**QUICKLY:** Colorado has won 23 games, the second most victories in school history. Coach Boyle owns the top three winningest seasons in school history (24 wins in each of the 2011-12 and 2010-11 seasons) • The Buffs are 13-5 in postseason games (9-2 conference, 3-1 NIT, 1-2 NCAA) in the last four years • CU has advanced to the conference tournament three of the last four years (2014: Pac-12), 2012: Pac-12, 2011: Big 12) • CU's last three wins have been by identical 59-56 scores (at Stanford, USC, Cal)

**FAMILIAR FOE:** CU meets Arizona for the third-straight year in the Pac-12 Tournament. In the first year, CU defeated Arizona, 53-51 in the title game on Mar. 10, 2012 in Los Angeles (Staples Center) and last season at the MGM in the tournament quarterfinal (Arizona, 79-69).

**A WIN FRIDAY MEANS:** Tying a school record 24 wins in a season • Upsetting No. 4/4 Arizona would be highest win over a ranked opponent under Boyle in the last four years • A school-first third win over a ranked Top-10 team in one season (Kansas, Oregon, Arizona) • First win over Arizona this season, breaking a three-game skid to the Wildcats • Advancing to the Pac-12 finals for the second time in three years.

**CU IN POSTSEASON:** The Buffs are 13-5 in postseason games (9-2 conference, 3-1 NIT, 1-2 NCAA) under Coach Boyle, .722 postseason winning %, Boyle ranks first in school history.

**COACH BOYLE:** Tad Boyle is 7-1 has the best winning percentage in the Pac-10 or Pac-12 history books of the conference tournament (.875) • Boyle's winning percentage (.657) is the best of any CU head coach in men's hoops history (min. 2 years) • 92 victories over his four seasons, most wins in any four-year span in school history (90-48 record).

**RECORD BOOKS:** CU has made 625 free throws, second most in school history (679: 2010-11 • Rebounding margin of +6.9, ranks second (+8.9: 1962-63) • FT% of .722 ranks seventh all-time at CU • 34 games played this season, ranks third most • 12,51 rebounds ties fifth all-time with the 1998-99 season.

**20 WINS, AGAIN:** Colorado has won 20 games in each of Tad Boyle's four seasons at CU - a school record for four consecutive years • Incredibly in 113 years of CU basketball there's been eight seasons of 20 wins or more, and Coach Boyle owns four.

**BUFF BITS:** CU is 4-1 this season when having three starters from the Centennial State (Gordon, Scott, Talton) • Askia Booker, Josh Scott, and Xavier Johnson all scored in double-figures in both Pac-12 Tournament games, marking the 19th and 20th time that has happened this season. CU is 16-4 in those games • When Booker is the leading scorer, CU is 8-1 in those game.

**20-POINT SCORERS:** Four different players have scored over 20 points resulting in a combined 14-4 record. Askia Booker: 4-1 record; Josh Scott: 4-2; Xavier Johnson: 3-1; and Spencer Dinwiddie: 3-0.

**MBB MISCELLANEOUS:** Overall (all games), CU is 39-3 out-rebounding and holding opponent under 40 FG% • CU is 13-6 when committing single-digit turnovers over the last four years (CU has performed single-digit turnovers five times this season) • CU has made at least one three-pointer in 398-straight games (dating back to Jan. 19, 2002) • CU is 15-5 when the game is a home sellout

**TEAM NOTES:** CU is an impressive 27-4 under Boyle when having 15+ assists in a game • CU is 7-0 overall when shooting 50 FG% (4-0 in Pac-12 games) • CU is 13-2 in single digits games (9-0 at home, 4-1 on the road) • CU has scored under 65 points in seven-straight games (4-3), longest stretch of 65 or less points in four years.

**IMPRESSIVE STATS:** Under the Boyle staff at the Events Center, CU is 50-1 when out-rebounding the opponent (last year out-rebounded Ariz. St., 41-26, OT loss) • CU is 31-2 when the opponent shoots under 40 FG% (UCLA this season at Cal) • CU is an incredible 27-0 at home when out-rebounding the opponent AND holding opponent under 40 FG% • In four years, Tad Boyle and the Buffs are 15-3 in games when a home win follows a road OR neutral court loss.

**NATIONALLY RANKED OPPONENTS:** CU is 11-14 against nationally ranked opponents and 5-8 against the nation's Top-10 under Boyle • CU has defeated a nationally ranked opponent at least once since 2010-11 • CU is 2-5 against ranked opponents this season.

**DOUBLE-DOUBLE:** Not by the tradition way of points/rebounds, Askia Booker recorded his first-career double scoring 16 points with 12 assists at UCLA. He's the first player since Marcus Hall (10 vs. Baylor, March 13, 2008) • "Ski" is the seventh CU player in school history with at least 12+ assists in a game. Last CU player with that many Jose Winston (15 vs. Coppin St., Jan. 2 2001).

**MOST WINS IN A SEASON:** Head Coach Tad Boyle is the first CU head coach to guide the program to four-straight 20-win seasons. He also owns the school record for most wins in a season (24), twice.

**5TH PLACE OR BETTER:** This season was the fourth straight year CU finished the conference season in fifth place among the final standings (three: Pac-12, once: Big 12). The four conference placings of fifth place or better is the first time since the 1963-67 seasons (1963-64: 2nd; 1964-65: t-5th; 1965-66: t-5th; 1966-67: t-2nd).

**UNDER THE BOYLE WATCH:** Last season, CU made back-to-back NCAA Tournaments appearances (2011-12 & 2012-13) for the first time since 1961-62 & 1962-63 (50 years) • Tad Boyle is the first CU head coach since Sox Walseth to lead the Buffs to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances • The 2012-13 NCAA Appearance is CU's first at-large invite since 2002-03 • In 12 NCAA Tournament appearances, the Buffs are 10-14 (.417) with two Final Fours (1942 & 1955) • For the first time in 112 years of CU basketball, three consecutive post-season appearances was a school-first in post-season play (2010-11 NIT semifinal, 2011-12 NCAA 3rd Round, 2012-13 NCAA 2nd Round).
