**QUICKLY:** CU has advanced past the opening round in all four years of the Pac-12 Tournament, five years overall (Big 12 included) under head coach Tad Boyle • CU became only the second No. 10 seed in the Pac-10/12 Tournament to beat a No. 7 seed since the Pac-10/12 began seeding all tournament teams in 2006 (other: Utah over USC, 69-66, 2013) • In the last five years under Boyle, the Buffaloes have advanced to the semifinal round every year except 2012-13.

**A WIN TONIGHT MEANS:** Advancing to the Pac-12/Big 12 Conference Tournament for the fourth time in five years under Boyle • A season split with Oregon and a 9-4 all-time record against the Ducks, including five of the last six games • CU would improve to 6-2 against Oregon in Pac-12 games • Coach Boyle improves to 9-2 and a winning percentage of .818, both ranking first among the Pac-10/Pac-12 Tournament history books • Over the last five years, the Buffs improve to 15-7 (.682) in post-season play (11-3 conference, 3-1 NIT, 1-3 NCAA) • The .682 postseason winning percentage continues to rank first in school history.

**BOOKER/BILLUPS:** Askia Booker is leading CU in points, assists and steals, something no Colorado player has done since Chauncey Billups (steals became an official NCAA statistic in 1985-86).

**IN THE PAINT:** The Buffaloes have an imposing presence in the paint on defense with the tandem of Josh Scott and Wesley Gordon. Pac-12 Duos with an average of 7.0+ rebounds a game and 1.5+ blocks per game since 1996-97. (Single Seasons - Min. 22 GP in Season).

**IT'S YOU AGAIN?:** Thursday's match up with Oregon is the second time CU will play the Ducks this season. During the Pac-12 Conference season facing the same team again after a loss in the first meeting, the Buffs are 3-2 (wins: Oregon State, Arizona State & Washington; losses: Utah & Arizona).

**40+ REBOUNDS:** CU has grabbed 40 or more rebounds in 15 games this season (9-6 record), the most since 2005-06, when that team did it 17 times (15-2).

**CU & 75 POINTS:** Colorado now has 25 wins for the most consecutive games when scoring 75 or more points (all games played). Utah is second with 20 victories. CU's streak dates back Jan. 24, 2013.

**PLAYER NOTES FROM LAST NIGHT:****Askia Booker**

- Played in his 133rd career game, for sole possession of No. 2 on the CU's all-time list
- Scored game-high 20 points, moves No. 6 on the all-time list passing Stevie Wise, 1727, 1987-91.
- Booker now has 1,728 career points.
- 14th game this season scoring over 20 points (21st career).
- 86th career game in double figures.
- Moved into No. 8 place on all-time field goals made list (591).

**Dominique Collier**

- Scored six points, pair of treys, first time vs. Pac-12 opponent this season.

**Tre'Shaun Fletcher**

- Career-best 12 points, tying career-high five made field goals.

**Josh Scott**

- Sixth double-double of season (21st career).
- 11th multi-block game (26th career).
- Scored 12 points at halftime, last three games has now scored 41 points in the opening 20 minutes.
- Career-high 14 rebounds in six career games against the Beavers.
- 14 rebounds moves into No. 14 on all-time rebounding list (657).
- Career-high 12 defensive rebounds.

**4-YEAR BESTS:** In the history of the men's basketball program, Ben Mills, a May 2014 graduate is the all-time leader in wins of four-year student-athletes. That's the first four years of the Tad Boyle era in Boulder. Senior Askia Booker holds the runner up slot with 83 wins over his four year career.
