Opening Statement:

WR PAUL RICHARDSON (3-77-1 TD) P-Rich" now has 60 catches for 1,061 yards, 17.7 per, with nine touchdowns this season, and for his career, he has 133 for 2,130 yards and 20 touchdowns (seventh, sixth and tied for second, respectively, all-time at CU), as he continues to inch closer to all the CU season marks: 78 receptions (**D.J. Hackett**, 2003), 1,149 yards (**Charles E. Johnson**, 1992) and 11 TDs (**Derek McCoy**, 2003).

► His 53-yard TD reception was his ninth of the season, just the fourth Buff to have that many in a year; the nine have covered 465 yards, or 51.7 per; his 20 career have spanned 836 yards (41.8).

Washington Notes

- **Bishop Sankey** scored his 30th career rushing touchdowns in the first quarter to move into sole possession for third all-time in UW history. He trails only **Joe Steele** (32) and **Napoleon Kaufman** (34) on the all-time list. It also was his 13th rushing TD this year to move him into a sixth-place single-season tie with **Jake Locker** (2009) and **Hugh McElhenny** (1951).
- **Sankey** entered the day ranked 6th all-time in UW history with 2,788 rushing yards. His 143 yards today moves him to 2,932 yards and allowed him to leap-frog **Vince Weathersby** (2,811) and **Greg Lewis** (2,903) all the way to fourth on the list. Next up Joe Steele (3,168).
- **Sankey** surpassed 100 yards on the ground for the 14th time in his career, the fourth most all-time in UW history. He has rushed for over 100 yards seven times this season and in 11 of the last 14 games dating back to last season.
- **Keith Price** went over 300 yards for the sixth time this year, eighth time overall in his career. He did not attempt a pass in the second half.
- **Price** has been especially good against Colorado during his career. In 2011, Price was 21-for-28 for 257 yards and 4 TDs. In 2012, he was 22-for-29 for 248 yards and 5 TDs. Today he was 22-of-29 for 312 yards, 2 passing TD's and 2 rushing TD's. Together, that's 65-for-86 for 817 yards and 11 TD passes, 2 rushing TD's and 0 INTs.
- **Price** has 8,434 passing yards to move up to 23rd all-time in Pac-12 history. He started the day 27th on the list. He also has 72 touchdown passes in his career and moved into a tie for 10th all-time in Pac-12 history with Carson Palmer.
- **Austin Seferian-Jenkins** grabbed the 18th touchdown of his career to take sole possession of No. 4 on the UW's all-time receiving touchdown list. He now only trails **Reggie Williams** (22), **Jermaine Kearse** (29) and **Mario Bailey** (30).
- **Travis Coons** improved to 9-of-9 on field goal attempts with a 27-yard on the Huskies first drive.
- Defensive back **Kevin King** became the first true freshman to start a game this season for the Huskies.
- **Sean Parker** collected his first career sack, getting to Sefo Liufau for a 6-yard loss in the 2nd quarter.
- **Seferian-Jenkins** equaled his season-high of 62 receiving yards by halftime.
- **Tre Watson's** 84-yard interception return for a TD is the 9th longest in UW history and the longest since a 91-yarder by **Jermaine Smith** in 1997. It was the Huskies first defensive touchdown of the season and the first since **Marcus Peters** scored on an interception vs. Portland State on Sept. 15, 2011.
- **Marcus Peters'** fumble return of 53 yards was the Huskies first fumble returned for a TD since **Will Shamburger** vs. San Diego State on Sept. 1, 2012.
- Tonight was the first time since Nov. 9, 2002 against Oregon State that the Huskies' defense has scored twice in the same game.
- **Sean Parker** snagged his 4th interception this year and the 11th of his career. He is now tied for 7th all-time in UW history with his 11 picks.
- The Huskies scored 28 points in the second half without attempting a pass.
- Washington's 59 points are the fifth most since 1945. The 52-point win is the ninth largest margin of victory in the modern era and the fifth largest against a Conference opponent.
- Washington scored a touchdown on its opening third quarter drive for the eighth time in nine games this season. The only time they failed to do so was against Idaho State.
- The Huskies added to their school record total of surpassing 500 total yards for fifth time this season and also fourth times over 600 total yards this year. The Huskies came into the season with only six games all-time of going over 600 yards.
