-yard loss, forcing a fumble that was scooped up by V.J. Fehoko and returned 57 yards for the game's final touchdown. His three forced fumbles is a school record.

Bigelow, a freshman from Fresno, Calif., became the first Golden Bear since Lavelle Hawkins in 2007 to return a kickoff for a touchdown when he took a second-quarter Presbyterian kickoff at the 12-yard line and raced 88 yards for a score. Bigelow finished with two kick returns for 111 yards, while adding two rushes for 15 yards and one reception for 11 to total 137 all-purpose yards as the Bears defeated Presbyterian 63-12. He was honored Sunday as a National Kickoff Returner Performer of the Week by the College Football Performance Awards.

Also nominated for offensive player of the week honors were wide receivers **Marvin Jones** of California and **Marquess Wilson** of Washington State, running backs **Rodney Stewart** of Colorado, **LaMichael James** of Oregon, **Stepfan Taylor** of Stanford and **John White** of Utah. Also nominated on defense were defensive back **Sean Cattouse** of California, rover **Eddie Pleasant** of Oregon, linebacker **Jarek Lancaster** of Stanford, linebacker **Dion Bailey** of USC. Also nominated for special teams play were tight end **Ryan Deehan** of Colorado, linebacker **Keloni Kamalani** of Oregon, **Jordan Williamson** of Stanford and **Jeff Locke** of UCLA.

Golden Bear Notes: Coach **Jeff Tedford** became Cal's winningest football coach with 75 victories, passing former Bears coach Andy Smith (74 wins, 1916-25). . . Cal's starting offensive line has now combined for 100 career starts – LT **Mitchell Schwartz** (41), RG **Justin Cheadle** (25), LG **Brian Schwenke** (15), RT **Matt Summers-Gavin** (15) and C **Dominic Galas** (4). . . Senior S **Sean Cattouse** is Cal's active career leader with six career interceptions. . . Junior TB **Isi Sofele** tied a career high with two TD runs (also vs. Fresno State 9/3/11) and posted a career high with 110 yards rushing in the win over Presbyterian. . . Senior WR **Marvin Jones** had his sixth career 100-yard receiving game and his second of the 2011 season with 123 yards vs. Presbyterian. Jones (100.3 yards) and sophomore WR **Keenan Allen** (98.7 yards) combine to average 199.0 receiving yards.

Husky Notes: Sophomore QB **Keith Price** tossed four TD passes in the 51-38 setback at Nebraska. He has now thrown for 11 TDs over the first three games of the season - the most ever by a Huskies quarterback in any three-game span. . . Junior RB **Chris Polk** led the Huskies with 130 yards rushing in the loss. It was his third 100-yard day in as many games. Dating back to last season, he's posted 100 or more yards rushing in five straight games, piling up 823 yards in that span. . . Junior WR **James Johnson** became one of 16 different Pac-12 receivers to register 100 or more receiving yards in a game when he caught six passes for 108 yards and a pair of TDs in the loss at Nebraska.

Buffalo Notes: Senior RB **Rodney Stewart** moved into fourth place on CU's all-time rushing yards list, closing the game with 2,967 yards; he passed Charlie Davis ('71-73; 2,958). With 191 yards from scrimmage today, he moved from fourth into second with 3,642, passing Bobby Purify (2000-04; 3,524) and Rashaan Salaam (1992-94; 3,469). He jumped from seventh into third in career all-purpose yards with 3,651, trailing only Eric Bienenmy (1987-90; 4,320) and Hugh Charles (2004-07; 3,622). On the year, he still has more receiving yards (18-277) than rushing yards (61-223). . . Senior QB **Tyler Hansen** threw for 215 yards and picked up 26 yards rushing as he surpassed the 4,000-yard mark in total offense, finishing with 4,114; he passed Eric Bienenmy (4,003) into ninth place as he became the 10th player to hit the mark.

Bruin Notes: In addition to his punting and kickoff chores, junior **Jeff Locke** has added place kicking duties. In his first career attempt, he successfully responded with 51-yard field goal as time expired in the first half against Texas. He added a 49-yard field goal in the second half. While not shirking his normal responsibilities, Locke averaged 48.8 yards on four punts, with a long of 70 yards. . . At 7.1 yards

per carry, senior TB **Derrick Coleman** is one of three Pac-12 running backs averaging better than 7.0 yards per carry. . . The Bruins have won six of the last eight meetings with Oregon State, and 12 of the last 15 times the two teams have met in Los Angeles.

Beaver Notes: Oregon State is coming off an open weekend and will be looking for its first win of the season. . . In their last outing, the Beavers fell to No. 8 Wisconsin, 35-0. Freshman QB **Sean Mannion** completed 25 of 38 passes for 244 yards. Junior WR **Markus Wheaton** caught eight of those passes for 83 yards, while junior WR **Jordan Bishop** had five catches for 98 yards. Wheaton is averaging 7.0 receptions per game and 95.5 yards receiving per game.

Duck Notes: Junior RB **LaMichael James** led the conference in scoring last season and has continued doing so this season at 14.0 points per game. James picked up three TDs in the 56-7 win over Missouri State as he gained 204 yards on only 12 carries (17.0 averaged). . . James and freshman RB De'Anthony Thomas are each averaging 7.7 yards per carry. . . Thanks to a balanced 681-yard performance in the win over Missouri State, Oregon sits atop the Pac-12 in total offense with Washington State, averaging 539.7 yards per game. . . Over the last two games, junior QB **Darron Thomas** has completed 24-of-34 for 501 yards and nine TDs.

Wildcat Notes: The Wildcats will take on their third consecutive Top 10 ranked opponent when No. 10 Oregon visits Tucson. . . Senior QB **Nick Foles** completed his first 17 pass attempts on the way to a 24-of-33 effort for 239 yards and one TD in the loss to Stanford. Foles has not thrown an interception in 126 attempts this season. . . The Wildcats have just one turnover in three games this season, joining Colorado as the only Pac-12 teams with less than two turnovers for the year. . . Senior WR **Juron Criner** bounced back from his Sept. 5 appendectomy and responded with six catches for 48 yards and one TD. . . Junior P **Kyle Dugandzic** has turned the Arizona punting game around. A year ago, the Wildcats were ninth in the league, averaging 34.1 net yards per punt, and last in average yards per punt at 39.2 yards per punt. This season, Dugandzic has the 'Cats atop the Pac-12 in yards per punt (49.4 yards) and net yards per punt (43.3 yards).

Trojan Notes: The Trojans have won their last 11 over the Sun Devils, including the past 5 trips to Tempe. . . Junior QB **Matt Barkley** threw a USC record-tying 5 touchdowns for the third time in his career to lead the Trojans to a 38-17 win over Syracuse. He connected with five different receivers for each of his TD throws. . . Sophomore WR **Robert Woods** has hauled in 33 receptions for 361 yards. He currently is first nationally in receptions (11.0, first in Pac-12) and is tied for ninth in receiving yards (120.3, second in Pac-12). . . USC defense limited Syracuse to 75 yards rushing, the second consecutive game the opponent has been held under 100 yards rushing. Allowing 88.0 yards rushing per game, USC is one of four Pac-12 teams allowing under 100 yards.

Sun Devil Notes: Junior QB **Brock Osweiler** was 25-of-45 for 256 yards and a TD as he connected with eight different receivers in the 17-14 loss at Illinois. Senior WR **Gerell Robinson** was the recipient of eight catches for 88 yards, while senior WR **Aaron Pflugrad** had seven catches for 75 yards. . . In the three games this season, Pflugrad has totaled 18 receptions for 305 yards and four TDs. Entering the 2011 season, he had 576 yards and three touchdowns in his career. . . Arizona State will play its first ever Pac-12 Conference game against the USC Trojans. It is fitting that USC is the first Pac-12 opponent for the Sun Devils, as they faced USC in the first ever Pac-10 game played in Tempe. After leaving the WAC to join the Pac-10 in 1978, the Sun Devils shocked the #2 USC Trojans 20-7 at Sun Devil Stadium to earn the program's first ever Pac-10 win.

OREGON TABBED TO WIN PAC-12 TITLE IN PRESEASON MEDIA POLL

LOS ANGELES -- Defending Pac-12 champion OREGON is the choice to win the 2011 Pac-12 Conference football title in a preseason poll of media members who regularly cover the league. The Ducks were listed in the top spot in the North Division by 29 of the 42 voters participating in the poll, collecting 239 points. Twenty-eight of those pollsters tabbed the Ducks to come out on top in the inaugural Pac-12 Championship Game. STANFORD was picked to finish second in the North Division, collecting the other 13 first-place votes in the balloting for the division race, with 11 of those members of the media casting a vote for the Cardinal to capture the Pac-12 title.

USC was picked to win the South Division with 230 points, edging out ARIZONA STATE, which tallied 207 points. Due to NCAA sanctions, USC is on probation and ineligible to participate in the postseason. Therefore, the Trojans would not be able to represent the South Division in the Pac-12 Championship Game. Should USC capture the South Division crown, the team finishing second would be the South Division's representative in the Pac-12 Championship Game. Arizona State collected 13 first-place votes in the division race, with three of the pollsters predicting a Pac-12 Championship crown for the Sun Devils.

The media poll has correctly selected the Conference Champion in 27 of 50 previous polls, including 10 of the last 11. Following are the results of the preseason media poll (points 6-5-4-3-2-1, first-place votes in parentheses):

PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

The inaugural Pac-12 Championship Football Game will take place Friday, December 2 at 8 p.m. ET/5 p.m. PT and telecast to a national audience on FOX. The Championship game will match the winner of the North Division vs. the winner of the South Division. The game will be played on the campus of the division winner with the best overall conference record. The winner of the inaugural Pac-12 Championship will earn the league's automatic BCS berth.

TIE-BREAK PROCEDURES TO DETERMINE DIVISION CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP GAME HOST

The Division Champion will be determined by the record in all games played (both divisional and cross-divisional) within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game representatives

Two-Team Tie.

1. Head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
 - a. If no game is played between the two tied teams or that game ends in a tie, the following tie-breaking procedures would be applied:
2. Record in games played within the division
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (Based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.
6. Total number of wins in a 12-game season. The following conditions will apply to the calculation of the total number of wins:
 - a. Only one win against a team from the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision or lower division will be counted annually.
 - b. Any games that are exempted from counting against the annual maximum number of football contests per NCAA rules (current Bylaw 17.9.5.2) shall not be included.
7. Coin toss.

Multiple-Team Ties.

The following procedures will only be used to eliminate all but two teams, at which point the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

1. Head-to-head (Best record in games among the tied teams).
2. Record in games played within the division.
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.

Pac-12 Championship Game Host

The Pac-12 Championship Game Host will be determined by the record in all games played within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game host.

Tie-breaking Procedure.

1. Head-to-head, if applicable.
2. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of Pac-12 regular-season games.
3. Record against the next highest-placed common opponent in the conference (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the conference.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Coin toss.

PAC-12 BOWL ARRANGEMENTS - 2011-12

The second year of a four-year bowl cycle kicks in this season and the Pac-12 welcomes a new addition to the lineup. The Gildan New Mexico Bowl in Albuquerque will feature the Pac-12's seventh selection against an opponent from the Mountain West Conference. The Pac-12 Conference has agreements with seven bowl partners. The lineup is led by the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, which is the destination for the Pac-12 champion, unless said champion is ranked No. 1 or No. 2 in the final Bowl Championship Series rankings. If that were the case, the Pac-12 champion would play in the BCS National Championship Game hosted by the Allstate Sugar Bowl. Regardless of the disposition of the Pac-12 champion, a second Pac-12 team may be selected for an at-large berth in the Bowl Championship Series in any given year and other Pac-12 bowl partner arrangements provide for that occurrence. In addition to the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, Pac-12 bowl partners include, in order of selection, the Valero Alamo Bowl in San Antonio, Bridgeport Education Holiday Bowl in San Diego, Hyundai Sun Bowl in El Paso, the MAACO Bowl Las Vegas, the Kraft Fight Hunger Bowl in San Francisco, and the Gildan New Mexico Bowl in Albuquerque.
