The Pac-12 posted has posted a winning record outside league for 30 consecutive seasons . . . The Pac-12 recorded a 37-9 record in non-conference action last season, posting the most wins ever outside of conference play. Since 1934, only one other season witnessed the Conference capture more than 29 wins in non-league play - 2002 (32-15) when the league played an eight game conference schedule, allowing an additional 10 non-conference games to be played.

PAC-12 PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

OFFENSE: Marcus Mariota, QB, Oregon

DEFENSE: Scooby Wright III, LB, Arizona

SPECIAL TEAMS: Adoreé Jackson, CB/KR, USC

SAN FRANCISCO - Quarterback Marcus Mariota of OREGON, linebacker Scooby Wright III of ARIZONA and cornerback Adoreé Jackson of USC have been named offensive, defensive and special teams Pac-12 Players of the Week in football.

Mariota, a junior from Honolulu, Hawaii., threw for 326 yards and five touchdowns in Oregon's 59-41 win over California. After the Golden Bears went ahead 14-7 in the first quarter, Mariota led Oregon to score 17 straight points to take the lead. In the first half, he completed 11-of-18 passes for 190 yards and three touchdowns. It was Mariota's 34th consecutive game with a touchdown pass. He finished 18-of-30 for 326 yards and became Oregon's all-time passing leader with 8,299 yards. On the year Mariota has thrown for 2,283 yards on has completed 24 TD passes while throwing only one interception.

Wright, a sophomore from Windsor Calif., forced three fumbles and tallied three sacks to lead Arizona to a 59-37 win over Washington State. Wright led an Arizona defense that held WSU to 106 yards of total offense on its first five possessions of the game, which resulted in the Cougars punting three times, turning the ball over on downs once (Wright recorded the tackle for no gain on the fourth down play) and throwing one interception. Wright has now forced five fumbles this season, becoming just the third Wildcat since 1973 to have done so (Rick Hunley and Chris Singleton). He ranks second in the nation, averaging 2.0 tackles for loss per game, and third in the nation with 1.29 sacks per game.

Jackson, a freshman from Belleville, Ill., matched the USC record (with Anthony Davis and Marqise Lee) with a 100-yard kickoff return touchdown in USC's 24-21 loss at Utah. Jackson ranks fifth in the nation in kickoff returns averaging 33.7 yards per return. Jackson, who also plays offense and defense for the Trojans, also recorded 4 tackles (one for loss) and forced and recovered a fumble.

AROUND THE PAC-12...

Road Warriors: Pac-12 teams continue to excel on the road in league play. The visiting teams are now 20-9 in league road games. The five teams ranked in this week's AP Top 25 (Oregon, Arizona State, Arizona, Utah, and UCLA) have combined overall road record of 17-0.

South Division Leaders Get Tested: Over the next five weeks, each of the three one-loss teams in the Pac-12's South Division will face three ranked opponents - ARIZONA (vs. No. 25 UCLA, No. 18 Utah, No. 15 Arizona State); ARIZONA STATE (vs. No. 18 Utah, No. 6 Notre Dame, No. 14 Arizona); UTAH (vs. No. 15 Arizona State, No. 5 Oregon, No. 14 Arizona).

And Then There Was One: UTAH's **Travis Wilson** (143 attempts) is the only FBS quarterback to have attempted at least 125 passes this season without an interception. OREGON's **Marcus Mariota** had his streak of 253 passes without an interception, dating back to last season, come to an end against Cal when one of his passes was tipped twice before finding the hands of a defender.

The Record Book: OREGON STATE senior QB **Sean Mannion** is closing in on Matt Barkley's Pac-12 career passing totals. With 12,134 passing yards, Mannion needs 194 yards to eclipse the 12,327 yards Barkley accumulated from 2009-12.

Award Watch List: Several of the National College Football Awards Association (NCAA) awards are starting to list their semifinalists. Making the cut for the Butkus Award, honoring the nation's top linebacker, are UCLA's **Myles Jack** and **Eric Kendricks**, WASHINGTON's **Hau'oli Kikaha** and **Shaq Thompson**, and USC's **Hayes Pullard**. Kendricks and Jack rank 1-2 in tackles for UCLA with 93 and 62 respectively. Kikaha has posted an FBS best 19.5 tackles for loss and 14.5 sacks, while Thompson has 53 tackles, 3 fumble recoveries and one interception (all four were returned for a touchdown). Pullard leads USC with 59 tackles. No other conference had more than five players named to the list of 15 semifinalists...The Jim Thorpe Award semifinalists, which honors the nation's top defensive backs, include OREGON's **Ifo Ekpre-Olomu** and STANFORD's **Jordan Richards**. Ekpre-Olomu has 40 tackles and two interceptions this season. Richards has anchored one of the nation's great defenses as Stanford enters this week's game ranked among the top five statistically in scoring defense, total defense, passing defense and rushing defense. Richards leads Stanford in solo tackles (37) and has three forced fumbles.

WASHINGTON (5-3) at COLORADO (2-6)
Sat., Nov. 1, 10 a.m. PT/1 p.m. ET, P12N

WASHINGTON: Senior OLB **Hau'oli Kikaha** became UW's all-time career sack leader and tied the single-season record with two sacks during the Huskies first defensive series of the second half. He now has 14.5 on the season and is tied with Jason Chorak (1996) for most in a season. He has 31.5 on his career to pass Daniel Te'o-Nesheim (2006-09), who had 30 during his career. Kikaha is the 16th player in Pac-12 history with 30 or more career sacks. He is 11th on the all-time list with 31.5 during his career... Now have a school record six defensive TDs this season.

COLORADO: Battled to come from behind, before failing to UCLA in double overtime, 40-37...In the fourth quarter the Buffs out-gained the Bruins 186-65 in yards of offense. On the year in the fourth quarter, they have out-gained opponents, 980-614...Colorado extended its streak of games with 400 yards of total offense to seven games, totaling 500 yards against the Bruins. Colorado has gone for 500+ yards three times this season, its most since doing so three times in 2002...Junior WR **Nelson Spruce** has caught at least one pass in 21 straight games.

LAST TIME: Washington used a wealth of offensive weapons to post 628 yards of total offense, scoring on four of its first five possessions to defeat Colorado, 59-7. Keith Price was 22-of-29 for 312 yards and 2 TDs, while Bishop Sankey rushed 23 times for 143 yards and one score for the Huskies.

USC (5-3) at WASHINGTON STATE (2-6)
Sat., Nov. 1, 1:30 p.m. PT/4:30 p.m. ET, P12N

USC: Junior RB **Javorius Allen** is the only player in the FBS to record 100+ yards from scrimmage in eight games this season after rushing for 101 yards, his fifth-straight game with 100+ rushing yards, in USC's 24-21 loss at Utah. Allen leads the Pac-12 in rushing (1,046 yards) and all-purpose yards (1,326 yards) and is the only player in the nation with at least 1,000 rushing yards and 300 receiving yards. Freshman CB **Adoree Jackson** returned a kick 100 yards for a touchdown. Jackson ranks fifth in the nation in kick return average (33.7)... The USC defense forced a fumble at the goal line in the first quarter stopping the Utes from scoring on their opening drive. No Trojan opponent has scored on its opening possession this season.

WASHINGTON STATE: With his 489 passing yards against Arizona, senior QB **Connor Halliday** broke Alex Brink's WSU career record of 10,913 yards. He ended the night with 11,264 career yards, fourth on the Pac-12 career passing list. Halliday also has 90 career touchdowns, third all-time in Pac-12 play... Halliday's four touchdown passes marked the sixth-straight game, and seventh time this season, Halliday has thrown multiple touchdown passes in a game... Senior WR **Vince Mayle** tied the WSU single-game record with 14 receptions (145 yards).

LAST TIME: Andrew Furney kicked a 41-yard field goal with 3:03 to play, and Washington State beat No. 25 USC 10-7 for its first victory at the Coliseum in 13 years. Damante Horton had two interceptions. His first came in the final seconds of the first half that he returned 70 yards to tie the game at 7-7, while his second came with 2:18 to play to seal the win. WSU held USC to 193 yards total offense.

STANFORD (5-3) at OREGON (7-1)
Sat., Nov. 1, 4:30 p.m. PT/7:30 p.m. ET, FOX/FOX Deportes

STANFORD: Now 10-0 under head coach David Shaw following a loss... Allowed fewer than 30 points for the 31st time in as many games, the longest streak in the nation...Stanford has not allowed a third-quarter touchdown in 2014, yielding only three field goals through eight games... Has held opponents to fewer than 400 yards of total offense in 15 straight games, the longest streak in the nation... Senior WR **Ty Montgomery**'s 50-yard punt return for a TD in third quarter was second punt return touchdown on the season and fifth career return touchdown. He posted 147 all-purpose yards, surpassing the 100-yard mark for the 12th time in last 13 games.

OREGON: Junior QB **Marcus Mariota** has a streak of 34 games with at least one passing touchdown - which is the second-longest current streak in the FBS (Marshall's Rakeem Cato holds the FBS record with an active streak of 40 games)... Mariota continues to lead the nation with a QB rating of 192.2. With his 326 passing yards in the win vs. California, Mariota became Oregon's all-time leader in career passing yards at Oregon with 8,625 yards. He tossed 5 TD passes vs. Cal, giving him 87 for his career - 4th all-time in the Pac-12... Freshman RB **Royce Freeman** scored twice against Cal, giving him a Pac-12 leading 13 rushing TDs. He's posted three straight 100-yard rushing games, averaging 134.0 yards in that span.

LAST TIME: Tyler Gaffney ran for 157 yards, and No. 5 Stanford hammered No. 3 Oregon for three quarters before holding off a furious rally by the fast-paced Ducks for a 26-20 victory. Stanford ran the ball 66 times for 274 yards and controlled the clock (42:34 vs. 17:26) to keep the Duck offense off the field.

ARIZONA (6-1) at UCLA (6-2)
Sat., Nov. 1, 7:30 p.m. PT/10:30 p.m. ET, ESPN

ARIZONA: Scored its most points in a Pac-12 road game since 2008, (Also against Washington State) in the 59-37 win at Washington State...The win helped Arizona improve to 6-1, its best start to a season since 2010, and become bowl eligible for the third consecutive year...Sophomore LB **Scooby Wright III** recorded eight tackles, three sacks and forced three fumbles to take honors as the Walter Camp National defensive player of the week...Freshman QB **Anu Solomon** matched his season-high with five TD passes in the win at WSU. His 20 TD passes are the most by an Arizona freshman in a single-season and tied for fifth on Arizona's single-season best list...Sophomore WR **Cayleb Jones** returned a Cougars onside kick attempt 44 yards for a touchdown. It was UA's first kickoff return for a touchdown since 2010.

UCLA: With the 40-37 wins double-overtime win at Colorado, UCLA extended its road winning streak to eight games, its longest since 1997-98 (10)...Sophomore RB **Paul Perkins** had a 92-yard TD run, the second-longest run in UCLA history. Perkins carried the ball 19 times for 180 yards and two TDs, his fourth 100-yard rushing game of the season. Perkins has rushed for 996 yards this season and needs four yards to become the 13th running back in UCLA history to post a 1,000-yard season...Team tackling leader, senior LB **Eric Kendricks**, recorded his seventh game this season with double-digit tackles (16 vs. CU). Kendricks is second on UCLA's all-time tackle list with 425. He's 43 shy of tying Jerry Robinson (468, 1975-78).

LAST TIME: Linebacker Myles Jack displayed his offensive skills as he rushed for 120 yards on six carries, including a 66-yard touchdown run to help No. 16 UCLA beat Arizona 31-26. On defense, Jack had eight tackles and recovered an Arizona fumble in the UCLA end zone.

CALIFORNIA (4-4) at OREGON STATE (4-3)
Sat., Nov. 1, 7:30 p.m. PT/10 p.m. ET, P12N

CALIFORNIA: Sophomore QB **Jared Goff** was 32-for-52 for 360 yards and two TDs in the loss to Oregon. Goff posted his 11th career 300-yard passing game, which is a school record, while his 14th 250-yard passing performance ranks tied for first with Pat Barnes. Now with 26 TD passes this season, he ranks third on the school's single-season list, trailing Kyle Boller (28) and Pat Barnes (31)...In the loss to Oregon, junior RB **Daniel Lasco** had 186 all-purpose yards (15 carries for 85 yards and a touchdown; eight receptions and 101 receiving yard).

OREGON STATE: Senior QB **Sean Mannion** needs 194 passing yards to become the Pac-12's all-time leader, and 182 total offense yards to move up to third on the Pac-12's all-time list... OSU's pass defense is second in the Pac-12, allowing 191.9 yards per game through the air. The Beavers also have nine interceptions, tied for most in the Pac-12.

LAST TIME: Brandin Cooks caught 13 passes for 232 yards and Sean Mannion completed 35-of-45 (.778) for 481 yards and four scores as the Beavers knocked off California, 49-17.

UTAH (6-1) at ARIZONA STATE (6-1)
Sat., Nov. 1, 8 p.m. PT/11 p.m. ET, FOX Sports 1

UTAH: Improved to its best start since winning its first eight games in 2010, and is off to its best conference start after joining the Pac-12 in 2011, after defeating USC for the first time since 2001, 24-21...Attendance was 47,619, the largest-ever crowd at Rice-Eccles Stadium...Junior RB **Devontae Booker** scored his team-leading eighth rushing touchdown in the third quarter on a 24-yard run in the third quarter. He led Utah with 102 rushing yards (26 carries) for his fourth straight 100-yard rushing game. With 844 rushing yards, Booker needs 156 yards to reach 1,000 yards for the season.

ARIZONA STATE: After missing three games due to injury, senior QB **Taylor Kelly** returned to action in the 24-10 win at Washington...Head coach Todd Graham has called a timeout when his defense is facing third down 44 times in his three years at ASU and the defense has forced fourth down or a turnover on the ensuing play on 31 of those occasions (70.5 percent)...ASU was 3-for-5 inside the red zone against UW (TD, FG, turnover on downs, bad snap on FG attempt, TD). This season, they have scored on 30 of their 34 trips inside the red zone...With the victory the Sun Devils became bowl eligible for the third-straight year under coach Todd Graham.

LAST TIME: Taylor Kelly found Richard Smith for the go-ahead 14-yard touchdown with 2:37 remaining and the Sun Devil defense picked off a pair of Utah passes in the final three minutes as Arizona State held on to defeat Utah, 20-19. Trailing 19-7 after three quarters, the Sun Devils scored 13 unanswered points in the fourth quarter to complete the comeback.

PAC-12 CHAMPIONSHIP GAME

The Pac-12 Championship Football Game will take place Friday, December 5 at 9 p.m. ET/6 p.m. PT and telecast to a national audience on FOX. The Championship game will match the winner of the North Division vs. the winner of the South Division. The game will be played at Levi's® Stadium in Santa Clara. The winner of the Pac-12 Championship will earn the league's berth into the College Football Playoff.

TIE-BREAK PROCEDURES TO DETERMINE DIVISION CHAMPIONS

The Division Champion will be determined by the record in all Conference games played (both divisional and cross-divisional) within the Conference. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the Pac-12 Championship Game representatives

Two-Team Tie.

- A. Head-to-head competition between the two tied teams.
- B. If no game is played between the two tied teams or that game ends in a tie, the following tie-breaking procedures would be applied:
 1. Record in inter-divisional games.
 2. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (based on record in all games played within the Conference), proceeding through the division.
 3. Record in common Conference games.
 4. Highest ranking in the CFP poll entering the final weekend of regular-season games.
 5. Total number of wins in a 12-game season. The following conditions will apply to the calculation of the total number of wins:
 - i. Only one win against a team from the NCAA Football Championship Subdivision or lower division will be counted annually.
 - ii. Any games that are exempted from counting against the annual maximum number of football contests per NCAA rules (current Bylaw 17.9.5.2) shall not be included.
 6. Coin toss.

Multiple-Team Ties.

In the event of a tie for a division championship between more than two teams, the following procedure shall be used to eliminate all but two tied teams, at which point the two-team tie-breaking procedure shall be used.

- A. Head-to-head (best record in games among the tied teams).
- B. Record in inter-divisional games.
- C. Record against the next highest placed team in the division (based on record in all games played within the Conference), proceeding through the division.
- D. Record in common Conference games.
- E. Highest ranking in the CFP poll entering the final weekend of regular-season games.

Pac-12 Championship Game - Determination of Home Team

The home team in the Pac-12 Championship Game will be determined by the record in all Conference games. In the event of a tie, the following procedures will be applied to determine the home team.

Tie-breaking Procedure.

- A. Head-to-head, if applicable.
- B. Record against the next highest-placed common opponent in the Conference (based on record in all games played within the Conference), proceeding through the Conference.
- C. Record in common Conference games.
- D. Highest ranking in the CFP poll following the final weekend of the regular-season games.
- E. Coin toss.

PAC-12 BOWL ARRANGEMENTS - 2014-15

The Pac-12 is in the first year of a six-year agreement with seven bowl partners that should provide the Conference with a competitive post-season bowl experience. The lineup is led by the Rose Bowl Game presented by Northwestern Mutual, which is the destination for the Pac-12 champion. In addition to the Rose Bowl, Pac-12 bowl partners include the Valero Alamo Bowl in San Antonio, the National University Holiday Bowl in San Diego, the San Francisco Bowl, the Hyundai Sun Bowl in El Paso, the Royal Purple Las Vegas Bowl, and the Cactus Bowl in Tempe. In 2014-15, the Rose Bowl Game is slotted as one of the College Football Playoff semifinal games. If no Pac-12 team was in the top four of the College Football Playoff poll following the 2014 season it would not have a team in the Rose Bowl. The displaced Pac-12 Champion and any other Pac-12 team ranked high enough would fill a berth in the other four bowls (Orange, Atlanta, Fiesta and Cotton Bowls). When the Rose Bowl does not host a semifinal game, the Pac-12 champion would play in the Rose Bowl unless it was ranked in the top four and would play in one of the semifinal games. The Pac-12 would back-fill the Rose Bowl game if the Pac-12 champion was in the top four and playing in one of the semifinal games.
