Pac-12 Championships

April 27-29 • Pullman, Wash. • Palouse Ridge Golf Club • Washington State host



Quickly...

The inaugural Pac-12 Women's Golf Championship will be held at the Palouse Ridge Golf Club in Pullman, Wash., April 27-29, with Washington State serving as host. The Buffs are the No. 4 seed entering the tournament, earning a tiebreaker with fifth-seed California on the strength of having defeated the Bears four times this season. The Buffs are seeded behind only No. 1 UCLA, No. 3 USC and No. 4 Arizona State.

The Buffs enter the 2011-12 postseason on a two event win streak and coming off perhaps the three best performances in school history. CU finished second at the Sugar Bowl on Feb. 26-28, finishing three strokes behind Duke but ahead then No. 2 Alabama, No. 3 Auburn and No. 4 Southern California. Golfweek ranked the field the second-toughest in the nation this season.

CU then enjoyed a perfect March, winning both the Clover Cup (March 16-18, Scottsdale, Ariz.) and the Anuenue Spring Break Challenge (March 26-27, Maui, Hawai'i).

At the Clover Cup, CU rewrote the record book, posting the top team score in each of the three rounds by at least six strokes, cruising to a 31-stroke victory with the top three individuals and four in the top six of the final standings.

Colorado had to fight off the field to maintain the lead and win the Anuenue Spring Break Challenge, in the end winning by two strokes.

The Buffs also won the Edean Ihlandfelt Invitational in Sammamish, Wash., in the fall, earning three tournament titles for the first time in school history.

CU vs. The Pac-12...

The Buffaloes have faced each of the other 10 teams in the Pac-12 (Utah does not have a women's golf team) at some point or another this season at least twice, facing every team at the SEC/Pac-12 Challenge to close out the fall and then every school at least one other time during the season.

CU is a combined 19-12 with perfect records against California, Oregon State, Stanford and Washington State to go with an impressive 4-1 record against Oregon. CU split with Washington (1-1) and topped USC once in three tries while CU hasn't defeated Arizona, Arizona State or UCLA.

Overall this season, the Buffs are 101-29-1 and outside of the Pac-12, the Buffs own an impressive 82-17-1 mark (.825).

This spring, the Buffs are 9-6 against Pac-12 teams having faced Oregon the most and holding a 3-0 record over the Ducks. CU is also 2-0 over Oregon State, 1-0 over Cal, Stanford and Washington State.

In the last three events when the Buffs have had arguably the three best performances in school history, CU is 5-0 against Pac-12 teams, having topped USC and Oregon at the Sugar Bowl (Feb. 26-28) and Cal, Oregon and Oregon State at the Anuenue Spring Break Challenge (March 26-27).

Head Coach Anne Kelly • Coach of the Year Candidate

It's no coincidence that Colorado's climb as one of the top programs in the nation has coincided with the hiring of Anne Kelly as its second head coach in 1997.

In her 15th season as head coach of the Colorado women's golf team, Kelly and the Buffs took the challenge of entering the nation's toughest conference head-on, as the Buffs have made national waves in the first year of the newly expanded Pac-12 Conference and Kelly should be a leading candidate for both Pac-12 and national Coach of the Year honors.

Kelly returned to her native Colorado from the University of North Carolina at Greensboro, where she filled head coaching duties for one-and-a-half years. Prior to her work at UNC Greensboro, she spent five years from 1991-96 as a teaching professional at Silverbell Golf Course in Tucson, Ariz., where she earned PGA Class A status, a position which followed a six-year stint from 1984-90 on the LPGA Tour.

During her six seasons on the women's tour, Kelly won a Women's Professional Golf Tour event in Phoenix in 1991. She fired a career low round of 69 at the 1989 McDonald's Championship and her career best finishes included several top-20 finishes. Her professional career culminated in a career low scoring average of 74.63 in 1990.

Kelly sparkled as a collegiate golfer, earning four letters for head coach Fred Warren and the Texas Christian University women's golf team. She was a member of the Horned Frogs' 1983 NCAA Championship team, and, all told, won 25 tournament team titles during her four-year career from 1979-83. She was named the team's most valuable player in 1980 and won TCU's Dutch Meyer Award, which recognizes the school's outstanding student-athletes, in 1983. She also tied for top individual honors in the San Jose State Lady Spartan Classic in 1982. Her 1983 NCAA Championship team was inducted into the TCU Hall of Fame in October 2000.

"I love coaching because it allows me to combine my competitive experience and professional golf experience into one job," Kelly says. "All of my different experiences in golf help me to assist team members in whatever situation they might encounter."

At UNC Greensboro, Kelly was named the 1997 Big South Conference Coach of the Year after the team won two tournaments. She coached UNCG's Becky Morgan to five individual tournament titles and second-team All-America standing on the year and, under Kelly's tutelage, Morgan finished 10th individually at the 1997 NCAA Championships and also earned GTE Academic All-America honors. Morgan is now in her fifth year as an LPGA and European tour member.

Since Kelly's arrive in 1997, the team has shown steady improvement and progress every year, culminating with the best season in program history last year. She has coached the Buffs to six tournament wins and 28 second or third place finishes. Last season, the Buffs finished in the top five in all 10 regular season events with two victories, one runner up and one third place finish.

The program took a big step forward with its first appearance in the NCAA Regionals in 2009 after several seasons of being right on the edge of selection. The Buffs made their second ever appearance in 2011 and will host the NCAA West Regional at Colorado National Golf Course this coming season.

The program has seen individual players excel both on the course and in the class room.

The Buffs have had 26 players earn 53 Academic All-Big 12 honors during Kelly's tenure and the Buffs time in that league, and seven Buffs have been named to the prestigious NGCA All-America Scholars team, including for the first time two players in 2011 with Taylor Doyle and Jessica Wallace. Former Buff Maria Persson-Gulda was named to that team three times and was also honored with an NCAA postgraduate scholarship. She was honored as CU's top female student athlete academically in 2006, an honor that current Buff Jamie Befort has racked up twice. Additionally, an astonishing 47 CU players have earned mention on the Big 12 Commissioner's Honor Roll (3.0 GPA or higher in a semester) a total of 205 times in Kelly's tenure.

Erin Kerr was the first Buff to qualify for a NCAA Regional post season bid in 2001 and that was followed up with another invitation in 2002. Hannah Hoch became a two time tournament winner in 2004-05 and broke many school records. She also became the first player in Buff history to be named All Big 12 second team that year as well. Last season, Emily Talley and Jessica Wallace were both named first-team All-Big 12, the first two players to earn that honor, and each were named twice as the Big 12 Golfer of the Month over the past two seasons. Wallace won CU's only Big 12 individual honor, named the Newcomer of the Year last season, as well.

Born May 15, 1961, in Aspen, Colo., Kelly graduated from TCU in 1983 with a bachelor's degree in business communications. She prepped at Santa Rita High School in Tucson, Ariz.

CU at League Championships...

The Buffaloes will be participating in their first Pac-12 Championships this season and in doing so partake in their third different league championship event in its history. The women's golf program at CU came about two years before the creation of the Big 12 Conference.

The Buffs have trended upward at the league championships the last several years, as five of the Buffs top six finishes at conference championships have come in the last six years, starting with the program best third place finish in 2006 behind a fifth place individual finish from Maria Persson-Gulda.

Current Buffs At Big 12's...

The five slated to tee off for the Buffaloes on Friday have shown some success in the past at the Big 12 Championships. Last year despite a ninth place finish, the Buffaloes posted the second- and third-best team rounds at a conference tournament and easily shot the best 36-hole and 54-hole scores in team history. CU's 36-hole score of 599 was six strokes better than any previous performance while the Buffs 54-hole total of 903 was 12 shots better than any previous performance.

Individually, Jess Wallace finished fourth last year, matching the best individual finish in CU history for a conference meet. Emily Talley finished sixth her freshman year and fifth her sophomore year and holds two of the top five individual performances in school history. Wallace's 1-under par 215 last year was the best 54-hole performance by seven strokes, topping Talley's 6-over 222 from the previous season. Talley's 8-over 224 last year ranks

Talley Closing Out Record Setting Career

Senior Emily Talley is the only one on the traveling roster that has played more than two seasons in Boulder, and thus she has put her mark, and then some, on the CU record book. She began breaking CU career records early in her junior campaign and now owns a majority of them, some by very impressive numbers.

In all Talley owns 33 CU records, including 15 career records, four season records, eight tournament records and six round records.
