The Pac-12 posted has posted a winning record outside league for 30 consecutive seasons . . . The Pac-12 recorded a 37-9 record in non-conference action last season, posting the most wins ever outside of conference play. Since 1934, only one other season witnessed the Conference capture more than 29 wins in non-league play - 2002 (32-15) when the league played an eight game conference schedule, allowing an additional 10 non-conference games to be played.

PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OFFENSE: Javorius Allen, TB, USC

DEFENSE: Shaq Thompson, LB, Washington

SPECIAL TEAMS: Ty Montgomery, KR/WR, Stanford

SAN FRANCISCO - Running back **Javorius Allen** of USC, outside linebacker **Shaq Thompson** of WASHINGTON and wide receiver **Ty Montgomery** of STANFORD have been named offensive, defensive and special teams Pac-12 Players of the Week in football.

Allen, a junior from Tallahassee, Fla., ran for a career-high and game-best 205 yards on 26 carries with three touchdowns to help the Trojans upset No. 10 Arizona, 28-26. Allen has rushed for over 100 yards in five of the team's six games and has eclipsed the 100-yard mark nine times in his career (all within the past 12 games). He is the first Trojan since Reggie Bush (8) and LenDale White (6) in 2005, to have at least five 100-yard rushing games in a season (Bush's statistics were later vacated due to NCAA penalty). On the year, Allen has 781 rushing yards (5.8 average) on 135 carries with seven touchdowns, along with 23 receptions for 278 yards (12.1 average) with a touchdown. He is the only player in the nation with at least 750 rushing yards and 250 receiving yards. He leads the Pac-12 in rushing (130.2, 11th nationally), all-purpose running (176.5, fifth nationally) and rushing touchdowns (7, 23rd nationally).

Thompson, a junior from Sacramento, Calif., scooped up a fumble and returned it 100 yards for a touchdown in the Huskies 31-7 victory over California. The return was the longest fumble return in school history and was Thompson's fourth defensive touchdown of the season and his third fumble return for a touchdown. Thompson also recorded a game-high 11 tackles. Thompson ranks second in the nation in fumble recoveries with three and his average of .50 forced fumbles per game ranks him fifth in the nation.

Montgomery, a senior from Dallas netted 206 all-purpose yards in the 34-17 Cardinal win over Washington State. He tallied 71 of those yards on kick returns (3 returns) and 63 yards came on punt returns (3 returns). With 13 touches in the game, Montgomery averaged 15.9 yards per touch. Montgomery ranks in the top 10 in the nation for both punt return and kick return average. His punt return average of 21.6 ranks sixth, while his kickoff return average of 29.1 ranks tenth.

AROUND THE PAC-12...

Road Warriors: Pac-12 teams continue to excel on the road in league play. The visiting teams posted three wins in four games last weekend and are now 14-4 in league road games.

Pac-12 Rematch: STANFORD visits ARIZONA STATE in a rematch of last season's Pac-12 Football Championship Game. In rematches following the previous two Pac-12 Football Championship, the team which won the FCG followed with a victory in the regular season.

Can't Touch This: Three FBS quarterbacks have attempted at least 100 passes this season without an interception and all three hail from the Pac-12 - OREGON's **Marcus Mariota** (155 attempts), WASHINGTON's **Cyler Miles** (129 attempts), and UTAH's **Travis Wilson** (101 attempts).

Arms Race: In terms of the number of passes attempted, two of the Pac-12's top three quarterbacks will get to ice their arms this weekend with an open date - WASHINGTON STATE's **Connor Halliday** (FBS-leading 438 attempts) and ARIZONA freshman **Anu Solomon** (278 attempts)... Meanwhile, two signal-callers who have yet to throw a pick this season square off in Eugene where OREGON's **Marcus Mariota** has not thrown a pick in 155 attempts this season, and WASHINGTON's **Cyler Miles** remains clean in 129 attempts... In Berkeley, CALIFORNIA's **Jared Goff** ranks fourth in the FBS with a 173.1 efficiency rating and will take on UCLA's **Brett Hundley** who ranks sixth with a 170.1 efficiency rating. Hundley leads the FBS with a completion percentage of 72.2 percent... After an open date, OREGON STATE's **Sean Mannion** returns to action. Following three open dates during his career, Mannion has responded by completing 89-of-132 (.674) for 1,192 yards and 8 TDs.

Go Long: With the deserved attention that the Pac-12 quarterbacks are receiving, equal attention should be spent on those who are catching the ball... Four Pac-12 receivers are averaging better than 100 yards per game - ARIZONA STATE's **Jaelen Strong** (122.8 ypg), COLORADO's **Nelson Spruce** (122.0 ypg), WASHINGTON STATE's **River Cracraft** (112.7 ypg) and **Vince Mayle** (111.6 ypg)... Spruce leads the FBS with 10.3 receptions per game and 10 TDs... Prior to this season, there were a total of 28 pass plays in the history of the Pac-12 that were of 90 or more yards. The league already has five pass plays of 90 or more yards this season. No other season in the Pac-12 had more than two of that length... A total of 14 pass plays in the Pac-12 this season have been of 80 or more yards.

UTAH (4-1) at OREGON STATE (4-1)
Thurs., Oct. 16, 7 p.m. PT/10 p.m. ET, FOX Sports 2/P12N

UTAH: Utah moved up in the AP rankings to No. 20, its highest ranking since coming in at No. 20 on Dec. 22, 2010...Utah leads the nation in both sacks (28 total/5.6 per game) and tackles for loss (51 total/10.2 per game). Senior DE **Nate Orchard** ranks No. 1 nationally in total sacks (8.5) and sacks per game (1.7)... Sophomore PK **Andy Phillips** is 7-for-9 this season from 40+ yards, Phillips ranks seventh in the nation in individual scoring averaging 10.8 points per game... Junior P **Tom Hackett** ranks second nationally and first in the Pac-12 in punt average (48.0).

OREGON STATE: In five games, Oregon State has not allowed a point in the 3rd quarter this season...OSU has now won 29 of its last 35 games in which it had a 100-yard rusher...Senior PK **Trevor Romaine** hit three field goals in the win at Colorado, giving him 49 in his career and moves into second on OSU's all-time list passing Justin Kahut (2007-10)...Senior QB **Sean Mannion** set OSU's career total offense mark with 11,151 yards. Mannion needs 79 passing yards to move up to second on the Pac-12's all-time list, and 135 total offense yards to move up to third on the Pac-12's all-time list.

LAST TIME: Sean Mannion converted two crucial fourth downs in the fourth quarter and then threw a 6-yard TD pass to Brandin Cooks in overtime to push the Beavers past Utah 51-48. Mannion completed 27 of 44 passes for 443 yards and five TDs. Cooks had nine receptions for 210 yards and three scores. Travis Wilson passed for 279 yards and ran for 142 and three TDs while rallying the Utes from 13 points down to tie the score at 45-45 on a 9-yard run with 21 seconds to play.

UCLA (4-2) at CALIFORNIA (4-2)
Sat., Oct. 18, 12:30 p.m. PT/3:30 p.m. ET, ABC regional/ESPN2 reverse mirror

UCLA: Junior QB **Brett Hundley** accounted for four UCLA TDs, three passing and one rushing, in the 42-30 loss to Oregon. Hundley rushed for 89 yards to bring his career total to 1,314, the most rushing yards ever by a UCLA QB....Sophomore RB **Paul Perkins** rushed for a career-high 190 yards to help the Bruins post 553 total yards to increase the team's total offense average to 465.4 yards per game...The Bruins have scored in all 20 of their red zone drives this season, scoring 16 TDs.

CALIFORNIA: Sophomore QB **Jared Goff** was 35-of-51 through the air with 304 yards in the 31-7 loss to Washington. It was his ninth career 300-yard passing game, which ranks second in school history. Goff has 5,687 career passing yards, moving past Aaron Rodgers for ninth all-time at Cal...Junior WR **Bryce Treggs** had seven receptions for 48 yards and has now caught a reception in 26 of the last 27 games that he has played in, and in his last 20 contests.

LAST TIME: Bret Hundley passed for a career-high 410 yards and three TDs, and Paul Perkins rushed for an early score in a 37-10 victory over Cal. Hundley went 31 for 41 and completed 13 straight passes during the first half.

COLORADO (2-4) at USC (4-2)
Sat., Oct. 18, 3 p.m. PT/6 p.m. ET, P12N

COLORADO: Sophomore QB **Sefo Liufau** has three 300+ yard passing games this season, one shy of matching Koy Detmer's single-season record set in 1996...Colorado has gone for over 400 yards in five-consecutive games. The last time CU had five straight 400+ yard games was in the middle of the 1996 season...The Buffs are averaging 467.7 yards per game at halfway point of the season, more than 100 more yards more than their average at this point last season (369.9)...Junior WR Nelson Spruce leads the nation with 10 receiving TDs.

USC: Junior RB **Javorius Allen** ran for a career-best 205 yards and 3 TDs to help USC upset No. 10 Arizona, 28-26. The eighth straight USC-Arizona game to be decided by seven or fewer points. Allen has gone over 100 yards rushing in three consecutive games and five of six games. Allen leads the Pac-12 and is 11th nationally in rushing, averaging 130.2 yards per game. Allen tops the Pac-12, and is fifth in the FBS, in all-purpose yardage...Junior QB **Cody Kessler** had his streak of passes thrown without an interception end at 195, which dated back to last season.

LAST TIME: Javorius Allen ran for a career-high 145 yards on 21 carries and scored 3 TDs, QB Cody Kessler threw a pair of TDs and the Trojan defense came up with a pair of key turnovers and a safety off a blocked punt to lead No. 23 USC to a dominating 47-29 victory over Colorado.

WASHINGTON (5-1) at OREGON (5-1)
Sat., Oct. 18, 5 p.m. PT/8 p.m. ET, FOX Sports 1

WASHINGTON: Washington ranks third (tied) in the nation with 24 sacks...Senior DL **Hau'oli Kikaha**, with three sacks vs. Cal, now has an FBS-leading 10 on the season. Kikaha also leads the nation in tackles for loss (13.5)...With 15 takeaways and just one turnover, the Huskies' turnover margin of plus-14 is best in the nation (second-best is 11). The Huskies' one turnover leads the FBS (Oregon and Utah are tied for second with three each)...UW and Oregon are the only two teams in the country that have yet to throw an interception this year while USC and Utah are tied for third throwing one interception each...Sophomore WR **John Ross** has scored on four receptions of 55 yards or more (91, 86, 75 and 55) this season.

OREGON: With the win at UCLA, the Ducks improved to 12-0 in games following a regular season loss, dating to 2007...Junior QB **Marcus Mariota** has a streak of 32 games with at least one passing touchdown - which is the second-longest current streak in the FBS (Marshall's Rakeem Cato holds the FBS record with an active streak of 38 games)...Mariota continues to lead the nation with a QB rating of 193.7. Mariota's third all-time in career passing yards at Oregon with 7,963 yards and is in reach of the top two marks held by Bill Musgrave (8,343 - 1987-90) and Danny O'Neil (8,301 - 1991-94)...Senior OT **Jake Fisher** returned to start at left tackle, and the Ducks did not surrender a sack. Oregon has given up four sacks in the four games Fisher has started at left tackle and 12 in the two games he has not played.

LAST TIME: Marcus Mariota completed 24 of 31 passes for 366 yards and 3 TDs, added another 88 yards and one TD rushing, and the second-ranked Ducks won their 10th straight over their rivals to the north with a 45-24 victory over No. 16 Washington. Byron Marshall rushed 19 times for 106 yards and added 2 TDs.

STANFORD (4-2) at ARIZONA STATE (4-1)
Sat., Oct. 18, 7:30 p.m. PT/10:30 p.m. ET, ESPN

STANFORD: A rematch of last year's Pac-12 Championship game. Stanford has won the last four meetings... The Cardinal have allowed just six points in the third quarter through six games this season...Stanford has held its opponents to 20 or fewer points in 13 consecutive regular season games. Stanford has held opponents to 20 or fewer points in 27 of its last 34 games... Stanford has recorded at least one sack in 39 of its last 40 outings. Only game without a sack came in 2013 at Army, which attempted just 10 passes...In the win over Washington State, junior FS **Zach Hoffpauir** had a career-high 15 tackles (nine solo), including 12 tackles in the first half.

ARIZONA STATE: Since filling in for the injured Taylor Kelly, junior QB **Mike Bercovici** has completed 74-of-113 for 998 yards and 8 TDs. Last time out against USC Bercovici threw for a school record 510 yards and 5 TDs...Junior WR **Jaalen Strong** has eclipsed the 100-yard receiving mark in each of his last two games and has nine career 100+ yard receiving games... Senior S **Damarious Randall** and junior FS **Jordan Simone** lead the team in tackles with 51 and 45, respectively. Their combined 96 tackles this season are 26.3 percent of the total tackles made by the Sun Devils this season. Randall's 9.4 solo tackle per game average is tops in the country.

LAST TIME: Tyler Gaffney ran for 133 yards and scored 3 TDs in a dominating first half, leading No. 7 Stanford back to the Rose Bowl with a 38-14 victory over No. 11 Arizona State in the Pac-12 title game. Stanford jumped out to a 28-7 early in the second quarter. Gaffney did most of the damage, scoring on a 69-yard run on the Cardinal's second play and a pair of 1-yard runs. The Cardinal racked up 517 yards, while the defense held ASU's offense to 311 total yards.

OPEN DATE

ARIZONA: Freshman QB **Anu Solomon** completed 43-of-72 for 395 yards and hooked up with ten different Wildcat receivers in the 28-26 loss to USC. Solomon is averaging 382.7 yards in total offense per game, ranked third in the nation...Sophomore LB **Scooby Wright III** recorded three TFL's and added a sack. Wright ranks ninth in the nation in sacks per game, averaging 1.00.

WASHINGTON STATE: Senior QB **Connor Halliday** moved up to third on the Pac-12's career list for touchdown passes with 86 (former USC Trojan Matt Leinart is second with 99), and climbed to seventh on the league's career list with 10,775 passing yards. With his next "average" performance, he can slide up to fifth on the list. In doing so, he'd pass Alex Brink, WSU's career record holder with 10,913 yards (from 2004-07)... Sophomore WR **River Cracraft** set a WSU single-game record with 14 receptions against Stanford. He also tallied his fifth career 100-yard game, and fourth straight (43-576 yds).

PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

The Pac-12 Championship Football Game will take place Friday, December 5 at 9 p.m. ET/6 p.m. PT and telecast to a national audience on FOX. The Championship game will match the winner of the North Division vs. the winner of the South Division. The game will be played at Levi's® Stadium in Santa Clara. The winner of the Pac-12 Championship will earn the league's berth into the College Football Playoff.

TIE-BREAK PROCEDURES TO DETERMINE DIVISION CHAMPIONS

The Division Champion will be determined by the record in all Conference games played (both divisional and cross-divisional) within the Conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game representatives

Two-Team Tie.

- A. Head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
- B. If no game is played between the two tied teams or that game ends in a tie, the following tie-breaking procedures would be applied:
 - 1. Record in inter-divisional games.
 - 2. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (based on record in all games played within the Conference), proceeding through the division.
 - 3. Record in common Conference games.
 - 4. Highest ranking in the CFP poll entering the final weekend of regular-season games.
 - 5. Total number of wins in a 12-game season. The following conditions will apply to the calculation of the total number of wins:
 - i. Only one win against a team from the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision or lower division will be counted annually.
 - ii. Any games that are exempted from counting against the annual maximum number of football contests per NCAA rules (current Bylaw 17.9.5.2) shall not be included.
 - 6. Coin toss.

Multiple-Team Ties.

In the event of a tie for a division championship between more than two teams, the following procedure shall be used to eliminate all but two tied teams, at which point the two-team tie-breaking procedure shall be used.

- A. Head-to-head (best record in games among the tied teams).
- B. Record in inter-divisional games.
- C. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (based on record in all games played within the Conference), proceeding through the division.
- D. Record in common Conference games.
- E. Highest ranking in the CFP poll entering the final weekend of regular-season games.

Pac-12 Championship Game - Determination of Home Team

The home team in the Pac-12 Championship Game will be determined by the record in all Conference games. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the home team.

Tie-breaking Procedure.


- A. Head-to-head, if applicable.
- B. Record against the next highest-placed common opponent in the Conference (based on record in all games played within the Conference), proceeding through the Conference.
- C. Record in common Conference games.
- D. Highest ranking in the CFP poll following the final weekend of the regular-season games.
- E. Coin toss.

PAC-12 BOWL ARRANGEMENTS - 2014-15

The Pac-12 is in the first year of a six-year agreement with seven bowl partners that should provide the Conference with a competitive post-season bowl experience. The lineup is led by the Rose Bowl Game presented by Northwestern Mutual, which is the destination for the Pac-12 champion. In addition to the Rose Bowl, Pac-12 bowl partners include the Valero Alamo Bowl in San Antonio, the National University Holiday Bowl in San Diego, the San Francisco Bowl, the Hyundai Sun Bowl in El Paso, the Royal Purple Las Vegas Bowl, and the Cactus Bowl in Tempe. In 2014-15, the Rose Bowl Game is slotted as one of the College Football Playoff semifinal games. If no Pac-12 team was in the top four of the College Football Playoff poll following the 2014 season it would not have a team in the Rose Bowl. The displaced Pac-12 Champion and any other Pac-12 team ranked high enough would fill a berth in the other four bowls (Orange, Atlanta, Fiesta and Cotton Bowls). When the Rose Bowl does not host a semifinal game, the Pac-12 champion would play in the Rose Bowl unless it was ranked in the top four and would play in one of the semifinal games. The Pac-12 would back-fill the Rose Bowl game if the Pac-12 champion was in the top four and playing in one of the semifinal games.
