AROUND THE PAC-12

- OREGON visits WASHINGTON where the victor looks to keep pace in the Pac-12 North Division race. It is also the final game at the current Husky Stadium. The game will feature a number of special ceremonies to mark the closing of the 92-year old facility for major renovations. Washington will play the 2011 Apple Cup and all of the 2012 season at the Seattle Seahawks' Century Link Field.
- ARIZONA STATE heads to UCLA where the Pac-12 South Division lead is on the line.
- WASHINGTON STATE senior WR **Jared Karstetter** has been named a National Football Foundation Scholar-Athlete. He will receive an \$18,000 postgraduate scholarship and is one of 16 finalists for the William V. Campbell Trophy as the nation's top-scholar athlete. If he is selected, the scholarship will grow to \$25,000.
- OREGON S **John Boyett**, STANFORD S **Delano Howell** and USC S **T.J. McDonald** are listed among the 20 quarterfinalists for the Lott IMPACT Trophy honoring college football's top defensive player, which recognizes both athletic performance and the personal character attributes of the player.
- Pac-12 defenses picked off 21 passes over the weekend, led by UCLA freshman S **Tevin McDonald** with three picks. Meanwhile, three were returned for touchdowns - ARIZONA senior S **Robert Golden** (91 yards), WASHINGTON STATE sophomore CB **Damante Horton** (76 yards) and USC sophomore CB **Nickell Robey** (33 yards). Prior to Saturday, the Pac-12 defenses had a total of 72 interceptions over the first eight weeks of the season (9.0 per weekend).

WALNUT CREEK, Calif.--Tailback **Chris Polk** of WASHINGTON, safety **Tevin McDonald** of UCLA and place kicker **Eric Whitaker** of STANFORD have been named Bank of the West Pac-12 Players of the Week in football.

Polk, a junior from Redlands, Calif., broke or tied a number of school records in the Huskies' 42-31 win over Arizona. Polk became the first player in Washington history to have 100 yards rushing and receiving in the same game. He finished the night with 144 yards on 34 carries and an additional 100 yards on four receptions. Polk scored five touchdowns (four rushing, one receiving) to tie the UW modern school record for touchdowns in a game. Additionally, he notched his 18th career 100-yard rushing game to set a new record. Polk joined Napoleon Kaufman as one of just two players in Washington history to rush for 1,000 yards in three seasons as he broke through the mark on Saturday.

McDonald, a redshirt freshman from Fresno, Calif., had three interceptions in UCLA's 31-14 win over California. The three interceptions tied the school single-game record, and McDonald became the fifth player to accomplish the feat. Rahim Moore had the last three-interception game for the Bruins in 2009 against San Diego State. McDonald also tied the Pac-12 freshman record with three picks in one game. He added three tackles as well.

Whitaker, a junior from San Diego, Calif., made both of his field goal attempts (33 and 29 yards) and all six of his PATs in Stanford's 56-48 triple-overtime win over USC. Whitaker was filling in for the injured Jordan Williamson, who entered the week leading the Pac-12 in scoring at 10.6 points per game.

Series: USC leads 5-0-0. Last: USC, 40-3 (2002)

Trojan Notes: The 56-48 triple overtime loss to No. 4 Stanford was the highest-scoring game in USC history. Besides the 104 combined points being a USC school record, the Cardinal's 56 points were the most ever by a Trojan opponent. . . Junior TB **Curtis McNeal** has led USC in rushing five times in 2011 and is riding a pair of 100-yard ground outing after rushing for a career-high 145 yards on 20 carries with the 2 TDs in the loss to Stanford. . . Junior QB **Matt Barkley**, who threw for 284 yards and 3 TDs against Stanford, needs 108 yards of total offense to move into third on the school's career total offense list. . . Sophomore WR **Robert Woods** is tied for second nationally in receptions (10.1, first in Pac-12) and is fifth in both receiving yards (123.9, first in Pac-12) and all-purpose running (177.9, second in Pac-12).

Buffalo Notes: Senior QB **Tyler Hansen** connected on 22-of-35 through the air for 285 yards and 1 TD in the 48-14 loss at Arizona State. He moved into fifth place all-time on CU's passing yards list with 4,851 yards; he passed John Hessler (4,788) and Mike Moschetti (4,797). He also became just the seventh player in CU history to attain 5,000 yards of total offense, as he now sits sixth with 5,231. . . Senior WR **Toney Clemons** (8 receptions, 97 yards, 1 TD) now has seven career TD receptions including the 21-yard grab in the loss to Arizona State. Those seven have covered 202 yards, or 28.9 per. He matched his CU career best with the eight catches and was one yard shy of his yardage high (he had 8-for-98 vs. Texas Tech last year).

Cardinal Notes: Stanford's winning streak continues and now is at 16 games. . . The Cardinal are 7-1 in the last eight games against ranked opponents. . . The 56-48 triple overtime win at USC was just the fifth overtime game in Stanford history. When USC took a 13-10 lead early in the third quarter, it was the first time Stanford had trailed in a game all season. . . Junior QB **Andrew Luck** has completed 117-of-157 passes (74.5) for 1,432 yards and 15 TDs over last five games. Stanford is 28-5 (.848) in Luck's 33 career starts. His 28 career wins as a starter rank first all-time among Stanford QBs. . . Senior WR **Griff Whalen** caught a team-high 6 passes for a career-best 102 yards vs. USC. He's caught 21 passes for 356 yards over the last four games.

Beaver Notes: Freshman QB **Sean Mannion** surpassed 200 yards passing for the seventh straight game in the 27-8 loss at Utah. He completed 27-of-49 passes for 231 yards. Only he, Sean Canfield (2009) and Derek Anderson (13 games in 2003) have thrown for 200 or more yards in seven straight games over the last decade. . . Junior WR **Markus Wheaton** posted a 3-yard TD reception, his first of the season. Wheaton had come into the game with a team-leading 51 receptions but no touchdowns. . . Senior P **Johnny Hekker** had four punts of more than 50 yards and in the process broke the OSU single-game record for average yards at 52.5. He broke Dainard Paulson's previous record of 51.2 set in 1959 against Oregon. . . With seven receptions senior WR **James Rodgers** pushed his career total to 206 receptions. He's one of three OSU players all-time with at least 200 receptions.

Cougar Notes: Senior QB **Marshall Lobbestael** completed 28-of-48 for 337 yards and 1 TD. He's thrown for 300 or more yards in four games this season. Only Arizona's Nick Foles has more 300-plus yard games with six. . . Sophomore WR **Marquess Wilson** caught 11 passes for 126 yards, while senior WR **Jared Karstetter** caught 7 balls for 114 yards. Wilson ranks 10th nationally/3rd in the Pac-12 averaging 111.1 yards per game. . . Sophomore PK **Andrew Furney** is now 5-for-5 on field goals of 40-yards or more and has hit his last six attempts. . . Sophomore **Damante Horton** returned an interception 76 yards for a TD at Oregon. It was his fourth straight game with an interception. . . WSU's 463 total yards are its fifth game this season with 400-plus yards of total offense. . . The Cougars have scored 266 points this season and are averaging 33.2 points per game. They scored a total of 235 points all of last season, averaging 19.6 points per game.

Golden Bear Notes: Junior P **Bryan Anger** booted a season-high punt for the third consecutive game with 64-yarder in the first quarter at UCLA, the first of his five punts on the day. He also had three punts of 50 or more yards and has 12 on the year. Anger also placed three punts inside the 20. Anger ranks 12th nationally/2nd in the Pac-12 with a 45.2 yard average. . . Senior DB **D.J. Campbell** had a career-high, and team-high, 11 tackles and recovered a fumble for the second straight game and the fourth time in his career. . . Senior WR **Marvin Jones** and sophomore WR **Keenan Allen** extended their streaks of consecutive games with a catch to 33 and 19 games, respectively. Allen needs 11 yards to post 1,000 receiving yards for the season.

Series: UTAH leads, 19-15-2. Last: UTAH, 27-24 (2005)

Ute Notes: The Utes posted their first-ever Pac-12 league win with a 27-8 win over Oregon State. Utah had averaged 13.0 points per game in four previous league contests. . Thanks to a season-high six sacks, the Utah defense limited Oregon State to 263 yards of total offense. Utah tops the league in total defense, allowing 325.6 yards per game. . . Senior DL **Tevita Finau** recorded three sacks. . . Junior RB **John White** posted a career-high 205 rushing yards on 35 carries (5.9 ypc) in the win over Oregon State. It was the first 200 yard rushing performance by a Ute in nine years. White's 114.4 yards per game average is third in the Pac-12 and 15th nationally.

Wildcat Notes: Senior QB **Nick Foles** is averaging a Pac-12 leading 366.1 passing yards per game. The Pac-12 single-season record is 342.9 yards per game, set in 2002 by Washington's Cody Pickett. . Foles needs 71 passing yards to reach 3,000 yards for the second straight season. Only one other Wildcat has thrown for 3,000 yards in a season twice - Willie Tuitama (2007, 2008). . . Senior WR **Juron Criner** has posted back-to-back 100-yard receiving games after posting 118 yards on 11 catches at Washington. Over the last two games, he's caught 21 passes for 219 yards and five TDs. His 29 career TD receptions are second all-time at Arizona, trailing only Theopolis Bell who hauled in 30 TD receptions from 1972-75. . . Senior PK **John Bonano** continues to impress. Since becoming the team's placekicker for the UCLA game, he's been perfect on all eight PATs and has connected on all five field goal attempts, including a career-best 47-yarder at Washington.

Sun Devil Notes: With the 48-14 win over Colorado, the Sun Devils now have scored 35 point or more six times this season. The last time that occurred was seven such games during the 2005 season. . . Junior RB **Cameron Marshall** rushed 15 times for 114 yards and three touchdowns in ASU's 48-14 Homecoming victory over Colorado. Marshall is tied for the league lead in rushing touchdowns with 12 (also Washington's Chris Polk). Over the last five games, he's rushed for 479 yards (95.8 ypg) and 10 TDs. . . Junior QB **Brock Osweiler** completed 18-of-28 for 307 yards and a pair of TDs. It's the third time this season he has thrown for at least 300 yards. Over the last three games, Osweiler has completed 72-of-115 (62.6%) for 923 yards (307.7 per game) and 7 TDs.

Bruin Notes: Junior QB **Kevin Prince** led UCLA to a 31-14 win over Cal with a career-best 19 carries for a career-high 163 yards rushing (8.6 ypc). It marked the first time since 1976 (Jeff Dankworth vs. Cal) that a UCLA quarterback has rushed for over 100 yards and the most by a Bruin quarterback since John Sciarra had 178 yards rushing against Tennessee in 1974. . . As a team, the Bruins rushed for 294 yards (5.7 ypc) in the win over Cal. Senior RB **Derrick Coleman** contributed to the ground game with 80 yards and 3 TDs. . . Junior P **Jeff Locke** had seven punts for a 44.3 yard average, including four inside the twenty yard line (including one at the one yard line, one at the five yard line, one at the three yard line). He also limited Cal's kickoff return to one return on six kickoffs as he had five touchbacks. On 13 possessions following a Locke punt or kickoff, Cal's average starting field position was the 16 yard line.

Duck Notes: Oregon has scored 40 or more points in each of the last seven games, averaging 50.4 points during its seven-game winning streak. . . Junior RB **Kenjon Barner** posted his third consecutive 100-yard rushing game with 107 yards on 11 carries (9.7 ypc) in the 43-28 win over Washington State. Barner has rolled up 393 yards over the last three games, averaging 131.0 per game and 7.6 yards per carry. . . Junior RB **LaMichael James** and junior QB **Darron Thomas** responded to action Saturday after being sidelined with injuries. James responded with 53 rushing yards on 13 carries (4.1 ypc), while Thomas connected on 8-of-13 passes for 153 yards and one TD. . . Freshman RB **De'Anthony Thomas** had 262 all-purposes yards, including a 93-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in the 43-28 win over Washington State.

Husky Notes: The Huskies have scored 30 or more points in seven games this season. That has not happened since the 2000 Rose Bowl squad scored 30 or more in nine games. . . Junior TB **Chris Polk** has rushed for 100 yards in seven of eight games this year and now has 18 career 100-yard games, a new school record. . . Polk ranks fifth in the nation in rushing (127.0 yards per game). . . More Polk: His 3,577 career rushing yards ranks 14th all-time in the Pac-12, second all-time at Washington behind Napoleon Kaufman (4,106 yard from 1991-94). . . Senior LB **Cort Dennison** continues to pace the Pac-12 in tackles, averaging 8.9 per game. In the win over Arizona, he added eight tackles and his first interception of the season, third of his career. . . The Oregon game marks the final game in current Husky Stadium before the 92-year old facility undergoes major renovation. The Apple Cup and the 2012 season will be played in Seattle Seahawks' Century Link Field.

OREGON TABBED TO WIN PAC-12 TITLE IN PRESEASON MEDIA POLL

LOS ANGELES -- Defending Pac-12 champion OREGON is the choice to win the 2011 Pac-12 Conference football title in a preseason poll of media members who regularly cover the league. The Ducks were listed in the top spot in the North Division by 29 of the 42 voters participating in the poll, collecting 239 points. Twenty-eight of those pollsters tabbed the Ducks to come out on top in the inaugural Pac-12 Championship Game. STANFORD was picked to finish second in the North Division, collecting the other 13 first-place votes in the balloting for the division race, with 11 of those members of the media casting a vote for the Cardinal to capture the Pac-12 title.

USC was picked to win the South Division with 230 points, edging out ARIZONA STATE, which tallied 207 points. Due to NCAA sanctions, USC is on probation and ineligible to participate in the postseason. Therefore, the Trojans would not be able to represent the South Division in the Pac-12 Championship Game. Should USC capture the South Division crown, the team finishing second would be the South Division's representative in the Pac-12 Championship Game. Arizona State collected 13 first-place votes in the division race, with three of the pollsters predicting a Pac-12 Championship crown for the Sun Devils.

The media poll has correctly selected the Conference Champion in 27 of 50 previous polls, including 10 of the last 11. Following are the results of the preseason media poll (points 6-5-4-3-2-1, first-place votes in parentheses):

PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

The inaugural Pac-12 Championship Football Game will take place Friday, December 2 at 8 p.m. ET/5 p.m. PT and telecast to a national audience on FOX. The Championship game will match the winner of the North Division vs. the winner of the South Division. The game will be played on the campus of the division winner with the best overall conference record. The winner of the inaugural Pac-12 Championship will earn the league's automatic BCS berth.

TIE-BREAK PROCEDURES TO DETERMINE DIVISION CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP GAME HOST

The Division Champion will be determined by the record in all games played (both divisional and cross-divisional) within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game representatives

Two-Team Tie.

1. Head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
 - a. If no game is played between the two tied teams or that game ends in a tie, the following tie-breaking procedures would be applied:
2. Record in games played within the division
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (Based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.
6. Total number of wins in a 12-game season. The following conditions will apply to the calculation of the total number of wins:
 - a. Only one win against a team from the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision or lower division will be counted annually.
 - b. Any games that are exempted from counting against the annual maximum number of football contests per NCAA rules (current Bylaw 17.9.5.2) shall not be included.
7. Coin toss.

Multiple-Team Ties.

The following procedures will only be used to eliminate all but two teams, at which point the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

1. Head-to-head (Best record in games among the tied teams).
2. Record in games played within the division.
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.

Pac-12 Championship Game Host

The Pac-12 Championship Game Host will be determined by the record in all games played within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game host.

Tie-breaking Procedure.

1. Head-to-head, if applicable.
2. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of Pac-12 regular-season games.
3. Record against the next highest-placed common opponent in the conference (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the conference.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Coin toss.

PAC-12 BOWL ARRANGEMENTS - 2011-12

The second year of a four-year bowl cycle kicks in this season and the Pac-12 welcomes a new addition to the lineup. The Gildan New Mexico Bowl in Albuquerque will feature the Pac-12's seventh selection against an opponent from the Mountain West Conference. The Pac-12 Conference has agreements with seven bowl partners. The lineup is led by the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, which is the destination for the Pac-12 champion, unless said champion is ranked No. 1 or No. 2 in the final Bowl Championship Series rankings. If that were the case, the Pac-12 champion would play in the BCS National Championship Game hosted by the Allstate Sugar Bowl. Regardless of the disposition of the Pac-12 champion, a second Pac-12 team may be selected for an at-large berth in the Bowl Championship Series in any given year and other Pac-12 bowl partner arrangements provide for that occurrence. In addition to the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, Pac-12 bowl partners include, in order of selection, the Valero Alamo Bowl in San Antonio, Bridgeport Education Holiday Bowl in San Diego, Hyundai Sun Bowl in El Paso, the MAACO Bowl Las Vegas, the Kraft Fight Hunger Bowl in San Francisco, and the Gildan New Mexico Bowl in Albuquerque.
