BANK OF THE WEST PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

MATT BARKLEY, USC - OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK

WALNUT CREEK, Calif.--Quarterback **Matt Barkley** of USC, linebacker **Alex Hoffman-Ellis** of WASHINGTON STATE and wide receiver/kick returner **Jamal Miles** of ARIZONA STATE have been named Bank of the West Pac-12 Players of the Week in football.

Barkley, a junior from Newport Beach, Calif., broke two USC records in the 48-41 win over Arizona. He completed 82.1-percent of his passes (32-of-39) for a game record 468 yards with four touchdowns, while also running for a short score. Barkley was 22-of-26 for 301 yards with three touchdowns in the first half. His 470 yards of total offense was also a single-game record. Both records belonged to Heisman Trophy winner Carson Palmer. Barkley's career-long 82-yard touchdown pass was the longest at USC since Palmer's 93-yard pass to Kareem Kelly in 2001. Barkley ranks fifth on USC's career lists for passing (579 completions) and total offense (7,063 yards).

Hoffman-Ellis, a senior from Los Angeles, Calif., registered a game-high 14 tackles in the Cougars' 31-27 comeback victory at Colorado. His 14 tackles, which included 12 solo tackles and two sacks, were a WSU-high for 2011 and one shy of his career-best effort. Hoffman-Ellis had 10 tackles in the second half, with five in the decisive fourth quarter. The win marked the first time WSU had rallied from 10 points down in the fourth quarter to defeat a conference opponent on the road since 1984, when the Cougars trailed Stanford by 21 and went on to win, 48-42.

Miles, a junior from Peoria, Ariz., became the only player in the nation this year to have returned a punt for a touchdown, a kickoff for a touchdown, thrown a touchdown pass and caught a touchdown pass. Miles returned a punt for 78 yards and a touchdown with 6:11 in the third quarter that gave ASU a 21-13 lead over Oregon State. It was the first punt return allowed by the Beaver special teams all season. Miles tallied 249 all-purpose yards in the 35-20 win, including 87 on punt returns and 55 on kickoff returns. He had 45 rushing yards on six carries and led Sun Devil receivers with 62 yards.

Series: CAL leads 39-32-2. Last: ORE, 15-13 (2010)

Golden Bear Notes: Cal's defense looks for a repeat performance in slowing down the Oregon offense. In last year's meeting, the Bears limited the explosive Ducks to 377 yards of total offense (162 rushing, 155 passing) in a 15-13 setback. . . California's rush defense has allowed only 78.25 yards per contest, ranking second in the Pac-12 and ninth nationally. . . Senior LB **Mychal Kendrick**s equaled a career-high with 15 tackles in at Washington and has a team-leading 35 tackles. . . Sophomore WR **Keenan Allen** is 12 receiving yards away from equaling DeSean Jackson as the fastest Cal player to reach 1,000 career receiving yards (he reached 1,000 in the 16th game). The 498 receiving yards Allen has totaled in four games this season have already surpassed the 490 he had during freshman campaign.

Duck Notes: Oregon has won its last 13 conference games overall and last 18 played at Autzen Stadium. . . The Ducks are averaging 49.55 points per game during their 18-game home winning streak. . . In 19 career conference games, junior RB **LaMichael James** has rushed for an average of 150.3 yards per game (6.33 ypc) and 33 touchdowns. . . James now leads the country in rushing, all-purpose yards and punt returns, and is fourth nationally in scoring (13.5 avg.). . . With 3,890 career rushing yards, James is looking to become the sixth conference back to have eclipsed 4,000 yards and only one, USC's Charles White, did so before his senior season. White is the record holder with 6,245 yards. . . Of Oregon's 27 offensive drives resulting in touchdowns, 12 have lasted 1:39 or less.

Wildcat Notes: Arizona looks to snap a seven-game winless streak in conference play. . . Freshman RB **Ka'Deem Carey** scored three touchdowns (two rush, one receiving) against USC. In a pass-heavy offense, Carey and senior RB **Keola Antolin** have combined for 311 yards (4.6 ypc) over the last three games. . . Carey leads the club in per-game all-purpose yardage (122.4 yards per contest) thanks to his 369 yards in kick returns (21.7). . . Senior QB **Nick Foles** completed 41-of-53 for 425 yards and 4 TDs, hitting 12 different receivers in the 48-41 loss at USC. It was the fifth time in his career that he has thrown for at least 400 yards in a game. . . Arizona has surrendered 503 yards of total offense per game this year, but that has come against some notable offenses. The next seven opponents average 377 yards per game.

Beaver Notes: Freshman QB **Sean Mannion** went 40-for-66 for 341 yards and a touchdown in the loss at Arizona State. He broke 25-year-old school records for completions and attempts in the game. . . OSU was without leading rusher **Malcolm Agnew** (hamstring) for the third straight game. Agnew rushed for 223 yards in the season-opener, but since then the OSU rushing attack has been limited to 158 rushing yards over the last three games. . . Despite a season-ending knee injury suffered last year in Tucson, senior WR James Rodgers has had considerable success against the Wildcats during his career as he's rushed for 159 yards (11.6 ypc), tallied 18 receptions for 238 yards and 143 kickoff return yards (23.8 per return) .

Series: ASU leads, 16-6-0. Last: ASU, 38-0 (1993)

Sun Devil Notes: Arizona State has won seven in a row over the Utes dating back to a streak that started with the Sun Devils last appearance in Salt Lake City (1977). . . This will be the second time in his career that Dennis Erickson will face the Utah Utes. His only previous match-up with them was in 1986, when his Wyoming Cowboys defeated Utah 38-14 in Laramie. . . Junior RB **Cameron Marshall**, playing on a badly sprained ankle, picked up 80 yards on 14 carries (5.7 ypc), to go with 2 TDs against Oregon State. . . The Sun Devil defense has dialed up the turnovers over the last two contests, forcing nine takeaways. . . Junior WR **Jamal Miles** has returned a kickoff for a touchdown in the season opener against UC Davis, threw a TD pass against Missouri, returned a punt for a TD against Oregon State and has caught three touchdown passes this year. Miles is the only player in the nation to have scored a touchdown on a reception, kickoff return and punt return as well as throw a TD pass.

Ute Notes: Junior QB **Jordan Wynn** is out for Saturday's game with an injury to his left (non-throwing) shoulder. Wynn was injured at the end of the first half against Washington and was replaced by junior college transfer **Jon Hays**. Hays responded by completing 10-of-16 passes for 156 yards and one TD, a 63-yard pass to junior WR **DeVonte Christopher**. It was Utah's longest pass play of the season. . . Christopher leads the Utes with 21 receptions and 330 receiving yards. . . In the latest national rankings, Utah is No. 4 in red-zone defense (5-9, 56%), is tied for fifth in fumbles recovered (8), tied for 7th in turnovers caused (13) and tied for 13th in turnover margin (1.25; 13 takeaways to 8 turnovers). The Utes lead the Pac-12 in all four categories. . . Senior LB **Chaz Walker** had a team-leading 12 tackles against Washington and is now tied for the Pac-12 lead with 9.5 tackles per game.

Series Record: Tied, 3-3-0. Last: STAN, 41-37 (1993)

Buffalo Notes: Senior QB **Tyler Hansen** became the seventh Buffalo to throw for 4,000 yards in career, as he has now posted 4,147 yards. His passes without an interception streak came to an end at 131 (intercepted on his 11th pass against Washington State); that was the second longest mark in school annals behind 139 by Joel Klatt (over a five-game stretch in 2005). . . A couple of Buffaloes have flipped sides of the ball as TB **Brian Lockridge** and WR **Jason Espinoza** have come to assist the Colorado defense at cornerback. Lockridge's first defensive stat he recorded was a 9-yard sack in the second quarter.

Cardinal Notes: In four games, the Cardinal have turned the ball over just once. . . The Cardinal have been perfect in 22 red zone opportunities, scoring 17 TDs and adding five FGs. . . In the win over UCLA, junior QB **Andrew Luck** guided the Stanford offense through five possessions with his own play calling, two possessions resulted in TDs. In addition to his efficient 23-of-27 (85.2%) for 227 yards and 3 TDs through the air, he added a spectacular one-handed reception for 13 yards. . . Junior RB **Stepfan Taylor** rushed for 112 yards on 17 carries (6.6 ypc) against UCLA. He's now one of four Pac-12 running backs averaging better than 100 yards rushing per game. . . Tight ends **Coby Fleener** (5), **Zach Ertz** (3) and **Levine Toilolo** (1) have accounted for nine of Stanford's 12 TD receptions this season and 13 of the last 16 scoring strikes dating back to the Orange Bowl.

Series: UCLA leads, 38-18-1. Last: UCLA, 42-28 (2010)

Cougar Notes: Washington State notched its 500th victory in program history at Colorado. . . Senior QB **Marshall Lobbestael** completed 32-of-49 passes for 376 yards and 3 TDs. He was 8-of-10 for 147 yards and a pair of TDs in the final two scoring drives that brought WSU back from 27-17 deficit in the final 5:04 minutes for the 31-27 victory. It was his third straight game with 300-plus passing yards. Lobbestael has thrown for 1,335 yards this season, compared to a total of 1,287 yards over the his first three seasons in Pullman. . . Through four games, WSU has scored 178 points, averaging 44.5 points per game. Last season, the Cougars scored a total of 235 points, averaging 19.6 points. . . Senior LB **Alex Hoffman-Ellis** posted a team-high 14 tackles and two sacks in the win at Colorado. He leads the Cougars with 27 tackles on the season. . . Junior QB **Jeff Tuel** has been cleared to begin practicing this week in full pads. . . Cougars look to start 4-1 for the first time since 2003. A win Saturday also would mark the first time WSU has won three consecutive league road games since 2006.

Bruin Notes: Junior QB **Richard Brehaut** threw for 202 yards and a pair of TD passes to junior TE **Joseph Fauria** in the loss at Stanford. Fauria has caught a touchdown pass in five of the last seven games. . . Junior RB **Johnathan Franklin** rushed for 96 yards on 12 carries (8.0 ypc) at Stanford. For the season, Franklin is averaging 6.1 yards per carry. With 2,092 career rushing yards, Franklin ranks 14th on the school's all-time list. Up next on the list is Brian Brown (2,099 yards from 1986-90). . . Junior P **Jeff Locke** had four boots for an average of 46.0 yards at Stanford. He is one of five Pac-12 punters averaging better than 44.0 yards per punt.

OREGON TABBED TO WIN PAC-12 TITLE IN PRESEASON MEDIA POLL

LOS ANGELES -- Defending Pac-12 champion OREGON is the choice to win the 2011 Pac-12 Conference football title in a preseason poll of media members who regularly cover the league. The Ducks were listed in the top spot in the North Division by 29 of the 42 voters participating in the poll, collecting 239 points. Twenty-eight of those pollsters tabbed the Ducks to come out on top in the inaugural Pac-12 Championship Game. STANFORD was picked to finish second in the North Division, collecting the other 13 first-place votes in the balloting for the division race, with 11 of those members of the media casting a vote for the Cardinal to capture the Pac-12 title.

USC was picked to win the South Division with 230 points, edging out ARIZONA STATE, which tallied 207 points. Due to NCAA sanctions, USC is on probation and ineligible to participate in the postseason. Therefore, the Trojans would not be able to represent the South Division in the Pac-12 Championship Game. Should USC capture the South Division crown, the team finishing second would be the South Division's representative in the Pac-12 Championship Game. Arizona State collected 13 first-place votes in the division race, with three of the pollsters predicting a Pac-12 Championship crown for the Sun Devils.

The media poll has correctly selected the Conference Champion in 27 of 50 previous polls, including 10 of the last 11. Following are the results of the preseason media poll (points 6-5-4-3-2-1, first-place votes in parentheses):

PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

The inaugural Pac-12 Championship Football Game will take place Friday, December 2 at 8 p.m. ET/5 p.m. PT and telecast to a national audience on FOX. The Championship game will match the winner of the North Division vs. the winner of the South Division. The game will be played on the campus of the division winner with the best overall conference record. The winner of the inaugural Pac-12 Championship will earn the league's automatic BCS berth.

TIE-BREAK PROCEDURES TO DETERMINE DIVISION CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP GAME HOST

The Division Champion will be determined by the record in all games played (both divisional and cross-divisional) within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game representatives

Two-Team Tie.

1. Head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
 - a. If no game is played between the two tied teams or that game ends in a tie, the following tie-breaking procedures would be applied:
2. Record in games played within the division
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (Based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.
6. Total number of wins in a 12-game season. The following conditions will apply to the calculation of the total number of wins:
 - a. Only one win against a team from the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision or lower division will be counted annually.
 - b. Any games that are exempted from counting against the annual maximum number of football contests per NCAA rules (current Bylaw 17.9.5.2) shall not be included.
7. Coin toss.

Multiple-Team Ties.

The following procedures will only be used to eliminate all but two teams, at which point the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

1. Head-to-head (Best record in games among the tied teams).
2. Record in games played within the division.
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.

Pac-12 Championship Game Host

The Pac-12 Championship Game Host will be determined by the record in all games played within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game host.

Tie-breaking Procedure.

1. Head-to-head, if applicable.
2. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of Pac-12 regular-season games.
3. Record against the next highest-placed common opponent in the conference (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the conference.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Coin toss.

PAC-12 BOWL ARRANGEMENTS - 2011-12

The second year of a four-year bowl cycle kicks in this season and the Pac-12 welcomes a new addition to the lineup. The Gildan New Mexico Bowl in Albuquerque will feature the Pac-12's seventh selection against an opponent from the Mountain West Conference. The Pac-12 Conference has agreements with seven bowl partners. The lineup is led by the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, which is the destination for the Pac-12 champion, unless said champion is ranked No. 1 or No. 2 in the final Bowl Championship Series rankings. If that were the case, the Pac-12 champion would play in the BCS National Championship Game hosted by the Allstate Sugar Bowl. Regardless of the disposition of the Pac-12 champion, a second Pac-12 team may be selected for an at-large berth in the Bowl Championship Series in any given year and other Pac-12 bowl partner arrangements provide for that occurrence. In addition to the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, Pac-12 bowl partners include, in order of selection, the Valero Alamo Bowl in San Antonio, Bridgeport Education Holiday Bowl in San Diego, Hyundai Sun Bowl in El Paso, the MAACO Bowl Las Vegas, the Kraft Fight Hunger Bowl in San Francisco, and the Gildan New Mexico Bowl in Albuquerque.
