

# 2005 COLORADO BUFFALO GOLF

## NCAA CENTRAL REGIONAL NOTES

**QUICKLY** The 108th Annual NCAA Golf Championships begin this week with 81 schools competing in three regionals around the country, though the **University of Colorado** won't be one of 27 schools competing in the 17th Annual NCAA Central Region Golf Championships in South Bend, Ind. ... It's just the fifth time in the 17 years of regional play that the Buffaloes did not qualify as a team; however, this will be the second time that CU did have an individual selected in those years the team did not advance... Junior **Edward McGlasson** (bio attached) will represent the Buffaloes in 2005; back in 2003, senior **Stephen Carroll** qualified and performed admirably, tying for 20th with a 72-71-72—215 scorecard. He did not advance to the NCAA Finals as only the top two finishers on teams not moving on also make the grade... The top 10 teams out of 27 competing in the Central Regional will advance to the NCAA Finals, set for June 1-4 in Cave Creek, Md. (Loyola, Md., is the host)... Ten out of 27 teams will also advance to the finals out the East and West regionals, taking place at the same time; the top two individuals from teams that do not qualify also will be invited to account for a 156-man field in the finals.

**QUICKLY II** Head coach **Mark Simpson** did not accompany McGlasson on the trip; Simpson was declared cancer-free after a five-month battle with lung cancer on April 12, but developed a blood clot in his left leg and underwent treatment last week and is not able to travel. Assistant coach **Brad Neher** was unable to attend as he is running two camps, so longtime SID (and golf SID) **David Plati** is chaperoning McGlasson at the regional... McGlasson will tee off at 1:03 p.m. (EST) on Thursday off No. 10 and at 9:00 a.m. Friday on No. 1; he will be paired with Patrick Sullivan (Arkansas-Little Rock) and Scott Anderson (Ohio State).

**THE SITE** This is the first time that the **Warren Course** at the University of Notre Dame will be hosting the NCAA Central Regional (it opened in 1999). The course will play to 7,011 yards and par-70 for the regional. It's the second straight year the Central Regional will be in Indiana, as Purdue hosted last year's in West Lafayette. **THE COACH** **Mark Simpson** (Colorado '83) in his 29th season as head coach of the Buffaloes. The 54-year old native of Durango, Colo., lettered three years as a Buff golfer, playing from 1970-73, and became an assistant coach right after his playing days. His college career highlight was winning the Weber State Invitational in 1971, with his coaching career highlight coming in 1981, when he was named the Big Eight and District Five Coach-of-the-Year. He was also named co-coach of the year in the Big 12 for 1999-2000. The program has enjoyed great success under Simpson's tutelage, with 15 trips to the NCAA Championships along with eight All-Americans and several all-league selections. His team's best finish in the NCAA's was an 11th place showing in 1981, and then the 14th place effort two years ago. He is a former president of the Golf Coaches Association of America, as he has been heavily involved in collegiate administration throughout his career. He was inducted into the GCAA Hall of Fame this past January. In his tenure, 119 of his 129 players have graduated (92 percent).



**SIMPSON ON McGLASSON:** "Edward set a goal at the start of the season of becoming an All-American, so he still has an opportunity to do that if he can advance to the finals. I think he can get that done. He's learned a lot this year, and his overall golf game is definitely in good shape. It depends if he can get his short game going and get the putter going. If he can, there is no reason in my mind that he can't reach his goal. He's familiar with the course, and he knows it fairly intimately from several previous rounds there. So if he can get a round or two under par, I believe he can make it the finals next month."
