- Plenty of true freshmen are collecting playing time around the Pac-12 this season. Five teams have had 10 or more freshmen see action - COLORADO (13), ARIZONA (10), CALIFORNIA (10), OREGON STATE (10) and WASHINGTON STATE (10).

WALNUT CREEK, Calif.--Running back **LaMichael James** of OREGON and safety **Lance Mitchell** and fullback **Clayton York** of OREGON STATE have been named Bank of the West Pac-12 Players of the Week in football.

James, a junior from Texarkana, Texas, posted his third-consecutive game with 200 or more rushing yards as he piled up 239 yards on 30 carries and collected one touchdown in just over three quarters of play before leaving with an elbow injury in the 43-15 win over California. The Walter Camp National Offensive Player of the Week had four carries that were each over 30 yards. He became the first Pac-12 player since Marcus Allen in 1981 to accumulate three-straight 200-yard games rushing.

Mitchell, a senior from Pasadena, Calif., made seven tackles, including five solo tackles, and posted his sixth career interception in Oregon State's first win of the season, a 37-27 victory over Arizona. In addition, he recorded a fumble recovery and a pass breakup. Mitchell also made a 13-yard reception for a first down on a fake punt.

York, a junior from Bend, Ore., not only blocked his first punt, he returned it 41 yards for a touchdown to give the Beavers a 14-0 lead. It was Oregon State's first blocked punt for a touchdown since 2008 against Washington State. A walk-on, York also made one tackle on special teams.

31/nr USC (4-1) at CALIFORNIA (3-2)

San Francisco • AT&T Park (45,000)

Series: USC leads 63-30-5. Last: USC, 48-14 (2010)

Trojan Notes: USC owns a seven-game winning streak over the Golden Bears (Cal has averaged just 10 points in each of those losses) and Troy also has captured 9 of the last 10. . . Sophomore WR **Robert Woods** leads the nation in receptions (13.6 per game) and is third in all-purpose running (203.0 yards per game), while being on pace to shatter the school single season receptions and receiving yardage records. . . Junior QB **Matt Barkley** has completed 133-of-188 (70.7%) for 1,587 yards and 14 TDs with just four interceptions. A starter since the day he stepped on campus as a true freshman, he already is fifth on the school's career passing list (579 completions) and in total offense (7,063 yards). . . Freshman LB **Dion Bailey** leads the team with 40 tackles. . . Fast start for the Trojans as they are outscoring the opposition 43-10 in the first quarter this season.

Golden Bear Notes: Sophomore WR **Keenan Allen** caught nine passes for 170 yards and a touchdown at Oregon. In the game that was the 16th of his Cal career, Allen equaled DeSean Jackson as the fastest Cal player to reach 1,000 yards receiving, with Jackson also reaching the figure in during the 16th game of his Cal career in 2006. Allen has updated career totals of 85 catches for 1,158 yards receiving and nine touchdown catches. This season, he leads Cal in all key receiving categories with 39 receptions for 668 yards and four touchdowns. His 17.1 yards per catch average is the highest among the team's regular receivers. . . He is second in the league and sixth nationally in receiving yards per game with 133.6 yards per game. . . Senior PK **Giorgio Tavecchio** connected on a career-best 54-yard field goal in the first half at Oregon. It was one-yard shy of the school record 55-yard field goal held by Robbie Keen (vs. Washington, 1988) and Tom Schneider (vs. Stanford, 2006).

UTAH (2-3) at Pittsburgh (3-3)

Series: UTAH leads, 2-0-0. Last: UTAH, 27-24 (OT) (2010)

Ute Notes: After allowing just 74 yards rushing to Arizona State, Utah's rush defense is now allowing just 99.4 yards per game, which ranks second in the league and 19th nationally. It has held three of its five opponents under 100 yards rushing: BYU (11 yards), Arizona State (74 yards), Montana State (75 yards). . . Utah heads out of league this weekend to face Pittsburgh from the Big East Conference. Utah is 8-0 all-time against current members of the Big East Conference, including a 2-0 mark against Pittsburgh. The Utes have also played Louisville (4-0), South Florida (1-0) and West Virginia (1-0). . . Junior RB **John White IV** rushed for 85 yards on 17 carries (5.0 ypc) against the Sun Devils. He is third in the Pac-12, rushing for an average of 100.0 yards per game. White's 30-yard TD run gave him seven TDs on the season (6 by rush). He's second in the league, averaging 8.4 points per game.

COLORADO (1-4) at WASHINGTON (4-1)

Series: Tied, 5-5-1. Last: WASH, 17-14 (2000)

Buffalo Notes: Senior TB **Rodney Stewart** posted 203 all-purposed yards in the loss at Stanford. He is nearing the top spot in CU career all-purpose yards, as he has 4,228 all-purpose yards that's just 123 shy of Eric Bieniemy's all-time mark of 4,351. . . Stewart had a 76-yard reception, which was the longest play of Stewart's career. . . OLB **Woodson Greer III** saw his first career action, the 13th true freshman to play for CU in 2011, tied for the eighth most in the nation. . . Senior QB **Tyler Hansen** is now tied for seventh in career touchdown passes (27), pulling even with Steve Vogel (1981-84) and Darian Hagan (1988-91).

Husky Notes: Junior RB **Chris Polk** is second in the Pac-12 and eighth nationally with a rushing average of 122.2 yards per game. He has rushed for 100 yards in four of five games this year and now has 15 career 100-yard games, tied for second-most in school history (tied with Greg Lewis; record is 17, set by Napoleon Kaufman). . . Polk is second on the UW career rushing yards list with 3,172 yards (Kaufman holds the UW career record with 4,106 yards). . . Sophomore QB **Keith Price** remains second in the nation with 17 TD passes. Price is seventh in the nation in pass efficiency (173.7). If he were to maintain his current efficiency rating, he would easily surpass the school record (153.8 by Brock Huard, 1997). . . Price has spread his completions around as six different players have caught at least 10 passes, while four receivers have at least 200 yards in receiving yardage. . . Washington has scored 30 or more points in each of its first five games this season. Only twice before in UW history has a Husky team scored 30 or more in each of the first five games, in 1924 and 1991. In neither of those seasons did Washington extend its 30-point streak to six games.

BYU (4-2) at OREGON STATE (1-4)

Corvallis, Ore. • Reser Stadium (45,674)
1 p.m. PT • FCS-Pacific/(Sirius143/139, XM 143)
Series: OSU leads, 5-4-0. Last: BYU, 44-20 (2009)

Beaver Notes: : Freshman QB **Sean Mannion**, who was the only freshman starting quarterback in the BCS at last check, completed 32-of-41 passes (78.0 percent) for 267 yards and two TDs in the 37-27 win over Arizona to lead the Beavers to their first win of the season. He has completed 66 percent of his pass attempts this season. . . The Oregon State defense limited Arizona to 53 yards rushing and forced three turnovers in the victory. . . Sophomore RB **Jovan Stevenson**, who coincidentally hails from Tucson, Ariz., rushed for 99 yards (5.8 ypc) and one TD in the win over Arizona. His totals in the first four games of the season were 11 carries for 57 yards (5.2 ypc). . . For the eighth consecutive season Oregon State failed to reach Oct. 1 with a winning record – combined 12-19 (39%) – that's the bad news. The good news is, the Beavers are a combined 38-15 (71.7%) in the months of October, November and December starting with 2004.

7/5 STANFORD (5-0) at WASHINGTON STATE (3-2)

Pullman, Wash. • Martin Stadium (35,117)

4:30 p.m. PT • Versus/(Sirius 85, XM 85)

Series: STAN leads, 35-25-1. Last: STAN, 38-28 (2010)

Cardinal Notes: While junior QB **Andrew Luck** has been putting up stellar numbers this season as he completed 26-of-31 passes for 370 yards and 3 TDs in the 48-7 win over Colorado. It was the second highest passing game of his career. . . Credit the offensive line for giving Luck the time to find his receivers. The unit up front has allowed just two sacks in five games this season for a nation-leading 0.40 per game. . . Luck is third in the nation with a 182.33 passing rating. . . Senior LB **Max Bergen** blocked a Colorado FG attempt in the first quarter and returned it 75 yards for Stanford's first TD in the victory over Colorado . . . The Cardinal defense continues to stuff the run as it ranks second nationally, allowing just 61.8 yards per game. . . **David Shaw** is the first Stanford head coach to start his tenure with a 5-0 record since Chuck Taylor, who led the Indians to nine straight wins in his inaugural season in 1951.

Cougar Notes: In the loss at UCLA, sophomore WR **Marquess Wilson** set a career single-game high with nine catches, surpassing previous high of seven (vs. USC 9/25/10). . . Freshman RB **Rickey Galvin** caught his first career TD pass and set career highs with 16 carries for 93 yards at UCLA. Galvin leads WSU in rushing with 220 yards on 29 carries (7.6 ypc). . . Senior WR **Jared Karstetter**'s TD catch was the 16th of his career, moving him into a tie for 10th on WSU's top-10 career receiving touchdowns list. He finished with two catches to up his career catches to 130 and move into eighth place on WSU's all-time career receptions list. . . Sophomore PK **Andrew Furney** has kicked a field goal in all five games this season. His four field goals are a single-game career high. Furney is now 4-for-4 this season on field goals of 40-yards or more and has hit his last five attempts from 40-yards plus.

Series: ASU leads, 16-15-0. Last: ORE, 42-31 (2010)

Sun Devil Notes: Junior QB **Brock Osweiler** completed 25-of-41 passes for 325 yards and three touchdowns in the win at Utah. He tied his season-high in pass completions (25) and posted his second-most passing yards (325). His three touchdown passes tied a season high. Osweiler also rushed seven times for a season-high 34 yards. . . The Sun Devil defense picked off three passes at Utah, giving them a league-best 10 interceptions. That figure ranks sixth nationally. . . Senior WR **Gerrell Robinson** became the second Sun Devil, and 22nd Pac-12 player this season, to collect 100 receiving yards in a game as he caught seven passes for a career-best 101 yards at Utah. . . The Sun Devils look to snap a 15-game winless streak against teams ranked in the Top 10. The last victory over a Top 10 team came on the road at No. 6 Oregon, 45-42, on Oct. 19, 2002.

Duck Notes: Junior RB **LaMichael James** injured his right elbow (dislocation) early in the fourth quarter of Oregon's 43-15 win over California and the Ducks are uncertain on his return. James leads the FBS in all-purposes running with 229.6 yards per game. He rushed for 239 yards in Thursday's win. It was the third straight game with 200 or more rushing yards. In the last three games, he carried the ball 65 times for 731 yards (11.2 yards per carry). . . Autzen Stadium streaks: Oregon has a 19-game home field winning streak. The Ducks have won 14 straight conference games at home. . . In addition, Oregon has won 14 straight conference games dating back to a 2009 loss at Stanford. . . The crowd of 58,796 (capacity 54,000) marked the 77th consecutive sellout at Autzen Stadium, dating to 1999. The last non-sellout was Sept. 18, 1999 vs. Nevada.

OREGON TABBED TO WIN PAC-12 TITLE IN PRESEASON MEDIA POLL

LOS ANGELES -- Defending Pac-12 champion OREGON is the choice to win the 2011 Pac-12 Conference football title in a preseason poll of media members who regularly cover the league. The Ducks were listed in the top spot in the North Division by 29 of the 42 voters participating in the poll, collecting 239 points. Twenty-eight of those pollsters tabbed the Ducks to come out on top in the inaugural Pac-12 Championship Game. STANFORD was picked to finish second in the North Division, collecting the other 13 first-place votes in the balloting for the division race, with 11 of those members of the media casting a vote for the Cardinal to capture the Pac-12 title.

USC was picked to win the South Division with 230 points, edging out ARIZONA STATE, which tallied 207 points. Due to NCAA sanctions, USC is on probation and ineligible to participate in the postseason. Therefore, the Trojans would not be able to represent the South Division in the Pac-12 Championship Game. Should USC capture the South Division crown, the team finishing second would be the South Division's representative in the Pac-12 Championship Game. Arizona State collected 13 first-place votes in the division race, with three of the pollsters predicting a Pac-12 Championship crown for the Sun Devils.

The media poll has correctly selected the Conference Champion in 27 of 50 previous polls, including 10 of the last 11. Following are the results of the preseason media poll (points 6-5-4-3-2-1, first-place votes in parentheses):

PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

The inaugural Pac-12 Championship Football Game will take place Friday, December 2 at 8 p.m. ET/5 p.m. PT and telecast to a national audience on FOX. The Championship game will match the winner of the North Division vs. the winner of the South Division. The game will be played on the campus of the division winner with the best overall conference record. The winner of the inaugural Pac-12 Championship will earn the league's automatic BCS berth.

TIE-BREAK PROCEDURES TO DETERMINE DIVISION CHAMPIONS AND CHAMPIONSHIP GAME HOST

The Division Champion will be determined by the record in all games played (both divisional and cross-divisional) within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game representatives

Two-Team Tie.

1. Head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
 - a. If no game is played between the two tied teams or that game ends in a tie, the following tie-breaking procedures would be applied:
2. Record in games played within the division
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (Based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.
6. Total number of wins in a 12-game season. The following conditions will apply to the calculation of the total number of wins:
 - a. Only one win against a team from the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision or lower division will be counted annually.
 - b. Any games that are exempted from counting against the annual maximum number of football contests per NCAA rules (current Bylaw 17.9.5.2) shall not be included.
7. Coin toss.

Multiple-Team Ties.

The following procedures will only be used to eliminate all but two teams, at which point the two-team tie-breaking procedure will be applied.

1. Head-to-head (Best record in games among the tied teams).
2. Record in games played within the division.
3. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the division.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Highest BCS ranking following the last weekend of regular-season games.

Pac-12 Championship Game Host

The Pac-12 Championship Game Host will be determined by the record in all games played within the conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game host.

Tie-breaking Procedure.

1. Head-to-head, if applicable.
2. Highest BCS Ranking following the last weekend of Pac-12 regular-season games.
3. Record against the next highest-placed common opponent in the conference (based on record in all games played within the conference), proceeding through the conference.
4. Record in common conference games.
5. Coin toss.

PAC-12 BOWL ARRANGEMENTS - 2011-12

The second year of a four-year bowl cycle kicks in this season and the Pac-12 welcomes a new addition to the lineup. The Gildan New Mexico Bowl in Albuquerque will feature the Pac-12's seventh selection against an opponent from the Mountain West Conference. The Pac-12 Conference has agreements with seven bowl partners. The lineup is led by the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, which is the destination for the Pac-12 champion, unless said champion is ranked No. 1 or No. 2 in the final Bowl Championship Series rankings. If that were the case, the Pac-12 champion would play in the BCS National Championship Game hosted by the Allstate Sugar Bowl. Regardless of the disposition of the Pac-12 champion, a second Pac-12 team may be selected for an at-large berth in the Bowl Championship Series in any given year and other Pac-12 bowl partner arrangements provide for that occurrence. In addition to the Rose Bowl presented by Vizio, Pac-12 bowl partners include, in order of selection, the Valero Alamo Bowl in San Antonio, Bridgeport Education Holiday Bowl in San Diego, Hyundai Sun Bowl in El Paso, the MAACO Bowl Las Vegas, the Kraft Fight Hunger Bowl in San Francisco, and the Gildan New Mexico Bowl in Albuquerque.
