## PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK - WEEK EIGHT

**OFFENSE: Matt Barkley, QB, USC**

**DEFENSE: Chase Thomas, OLB, Stanford**

**SPECIAL TEAMS: Richard Morrison, WR/PR, Arizona**

WALNUT CREEK, Calif.-- Quarterback **Matt Barkley** of USC, outside linebacker **Chase Thomas** of STANFORD and wide receiver/punt returner **Richard Morrison** of ARIZONA have been named Pac-12 Players of the Week in football.

Barkley, a senior from Newport Beach, Calif., led USC to a 50-6 victory over Colorado as he threw for a USC single game record-tying six touchdown passes, including a school record-tying five in the first half, to become the Pac-12's career recordholder. He passed former Trojan Matt Leinart's Pac-12 record of 99 career touchdown passes and now has 102 for his career. Barkley completed 95.0% of his passes (19-of-20) to set both the Pac-12 game mark for highest completion percentage (minimum 15 completions) and the Pac-12 game passing efficiency rating record (319.2). He threw for 298 yards overall with no interceptions and was 16-of-17 for 269 yards in the first half to earn College Football Performance Awards National Performer of the Week and National Quarterback of the Week.

Thomas, a senior from Marietta, Ga, led an impressive Stanford defensive performance that held the Pac-12's No. 3 rushing offense to three yards rushing in a 21-3 victory over Cal in the 115th Big Game. The three yards rushing (0.1 yards/carry) was the fewest allowed by a Stanford defense since 2003 (vs. BYU, minus-five) and tied for the seventh best in school history. Thomas had seven tackles, which included 4.0 tackles for loss in the game. He registered one sack for a seven-yard loss, a forced fumble and another fumble recovery. Stanford's dominating defense recorded 11 tackles for loss, four sacks and allowed only three points, the lowest in a Big Game since 1998. Stanford's defense held Cal, which entered the game averaging 5.0 yards per carry, to 3.86 inches per carry.

Morrison, a junior from Royse City, Texas, delivered the back-breaker in the third quarter of last Saturday's 52-17 victory over Washington. With Arizona leading 38-17, the Wildcats forced the Huskies into a punting situation. Morrison fielded the punt and raced 63 yards, aided by a key block from Mark Watley to spring him for the final yards, for a touchdown to put the game out of reach. The return was the longest of Morrison's career and was also his first touchdown on a return. Arizona's last punt return for a touchdown was turned in by Bug Wright, who had an 86-yard scoot against Washington State on Nov. 7, 2009, at Arizona Stadium.

Also nominated for offensive player of the week honors were quarterback **Marcus Mariota** of OREGON, and running backs **Ka'Deem Carey** of ARIZONA, **Storm Woods** of OREGON STATE and **Stepfan Taylor** of STANFORD. Also nominated on defense were linebackers **Jake Fischer** of ARIZONA and **Michael Doctor** of OREGON STATE and defensive end **Kevin Greene** of USC. Also nominated on special teams were punters **Josh Hubner** of ARIZONA STATE, **Jackson Rice** of OREGON, and **Keith Kostol** of OREGON STATE.

## AROUND THE PAC-12

**BCS STANDINGS:** The Pac-12 continues to place three teams among the Top 10 in the latest BCS Standings - No. 4 OREGON, No. 7 OREGON STATE, No. 9 USC. STANFORD also appears at No. 17. Looking down the road... Oregon is scheduled to play at USC on November 2, and will finish the season at Oregon State on November 24. Oregon State and USC do not meet in the regular season.

**IN A RUSH:** Stanford senior RB **Stepfan Taylor** rushed for a career-high 189 yards (6.8 avg) and 1 TD in the win at California, Arizona sophomore RB **Ka'Deem Carey** posted a career-best 172 yards (5.9 avg) and 1 TD in the win over Washington, while Oregon senior RB **Kenjon Barner** tallied 143 yards (8.9 avg) and 3 TDs in the win at Arizona State. . . UCLA senior RB **Johnathan Franklin**, who had the week off, continues to pace the league at 125.4 ypg, followed by Barner (124.3), Taylor (120.9) and Carey (120.3). Those four rank 9, 10, 13 and 14, respectively in rushing among FBS players. Barner, Taylor and Carey would each lead four other BCS conferences in rushing yardage, including the ACC, Big 12, Big East and SEC. No player from those four conferences has topped 800 yards yet this year.

### **UCLA (5-2) at ARIZONA STATE (5-2)**

Sat., Oct. 27, 12 noon PT - FOX

UCLA leads, 17-10-1. Last game: UCLA, 29-28 (2011)

It's an even series between the Bruins and Sun Devils over the last eight games. In last year's game, UCLA's Derrick Coleman scored his second of two TDs on the day with 49 seconds to play, giving the Bruins a 29-28 win over the 20th-ranked Sun Devils.

UCLA's offense is scoring 8.6 points more per game from a year ago, while the defense is surrendering 8.8 points less per game than it did a year ago. The Bruins have 24 sacks in seven games (3.43 avg), led by junior LB **Anthony Barr** (7.0 sacks, 1.00 avg). UCLA had just 14 sacks in 14 games last season.

Junior LB **Chris Young** picked up 11 tackles, including 2.0 for loss, and now leads the Sun Devils in tackles with 51. He's posted 12.5 TFL, and his 1.79 TFL ranks tied for seventh in the nation.

The Sun Devils had just two penalties for 10 yards against Oregon. Through seven games, ASU has committed just 28 penalties for 198 yards for a league-best 28.3 yards per game. The 4.0 penalties per game ranks tied for seventh in the nation.

### **COLORADO (1-6) at No. 2 OREGON (7-0)**

Sat., Oct. 27, 12 noon PT - P12N

Series tied, 8-8-0. Last game: ORE, 45-2 (2011)

In the 43-21 win at Arizona State, freshman QB **Marcus Mariota** became school's first player to run (86 yards), pass (46 yards) and catch (2 yards) a TD pass in the same game since Joey Harrington in 2000 Holiday Bowl (vs. Texas). His 86-yard TD run was the longest rush in school history by an Oregon QB.

Oregon has scored 30 or more points in 20 straight games, the longest streak in the FBS. The Ducks are 38-2 when scoring 30-plus in the Chip Kelly era, which is only 47 games. Oregon has scored 42 or more points in nine straight games.

Colorado senior DE **Will Pericak** has started 44 straight games (every game of his career, dating back to his first in the '09 opener). He is now one shy of the most starts by a defensive player in CU history—45 by ILB Jordon Dizon, 2004-07; the most starts overall is 47 (OL Ryan Miller, 2007-11).

Having allowed 50 or more points in consecutive games for the first time since 1962, it doesn't get easier this week for the Buffs as they face an Oregon team that averages 51.0 points per game.

### **No. 10 USC (6-1) at ARIZONA (4-3)**

Sat., Oct. 27, 12:30 p.m. PT - ABC (ESPN2 reverse mirror)

USC leads, 28-7-0. Last game: USC, 48-41 (2011)

The last five meetings between USC and Arizona have been decided by seven or fewer points, with the Trojans holding a 4-1 advantage. Last year's 48-41 USC victory in Los Angeles saw Matt Barkley pass for a Trojan record 468 yards with four TDs, while Arizona's Nick Foles threw for 425 yards and four TDs. The teams combined for 1,136 yards as USC outgained Arizona 582-554.

Arizona averages 548.7 yards in total offense (leads Pac-12, fifth nationally), while USC posts 421.3 yards in total offense. UA senior QB **Matt Scott** is fourth in the nation in total offense (374.3 avg). Scott is one of four UA QBs all-time to complete 200 passes in a season.

With the 52-17 win over Washington, the Wildcats have scored 50 or more points for the third time in seven games this season. They scored 50 or points three times in 51 games prior to this season. There are only four other seasons in school history in which Arizona scored 50 or more points three times in one season - 1920, 1921, 1952 and 1954.

USC junior WR **Robert Woods** caught eight passes for 132 yards and a school-record four touchdowns in the win over Colorado. In the process, he set the USC career reception record, passing former Trojan Dwayne Jarrett's mark of 216. Woods now has 220 career receptions and is tied for 10th all-time in Pac-12 history.

In addition, he's on pace to be the first Pac-12 QB to throw for 2,500 yards in four separate seasons.

---

### **WASHINGTON STATE (2-5) at No. 19 STANFORD (5-2)**

Sat., Oct. 27, 3:15 p.m. PT - P12N

STAN leads, 36-25-1. Last game: STAN, 44-14 (2011)

Stanford's defense limited California to 3 yards rushing on 28 carries (3.86 inches per rush) in the 21-3 Big Game win. Stanford is allowing just 77.0 yards per game on the ground, which ranks fourth among FBS teams.

Junior RB **Stepfan Taylor** posted a career-high 189 yards rushing on 28 carries (6.8 avg). He needs 149 yards to reach 1,000 yards for the third season in his career. He'd join former Cardinal Darin Nelson as the only Stanford players to accomplish that feat, and 11th player to do so in Pac-12 history.

Washington State is second in the league and 20th in the nation in kickoff returns (25.4 avg). Thanks in part to freshman KR **Teondray Caldwell**, who is second in the Pac-12 in kick returns (26.8 avg)

### **CALIFORNIA (3-5) at UTAH (2-5)**

Sat., Oct. 27, 7:45 p.m. MT - P12N

CAL leads, 5-3-0. Last game: CAL, 34-10 (2011)

California junior WR **Keenan Allen** has 200 career receptions and needs three more to set the school record, passing former Golden Bear Geoff McArthur who had 202 receptions (2000-03).

After posting just four interceptions through the first five games of the season, Cal's secondary has seven picks over the last three games.

Utah's defensive unit limited Oregon State to 52 yards rushing. The Utes are 22nd in the nation, allowing 114.0 rushing yards per game. Utah is second in the Pac-12, 29th FBS in total defense (333.0 avg).

---

### **No. 7 OREGON STATE (6-0) at WASHINGTON (3-4)**

Sat., Oct. 27, 7:15 p.m. PT - P12N

WASH leads, 58-34-4. Last game: OSU, 38-21 (2011)

At 6-0, Oregon State has matched its best start in school history. The 1907 squad went 6-0 with victories over Astoria, Whitman, Pacific, Oregon, Willamette, and St. Vincent College. . . OSU has held three consecutive opponents to single-digits at home for the first time since 1961.

The Beavers made the most of their red zone opportunities last week vs. Utah, scoring three TDs on three possessions in the red zone. OSU has scored on each of its last 8 trips to the red zone (7 TDs, 1 FG) and are scoring on 84.0 percent of their trips inside the 20-yard line.

Washington sophomore TE **Austin Seferian-Jenkins** had eight receptions for a career-best 110 yards at Arizona. He leads all FBS tight ends with 5.3 receptions per game.

## USC TABBED TO WIN PAC-12 TITLE IN PRESEASON MEDIA POLL

UNIVERSAL CITY, Calif. - USC is the favorite to win the 2012 Pac-12 Conference football title in a preseason poll of media members who cover the league. The Trojans were listed in the top spot in the North Division by 117 of the 123 voters participating in the poll, collecting 729 points. 102 of those pollsters tabbed the Trojans to come out on top in the Pac-12 Championship Game. Utah was picked to finish second in the South Division, collecting one first-place vote in the balloting for the division race. Arizona State claimed three of the other five first-place votes, with each of those members of the media casting a vote for the Sun Devils to capture the Pac-12 title.

Oregon was picked to win the North Division, garnering 732 points and 117 first place votes, while Stanford, which tallied five of the other six first place votes, was pegged to finish second in this year's poll. California, predicted by the voters to finish fourth in the North Division, claimed the remaining first place vote.

The media poll has correctly selected the Conference Champion in 28 of 51 previous polls, including 11 of the last 12. Following are the results of the preseason media poll (points 6-5-4-3-2-1, first-place votes in parentheses):

## PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

The Pac-12 Championship Football Game will take place Friday, November 30 at 8 p.m. ET/5 p.m. PT and telecast to a national audience on FOX. The Championship game will match the winner of the North Division vs. the winner of the South Division. The game will be played on the campus of the division winner with the best overall conference record. The winner of the Pac-12 Championship will earn the league's automatic BCS berth.

### TIE-BREAK PROCEDURES TO DETERMINE AND CHAMPIONSHIP GAME PARTICIPANTS & HOST

The division winner will be determined by the record in all games played (both divisional and cross-divisional) within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game representatives from each division:

#### Two-Team Tie.

1. Head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
  - a. If no game is played between the two tied teams or that game ends in a tie, the following tie-breaking procedures would be applied:
2. Record in games played within the division
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (Based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.
6. Total number of wins in a 12-game season. The following conditions will apply to the calculation of the total number of wins:
  - a. Only one win against a team from the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision or lower division will be counted annually.
  - b. Any games that are exempted from counting against the annual maximum number of football contests per NCAA rules (current Bylaw 17.9.5.2) shall not be included.
7. Coin toss.

#### Multiple-Team Ties.

The following procedures will only be used to eliminate all but two teams, at which point the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

1. Head-to-head (Best record in games among the tied teams).
2. Record in games played within the division.
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.

#### Pac-12 Championship Game Host

The Pac-12 Championship Game Host will be determined by the record in all games played within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game host.

#### Tie-breaking Procedure.


1. Head-to-head, if applicable.
2. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of Pac-12 regular-season games.
3. Record against the next highest-placed common opponent in the conference (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the conference.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Coin toss.

## PAC-12 BOWL ARRANGEMENTS - 2012-13

The Pac-12 is in the third year of a four-year bowl cycle. The Pac-12 Conference has agreements with seven bowl partners. The lineup is led by the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, which is the destination for the Pac-12 champion, unless said champion is ranked No. 1 or No. 2 in the final Bowl Championship Series rankings. If that were the case, the Pac-12 champion would play in the BCS National Championship Game hosted by the Discover Orange Bowl. Regardless of the disposition of the Pac-12 champion, a second Pac-12 team may be selected for an at-large berth in the Bowl Championship Series in any given year and other Pac-12 bowl partner arrangements provide for that occurrence. In addition to the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, Pac-12 bowl partners include, in order of selection, the Valero Alamo Bowl in San Antonio, Bridgeport Education Holiday Bowl in San Diego, Hyundai Sun Bowl in El Paso, the MAACO Bowl Las Vegas, the Kraft Fight Hunger Bowl in San Francisco, and the Gildan New Mexico Bowl in Albuquerque.
