**QUICKLY...**The University of Colorado (7-7, 0-3 Big 12 Conference) will travel to face the University of Missouri (7-8, 1-3 Big 12) on Tuesday, Jan. 18, at 6:05 p.m. MST at the new Mizzou Arena.

**BUFFS ON THE AIR...**All Colorado women's basketball regular and post season games are broadcast live on KKZN AM 760, Boulder's Progressive Talk station. **Carol Callan** of USA Basketball will handle Tuesday's play by play duties and will be joined by CU Director of Basketball Operations **Kris Livingston** with the color commentary.

**31ST SEASON...**Colorado is in its 31st season of varsity women's basketball sporting an all-time record of 584-320 (.646). The Buffaloes have made 12 NCAA Tournament appearances, all since 1988, including six Sweet 16 appearances and three trips to the Elite Eight (1993, 1995 & 2002).

**LEAGUE SEASON WELL UNDERWAY...**Colorado will look to break its second three-game losing streak of the season on Tuesday. The Buffs have dropped their first three Big 12 games after entering league play on a five-game winning streak. CU has started its schedule with Iowa State and Texas Tech, who are both ranked and currently lead the Big 12 with unblemished 4-0 records. CU's third opponent, Nebraska, was unbeaten in league play until Saturday's loss at Kansas State and remains tied for third in the Big 12 standings with the Wildcats at 3-1. Sophomore forward **Anna Nedovic** leads a balanced CU scoring attack at 11.1 points per contest. Nedovic, who also posts a team-high 6.9 rebounds per game, is one of six Buffs averaging at least six points per game. Senior point guard **Veronica Johns-Richardson** is averaging 10.1 points per contest and paces the Buffaloes in 3-point field goals (21), steals (29) and assists (42). The freshman duo of forward **Jackie McFarland** and center Kara Richards have nearly identical outputs, combining for 19.3 points and 11.3 rebounds per game. Richards, who has started all 14 games, has a team-best .516 shooting percentage and is averaging 10.1 points and 5.5 rebounds a contest. McFarland, a two-time Big 12 Rookie of the Week, is averaging nine points and 5.8 rebounds per game. On the outside, sophomore **Jasmina Ilic** averages 8.9 points per game coming off a recent 15-point, nine-rebound performance against Nebraska. Junior shooting guard **Whitney Law** is sixth on the squad in the scoring column (6.6 ppg) and has a team-best .433 average from 3-point land (13-of-30).

**No. 13 TEXAS TECH DOWNS BUFFALOES...****Jackie McFarland** scored 11 points and grabbed six rebounds but it was not enough as No. 13 Texas Tech beat Colorado 87-41 on Jan. 15 at the Coors Events Conference Center.

Alesha Robertson scored 27 points and Chesley Dabbs had a career-high 22 for the Lady Raiders. Cisti Greenwalt added 12 points and LaToya Davis had 10 for Texas Tech (12-3, 4-0 Big 12 Conference).

The Lady Raiders limited Colorado to 31 percent shooting in winning their seventh straight and posting their most lopsided win over the Buffaloes. Colorado's 41-point output was the ninth lowest in team history and third lowest in Boulder.

Colorado used an 8-0 run in the first two minutes of the second period to cut a 17-point halftime deficit to 39-28. However the Lady Raiders responded with a 32-3 run over the next 14:07 to put the game out of reach. The loss was the third largest at the CECC in team history.

**Jasmina Ilic** and **Kara Richards** both scored nine points for Colorado (7-7, 0-3 Big 12).

**TIGERS UP AND DOWN IN 2005...**Missouri will be looking to break a three-game losing streak of its own against the Buffaloes. The Tigers' lone league win came at home against Oklahoma State (67-49) on Jan. 5. Missouri has been riding a virtual roller coaster of sorts this season. After a 4-2 start, the Tigers dropped three straight to fall to 4-5. Missouri followed that with a three-game winning streak, only to drop its last three. Sophomore guard Tiffany Brooks leads the the Tigers scoring attack 14.7 points per game. Junior

center Christelle N'Garsanet posts a team-high six rebounds per game and averages 12.8 points a contest. LaToya Bond, a junior guard, leads the Tigers in assists (58) and is Missouri's third scorer in double digits at 12.4 per game.

**COLORADO-MISSOURI SERIES...**This will be the 56th meeting between Colorado and Missouri, the most-played series in team history. Colorado holds a 33-22 lead in the series and has won six of the last seven overall meetings. Missouri's lone win in that span came in Columbia on Feb. 2, 2003 (71-52). This will be CU's first trip to the new Mizzou Arena which opened earlier this season. The Tigers previously played their games at the Hearnes Center on campus. Missouri holds a 13-11 advantage over the Buffaloes in Columbia.

**LOSING STREAKS DONT NECESSARILY MEAN LOSING SEASONS...**Colorado is 0-3 in the Big 12 Conference for the first time since the 2001-02 season. That year the Buffs lost their first three league games, but then won the next eight and finished 11-5 in league play en route to the Elite Eight. The Buffaloes will be trying to avoid their first four-game losing streak since a five-game winless stretch during the middle of the 1999-2000 Big 12 season. Colorado started 0-3 on four previous occasions (1987-88, 1991-92, 1999-00, 2001-02), but rebounded to have a winning league record in all but one of those campaigns (1999-00). CU has never started any conference season 0-4.

**AGAINST THE NATION'S BEST...**Colorado's loss to Texas Tech dropped the Buffaloes to 0-2 against ranked teams this season. Colorado has lost eight straight against teams ranked in the two major polls dating back to last season. The Buffs' last win over a ranked team came in the 2003-04 league opener at Baylor where CU took care of the No. 24 Bears 69-59 on Jan. 7. CU is 47-88 all-time against ranked opponents and has a 27-24 mark in Boulder. As of the most recent polls, Colorado has five remaining games against ranked teams including two against Kansas State.

**BUFFS CONTINUE SUCCESS IN PRESEASON...**With a five-game winning streak in December, Colorado clinched its fifth straight season with a record of .500 or better during the nonconference regular season schedule. The Buffs have only finished below .500 twice during the nonconference schedule in the Ceal Barry era going 5-6 in 1999-2000 and 4-9 in 1984-85.

**VJ FROM DOWNTOWN...**Senior Veronica Johns-Richardson has tied Emily Waner (2003-04) for the 10th spot on Colorado's career 3-point field-goals made list. She has a team-leading 21 trey's already this season, helped by a school-record tying seven against Northern Colorado on Dec. 29. Johns-Richardson is currently fifth in the Big 12 in 3-point field goal percentage this season at .429.

**JUMPIN IN JANUARY...**Colorado is 148-108 (.578) all-time in the month of January. The Buffaloes have won 20 of their last 26 January games dating back to the 2001-02 season, including a 7-1 mark last season.

**COLORADO WELL REPRESENTED WITH BIG 12 ROOKIES OF THE WEEK...**Colorado has been a popular choice in the voting for Big 12 Rookie of the Week this season. Of the seven weeks the award has been given, Colorado has been represented three times.

Forward Jackie McFarland has received the honor twice -- on Dec. 6 and Jan. 3. Center Kara Richards earned the award in the first week of the regular season, back on Nov. 22.

Most recently, McFarland was cited for her performance over the holiday break where she averaged 10.7 points, 7.3 rebounds, 3.0 assists and connected on 68.4 percent of her field goals (13-of-19). McFarland had 16 points on a career-best 8-of-13 shooting against Washington, which included the game-winning layup with under two seconds left in overtime. McFarland made all three of her shots from the field and had five rebounds against Northern Colorado. She then recorded her second career double-double by scoring 10 points and recording a career-high 11 rebounds against Manhattan while adding four assists, two blocks and two steals.

In her first effort, McFarland led Colorado and established career-highs with 23 points and eight rebounds in CU's five-point loss at Wyoming on Dec. 1. She hit 8-of-14 from the field (.571) and 7-of-8 from the line (.875) against the Cowgirls. She then registered her first career double-double with 19 points and a new career-best 10 rebounds against Creighton on Dec. 4. She hit 9-of-10 from the free-throw stripe and added two blocks, one steal and one assist. For the week McFarland averaged 21.0 ppg, 9.0 rpg and 1.0 bpg.

Richards averaged 13.5 points, three rebounds and 1.5 blocks in her first two collegiate games. The Graham, Texas, native scored 13 points and pulled down six rebounds in her first game, a Colorado win over Loyola Marymount. She was the first Buff freshman to start the season opener since Linda Lappe in 1998. Richards hit 7-of-10 from the floor for 14 points in CU's loss to Nevada.

**FRESHMAN LEADERS IN THE BIG 12...**Colorado's duo of **Kara Richards** and **Jackie McFarland** are featured prominently in the Big 12's freshman statistics. Richards is second in scoring (10.4 ppg) and McFarland is fourth (9.0 ppg) among all league freshman. McFarland is second rebounding (5.8 rpg) while Richards is just behind in third (5.5 rpg). Richards is also second in field-goal percentage at .516 (minimum of 50 attempts) and third in blocks (1.14 bpg). McFarland is fifth in field-goal percentage (.483), fifth in assists (1.38 apg) and seventh in blocked shots (0.69). Reserve guard **Yari Escalera** is fourth in assists (1.71 apg), sixth in steals (1.00 spg) and ninth in 3-point field-goal percentage (.263).

**SOME STREAKS ENDING...**Prior to the loss against Creighton, Colorado had won 10 straight games at home following a road loss. The three-game losing streak is also the program's first since the 2001-02 season (78-67 at No. 3 Oklahoma on Jan. 2, 70-68 vs. No. 21 Texas on Jan 6, and 75-72 at No. 14 Kansas State on Jan. 9) and the losses to Wyoming and Creighton were CU's first back-to-back setbacks against unranked teams since the 2000-01 season (72-70 vs. CSU on Dec. 6 and 92-66 at Iowa on Dec. 10).

**A BARRY GOOD MILESTONE...**By coaching the Buffaloes against Loyola Marymount in the season opener, head coach **Ceal Barry** passed legendary track & field coach Frank Potts for the most events coaches in school history at 642. She already holds the CU record for wins in any sport (420) and has coached in more games (645) than any coach in school history.

**HOWARD LEAVES THE BUFFALOES...**Leslie Howard, a 5-10 sophomore forward from Salem, Mo., has left the CU basketball program for personal reasons. Howard played in the first four games of the season averaging 6.3 points and 3.5 rebounds per game including a career-high 14 points against Pennsylvania on Nov. 26. She played 24 games in a Colorado uniform averaging three points and just over one rebound per contest.

**FOR OPENERS...**Colorado improved to 26-5 all-time in season openers and has won 17 of its last 18. The Buffs are 19-3 under Ceal Barry in season-opening games and have won the last five. This season marked the first time since the 1999-2000 season the Buffs didn't open the season in Boulder (at Denver) and the first time since 1996-97 (at BYU) the Buffs didn't begin the season in the state of Colorado.

**SECOND AT COORS...**Colorado placed second at the 18th annual Coors Classic, Nov. 26-27, at the Coors Events Center. The Buffaloes took care of business with a 69-49 win over Pennsylvania in the first round, but fell to then No 2 ranked, and now top-ranked, LSU 75-44. Freshman **Kara Richards** was awarded All-Tournament team honors after achieving career-highs with 11 rebounds and six assists against Penn and 10 rebounds, three steals and two blocks against the Tigers. Leslie Howard scored a career-high 14 points against Penn while **Anna Nedovic** and **Whitney Law** each had 10. LSU held Colorado to a school record low 24 percent shooting in the championship game. Preseason Player of the Year candidate Seimone Augustus took home tournament MVP honors.

**PRESEASON TOURNAMENTS...**Colorado is 86-31 all-time in preseason tournaments, including a solid 30-6 mark in the Coors Classic. The Buffaloes have won 23 of their last 29 preseason tournament games and went 5-1 last season winning the WBCA Classic and Coors Classic Tournament championships.

**LIGHTS, CAMERA, BUFFS...**The Colorado Athletic Department and Fox Sports Rocky Mountain have agreed to televise seven Buffs' women's basketball games this season. Add that to the three national Fox Sports Network games scheduled through a combination of Big 12 and Pac 10 Conference pacts, CU women's basketball is scheduled for a school-record 10 regular season television games this winter.

**TOUGH SCHEDULE...**Colorado's schedule is once again a tough one, with the Buffs facing nine teams that played in the 2004 NCAA tournament. The Big 12 offers one of the toughest schedules in the nation, as

seven members played in the NCAA's a season ago, with Texas and Baylor making the Sweet 16. Colorado's Coors Classic alone featured three teams who played in the NCAA Tournament last season, Penn, LSU and Maryland.

**HEAD COACH CEAL BARRY...**Ceal Barry is in her 22nd season at Colorado, and 26th overall has a collegiate head coach. Barry's overall coaching record is 508-272 with the win total ranking 20th among active NCAA Division I coaches. At Colorado Barry has led the Buffaloes to a 425-230 record, including 13 20-win seasons and 12 trips to the NCAA Tournament.

As a head coach Barry is 30-19 against Missouri, 30-18 while at Colorado.

**BUFFS PICKED SEVENTH, SIXTH IN BIG 12 POLLS...**Colorado was picked to finish seventh in the annual Big 12 Coaches Preseason poll while the media said the Buffaloes would finish sixth in their preseason poll. Texas was the overwhelming favorite in both polls. The Longhorns received 11 of 12 first place votes in the coaches poll (coaches aren't allowed to vote for their own teams) and 12 of 14 first place votes in the media poll. Colorado was picked fifth in both the 2003-04 and 2002-03 preseason polls only to achieve a higher standing by the end of the season. CU enjoyed a third-place finish last season and a fourth-place showing in 2002-03. The Buffs have not finished lower than fourth in the Big 12 standings since the 1999-2000 season.

**NATIONAL POLLS...**Colorado was not ranked in either of the major polls this week. Six of CU's 2004-05 opponents are in the current top 25 including four in the top 15. LSU is ranked second and Baylor is ranked third in the latest Coaches poll while the teams flop positions in the AP poll. In the coaches poll Texas is 11th, Texas Tech is 13th, Kansas State is 22nd and Iowa State is 24th. In the AP poll, Texas is 12th, Texas Tech is 13th, Kansas State is 23rd and Iowa State is 24th.

**HOME SWEET HOME...**The Buffs are 321-94 (.773) at home all-time, with an even more impressive record at the Coors Events/Conference Center, turning in a record of 288-73 (.798). Under head coach Ceal Barry the Buffs are 236-72 (.766) at the CECC. CU has turned in six undefeated seasons at home in 28 seasons, including three consecutive years from 1980-83. Most recently the Buffs were perfect at home in 1993-94 when they went 13-0 at the CECC, 27-5 overall. Colorado owns the seventh-longest home winning streak in NCAA history, going for 53-straight during the early 80s.

**THE BUFFALO STAMPEDE...**Coach Ceal Barry's television show airs on Fox Sports Rocky Mountain on Friday evenings at 7:30 p.m. Hosted by Sandy Williams, the show incorporates all of CU's athletic department and is filmed on location in and around Boulder and is produced by BuffVision, the partnership that brings us the fantastic video boards at Folsom Field.
